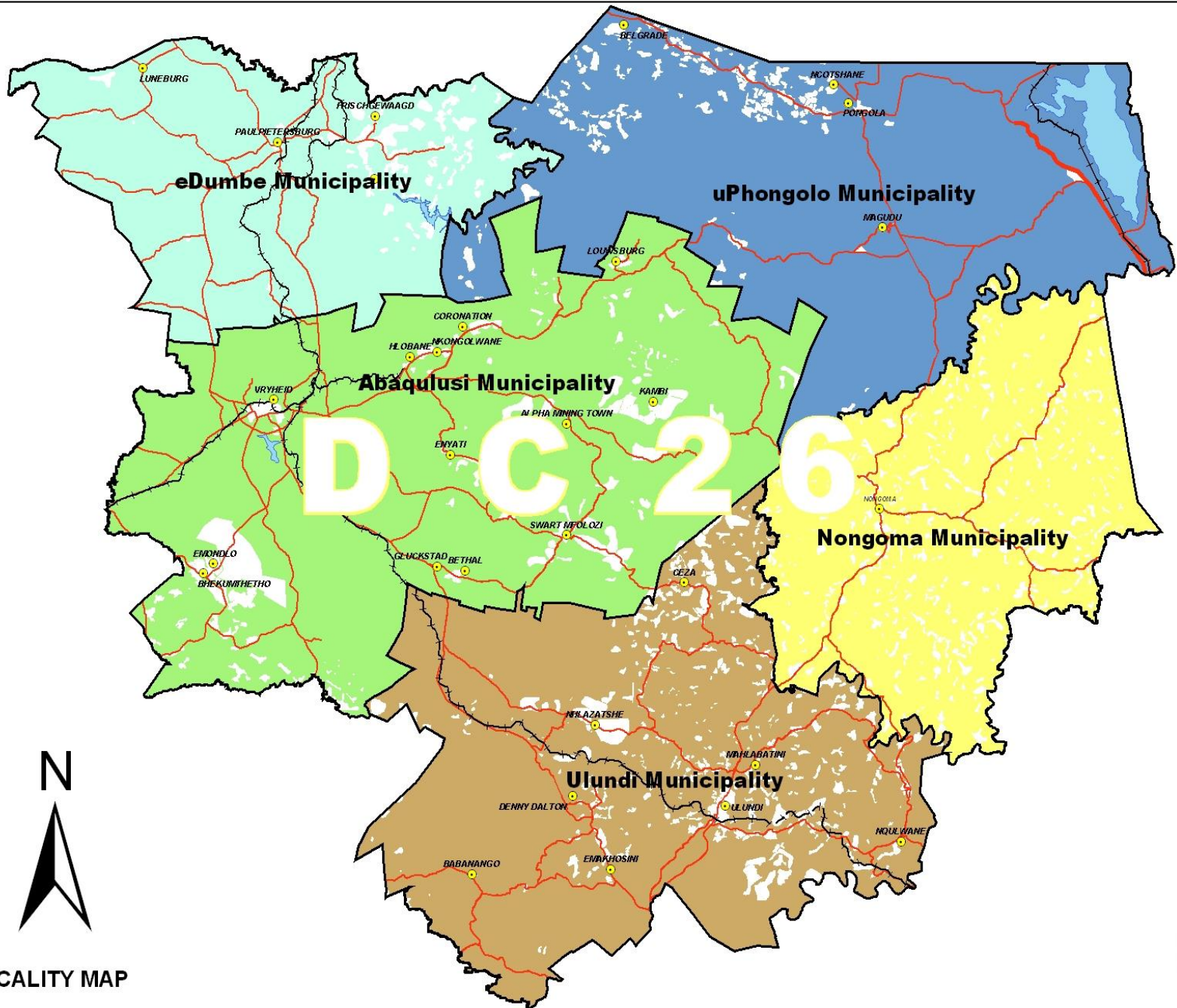

Zululand is comprised of 