


## **UGU DISTRICT MAP**

## Number of people aged 15-24 reached with anti-gender based violence information








## LIFE SKILLS


- Trained 210 peer educators in 15 schools
- Conducted peer education trainings for 15 secondary schools
- The training was facilitated by DOE in partnership with Aids Foundation.
- Conducted community dialogues with five schools reached 5000 children
- Conducted Peer competition with 30 high schools that are involved in the peer programme.
- Education and prevention programme done DSD in 6 high school and reached 3000 children




#### Baby PCR tested positive around 6 weeks rate




## Baby HIV antibody test positive at 18 months rate



#### **Ante-Natal Care Booking before 20 weeks rate**






- Favourable trends noted in early booking, testing of infants and number of infants who tested positive. Mixed feeding remains a challenge.
- Facilities are dedicated to promoting safe infant feeding via the mother and baby friendly hospitals initiative.
- St Andrews has been assessed and accredited with mother and baby friendly status.
- District Clinical Specialist Team to discuss mortality targets with facilities as well as narratives for deviations set by National Department of Health. To continue with auditing for all paediatric deaths.

- 10 maternal deaths: 6 died at regional hospital due to 1x retained placenta,1x ARV side effects, 1x Meningitis, 1x incomplete abortion, 1x Burns, 1x ectopic. District hospitals x 4: 1x ruptured uterus, 1x meningitis, 1x high spinal anaethesia, 1x TB. Reasons for mortality is lack of skilled personnel to diagnose & manage obstetric emergencies.
- All deaths audited & modifiable factors followed up in PHC & hospitals & implemented in- service training at hospitals, CHCs & hospitals & clinics.
   Essential Skills in Management of Obstetrical Emergencies weekly drills done at all hospitals supported by District Clinical Specialist Team.
   National planned two months mop up training of ESMOE to all doctors & nurses working in maternity units.




### MALE MEDICAL CIRCUMCISION

- The school holidays usually impact on MMCs and numbers are usually low over this period. 4 family teams added and 14 School health teams are being prepared to commence enhanced MMC recruitment and planning of school MMC camps. MMC teams to undergo further skills development.


## **HIV COUNSELLING AND TESTING**




## **MALE CONDOM DISTRIBUTION**

## **FEMALE CONDOM DISTRIBUTION**




## **CONDOM DISTRIBUTION**


- Condoms were out of stock at province for some time in the quarter under review. Private GPs, Political leadership, NGOs and Cansa association is assisting the district with condom distribution. Outreach done to farms, industries etc by mobile HTA.

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



## PREVENTION OF EXPOSURE TO TRANSMISSION FROM OCCUPATIONAL EXPOSURE & SEXUAL VIOLENCE

- Data is analysed to establish areas where sexual assault is high.
- Awareness was done during child protection week in Harding, municipalities and Thuthuzela care centre. Volunteers from Department of community safety and liaison and CBOs, public works and SAPS attended child protection workshop in all Local Municipalities
- In terms of Post Exposure Prophylaxis, train the trainer course was held in Durban and was facilitated by the Provincial manager.
- This issue of sexual violence needs to be discussed at the men's forum.
- Training for sexual assault to take place in Q1 in the new financial year
- To engage Traditional Leadership and Faith Based Organizations
- Working in partnership with Drug and Substance Abuse forums




#### **Number of children on ART**





#### Number of adults lost to follow up




- Plans in place to increase Mpilonde support clubs, currently there are 200 clubs.
