- More OVCs will receive care and support through CCGs (employed by DOH, DSD, Amajuba EPWP), Isibindi Child and Youth Care Workers and patient advocates employed by Khethimpilo and newly employed field workers employed by Educational Support Services Trust through the National Youth Development Agency
- Referrals for access to grants, tracing of malnutrition cases and sexual assault cases will be increased

- Teenage Pregnancy issues have been addressed through school dialogues by ESST, DOE (gender and parent-child dialogues, life skills programes) and DOH through intervention programmes and school dialogues. 15 schools have been visited in the Newcastle, Dannhauser and Emadlangeni Locals, reaching 2484 (<14 years) and 8599 (14-21 years).
- The Department of education has also introduced Learner Support Agents in schools to strengthen My Life My Future Campaign; which is the campaign which intended to fight Social ills in schools.
- A dialogue targeting 150 young women 18-35 years is planned for ward 7 Dannhauser before end August 2015, as an intervention identified on the Provincial Cabinet Day (27 May 2015). The theme covers Teenage Pregnancy, HIV/AIDS and TB testing, parenting and Ante Natal Care
- Further programmes addressing Behaviour Change will be done through the "Just Don't Campaign", targeting 4 schools with 6560 learners in the District, from 30-31 July 2015. Sizimele High school in ward 11-Danhauser, being one of the schools as identified by the Legislature visit.

- The increase in infant deaths is still a challenge, nurses are given in service training on specific interventions.
- Referrals for testing of all 18 month old babies has been implemented through all Philamntwana Centers.
- Pregnancy testing will be done at all campaigns to promote ANC early booking
- ANC early booking and female condom distribution is being strengthened through community dialogues and road shows.
- PMTCT will also be strengthened by attaching all pregnant women tested positive to 120 patient advocates at ward level through Khethimpilo NGO and nearby clinics the advocates are placed at. This only covers the Newcastle and Dannhauser Municipalities, due to minimal funding.
- All Ward AIDS Committees (3 LMs) will be trained on MOM Connect, condom distribution and condom use demonstrations, in the 2nd quarter, by Khethimpilo
- The increase in employment of CCGs, Child and Youth Care Workers and NGO (ESST, Red Cross and Khethimpilo) field workers will strengthen early bookings, ante-natal care through door to door visits and awareness campaigns

- Condom distribution was enhanced by the Dual Protection launch. A follow up on this programme is planned for 30 July 2015 at Amajuba TVET Campus
- 2015/2016 plan includes condom distribution in mining communities, workplace, informal settlements and taxi ranks
- The follow up programme also includes a Billboards unveiling on Dual Protection as a marketing strategy planned for August 2015
- Female condom distribution needs to be increased through door to door educational campaigns done by CCGs, the new NYDA project (31 youth contracted), THPs and partnering NGOs (ESST, Khethimpilo and Redcross).
- Local Municipalities have been encouraged to have budgets for monthly and quarterly awareness campaigns to reduce new infections, promote ANC early bookings, HIV/AIDS and TB testing and MMC as part of the 90/90/90 Campaign

- Male circumcision is still low and it will be encouraged in the District Men's Month in July 2015, along with promoting healthy lifestyle.
- Build up campaigns were done in Newcastle ward 20 and 22 addressing MMC, HIV/AIDS and TB testing and healthy lifestyle
- MMC will be promoted through church and gender dialogues, the Local Media (Dual Protection Billboards and campaign, radio slots by ESST and MAMA) business industry, taxi associations
- An increase in deaths in the 4th quarter is noted and will be addressed through the new ART guidelines which have been implemented and the 90/90/90 programme to be activated in the 1st quarter of 2015/2016.
- More ART recipients will be attached to patient advocates (Khethimpilo) for support and improving adherence rate
- 16 ART adherence clubs have established in 5 health facilities in Newcastle- ward 24, 10, 11 Dannhauser-ward 11, 09

- Men having Sex with Men were workshopped by Khethimpilo and ESST in partnership with Anova Health Institute in June 2015
- PLHIV will be strengthened through Asibambimpilo Support Group based in Dannhauser and Newcastle and Emadlangeni LACs
- Workplace programmes will be initiated through Teacher Development Programmes to strengthen, HIV/AIDS and TB testing, the fight against Stigma in schools and ART adherence for learners and staff.
- Sexual assault cases (35 Newcastle and 14 Dannhauser) are receiving more therapeutic services through Isibindi Programme, Child Line and DSD. Research currently being conducted out will inform future Prevention Campaigns

- Newcastle Local Municipality held the LAC meeting...
- Two Local AIDS Councils/Municipalities do not have focal persons/staff for HIV /AIDS Programme implementation. The structures need support. Future DAC meetings will sit at the Local level for support. The item will be on the IGR.
- Civil Society structure will be strengthened from Local AIDS Councils through Moral Regeneration Movement which requires a Civil Society structure that addresses all Special Programmes and HIV/AIDS