05 local municipalities and they are distributed as follows;

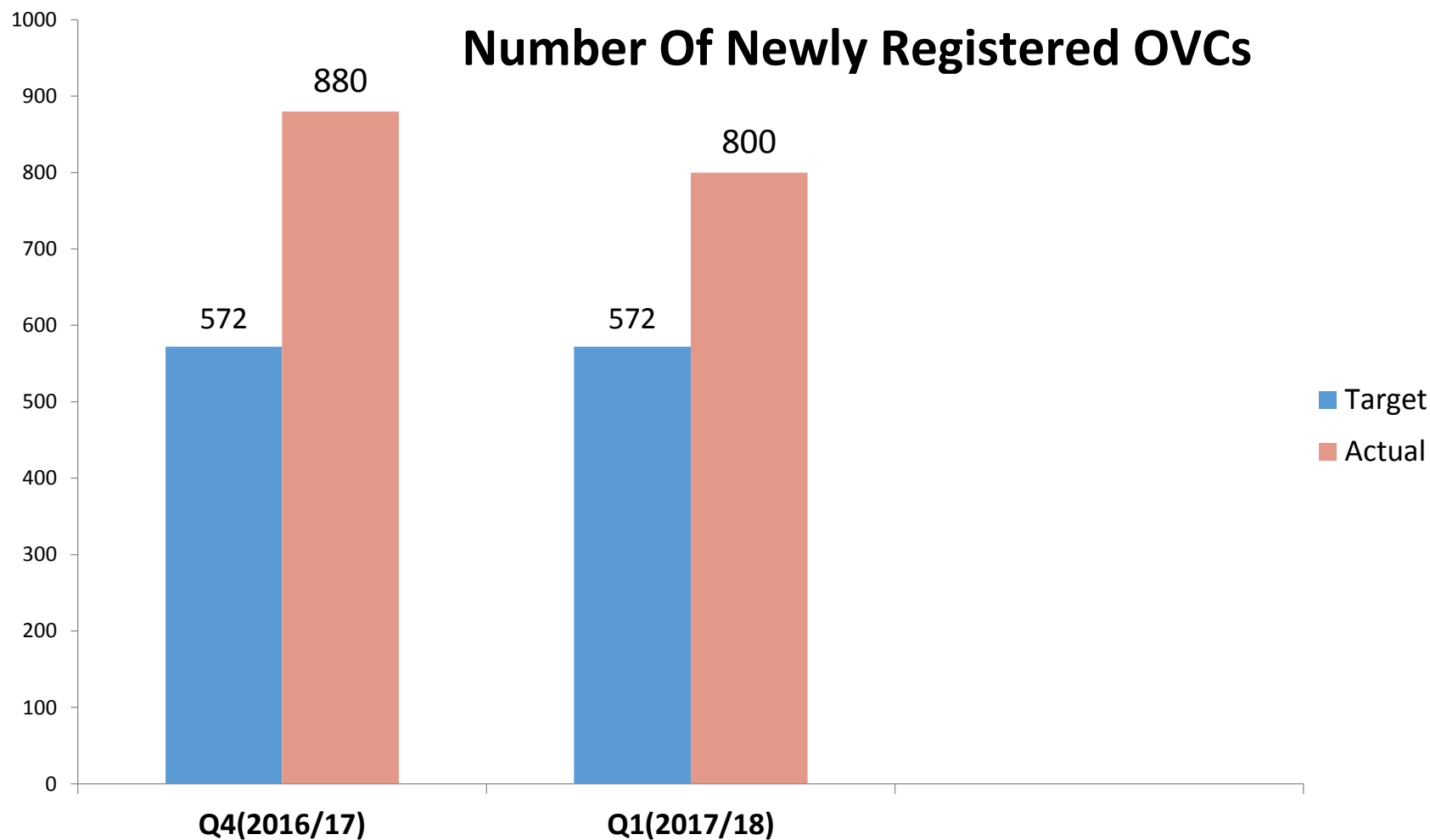
- ❑ Ulundi - 24 wards

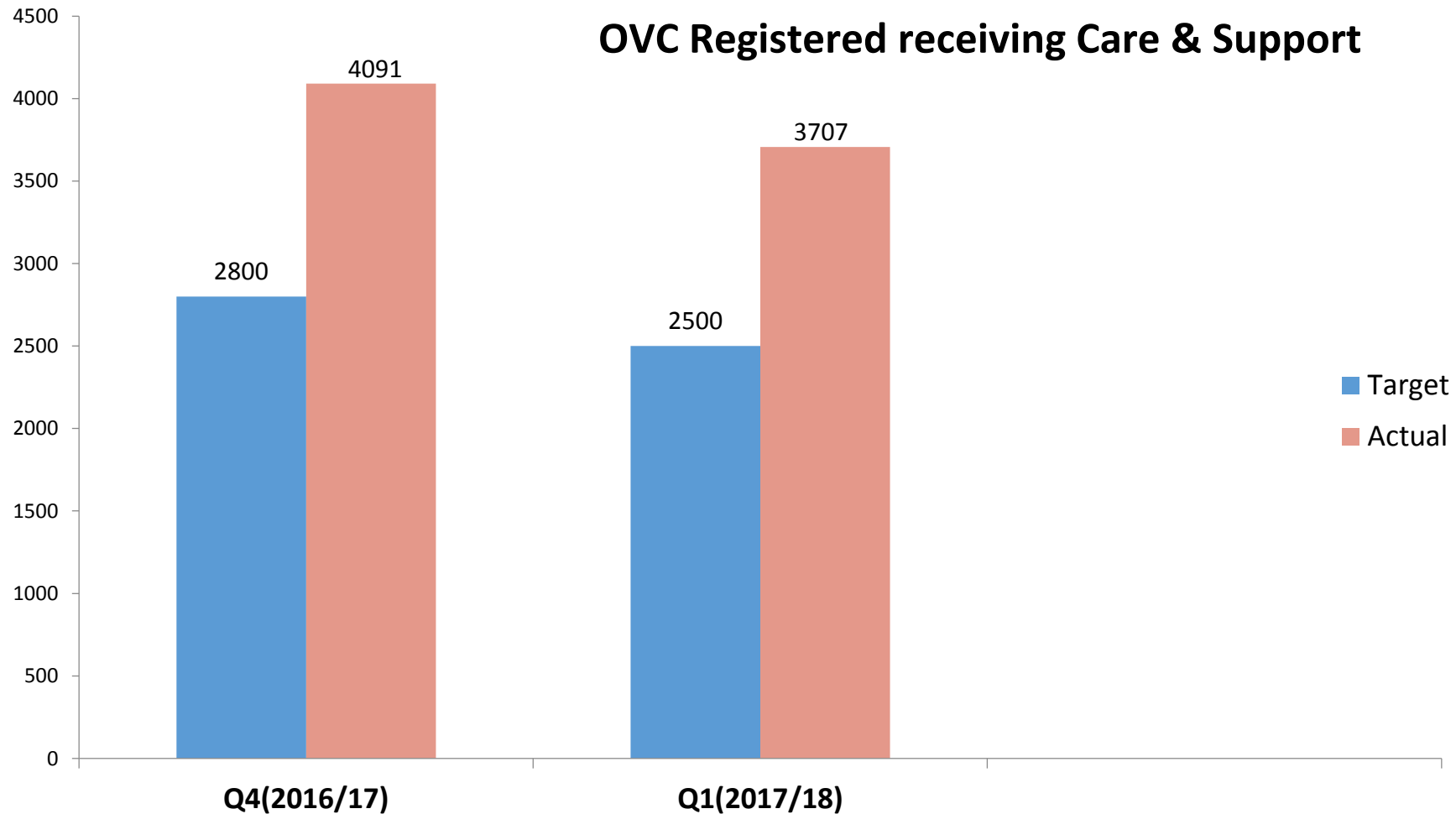

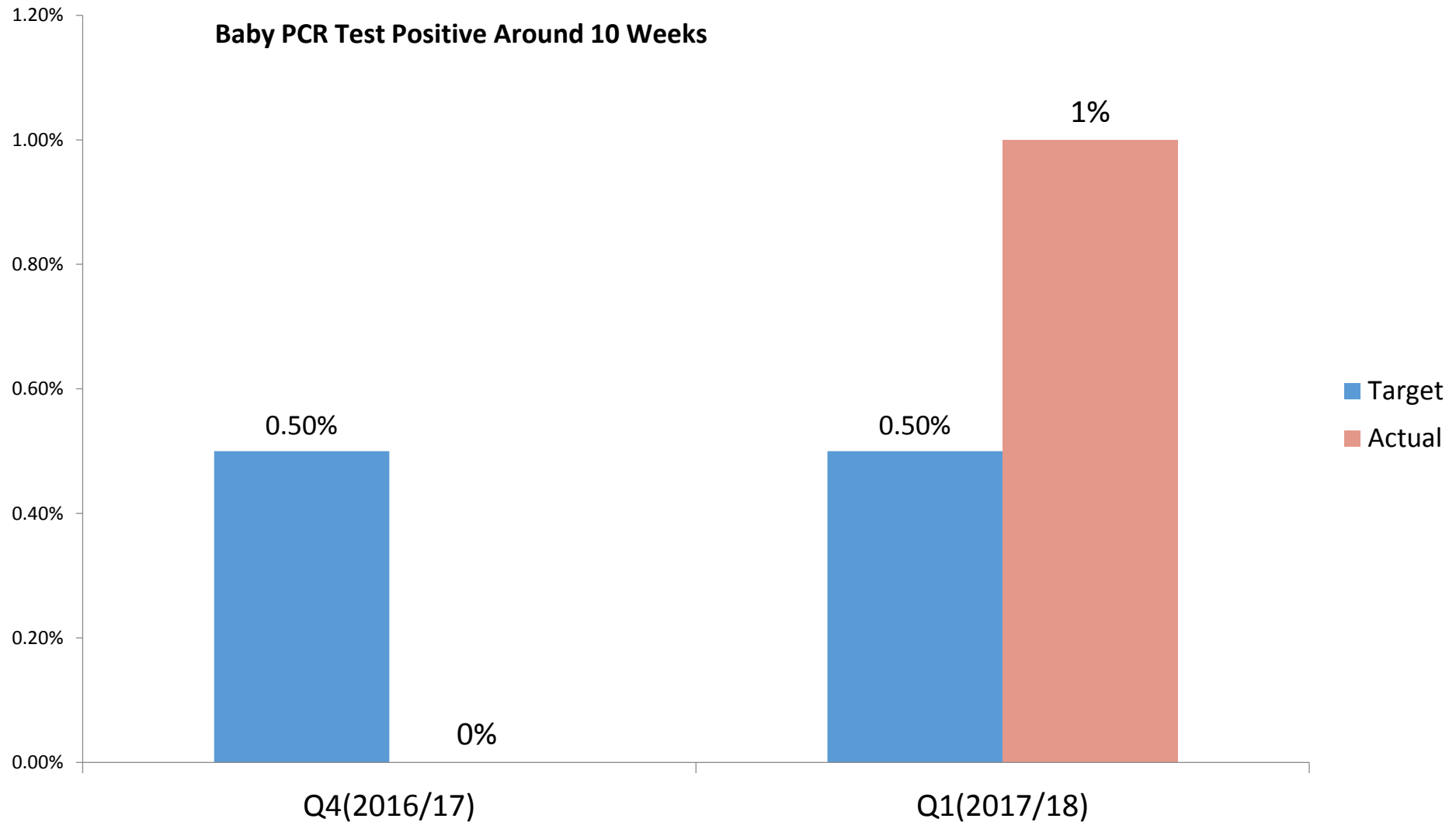

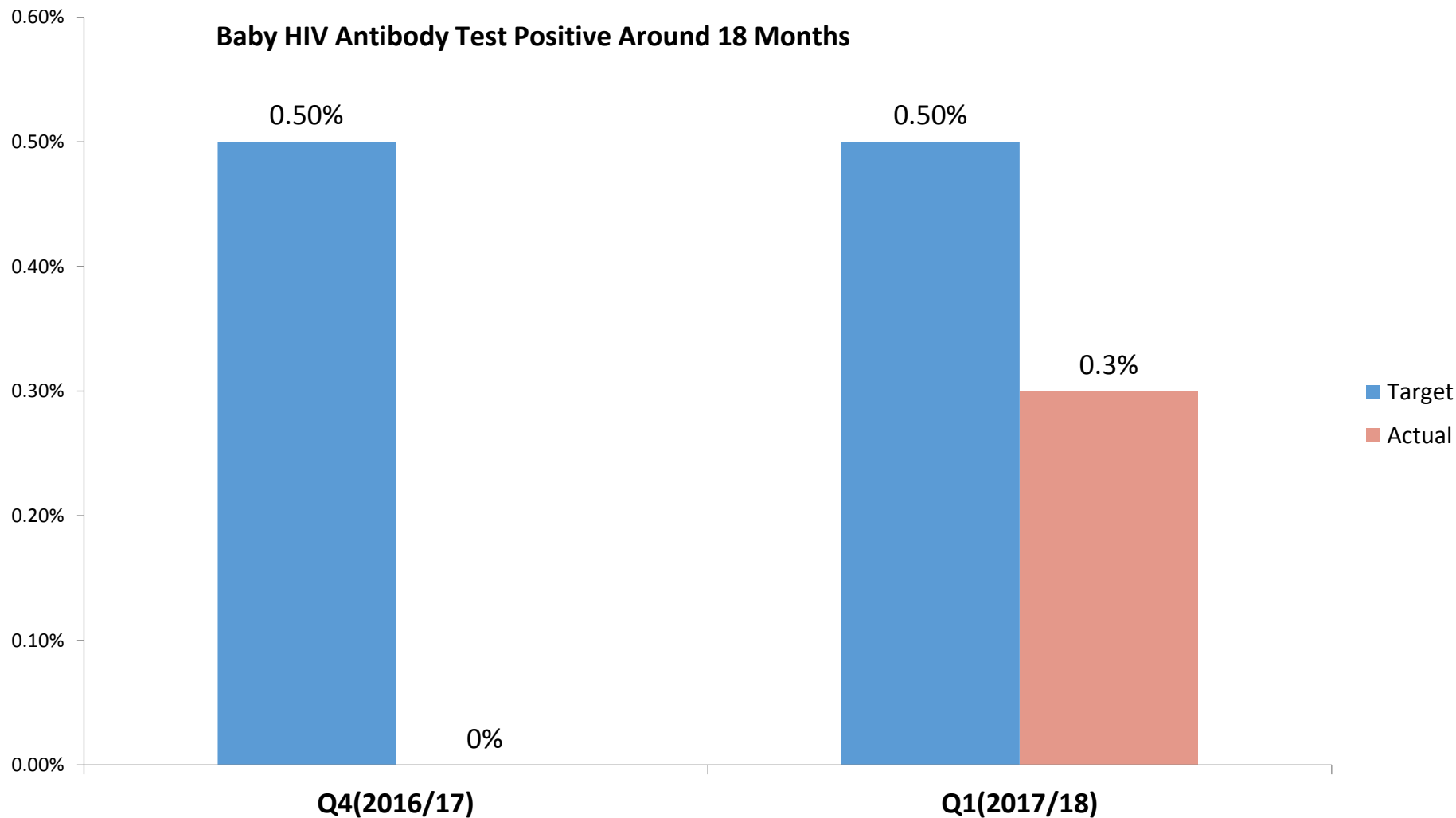

Baby PCR Test Positive Around 10 Weeks

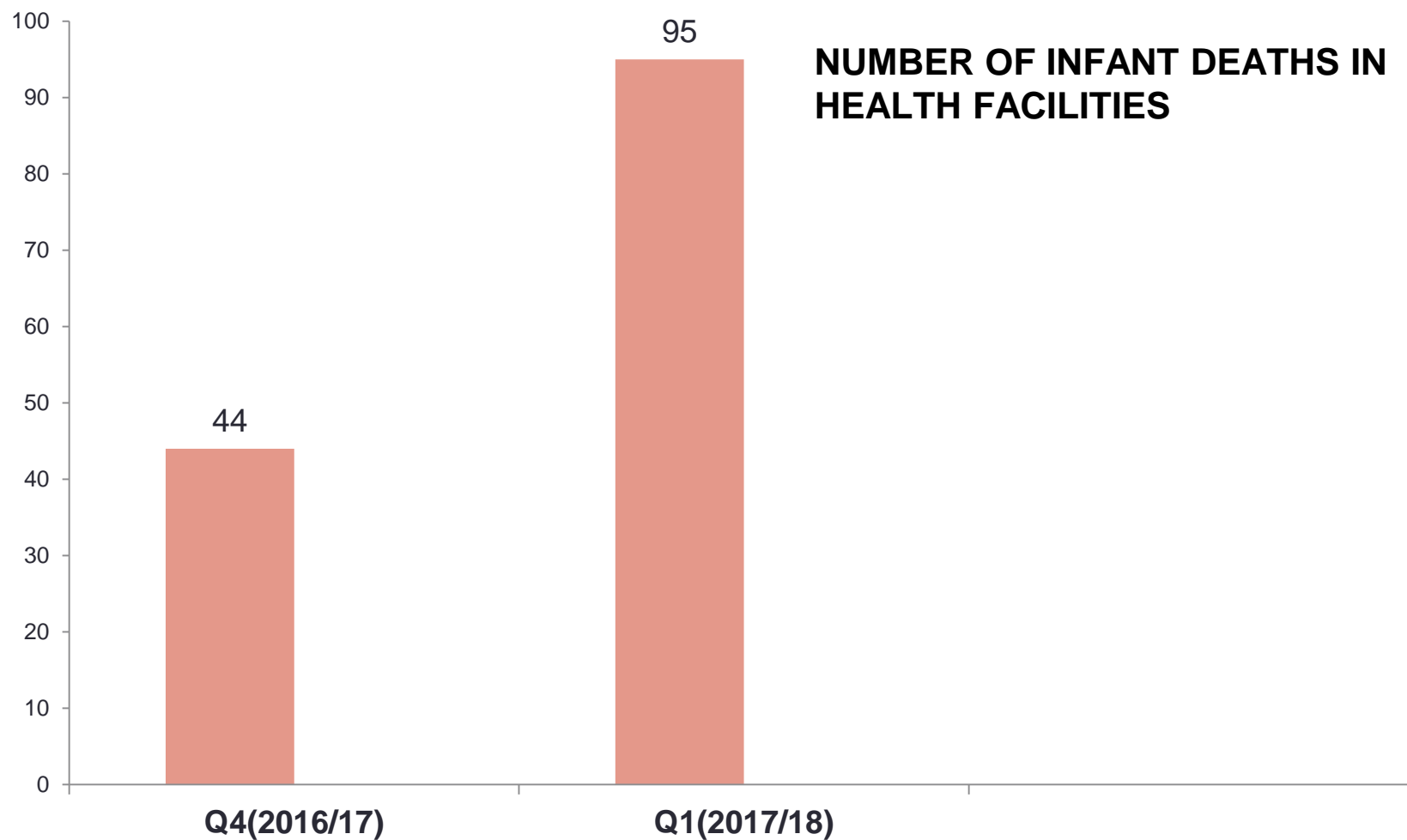

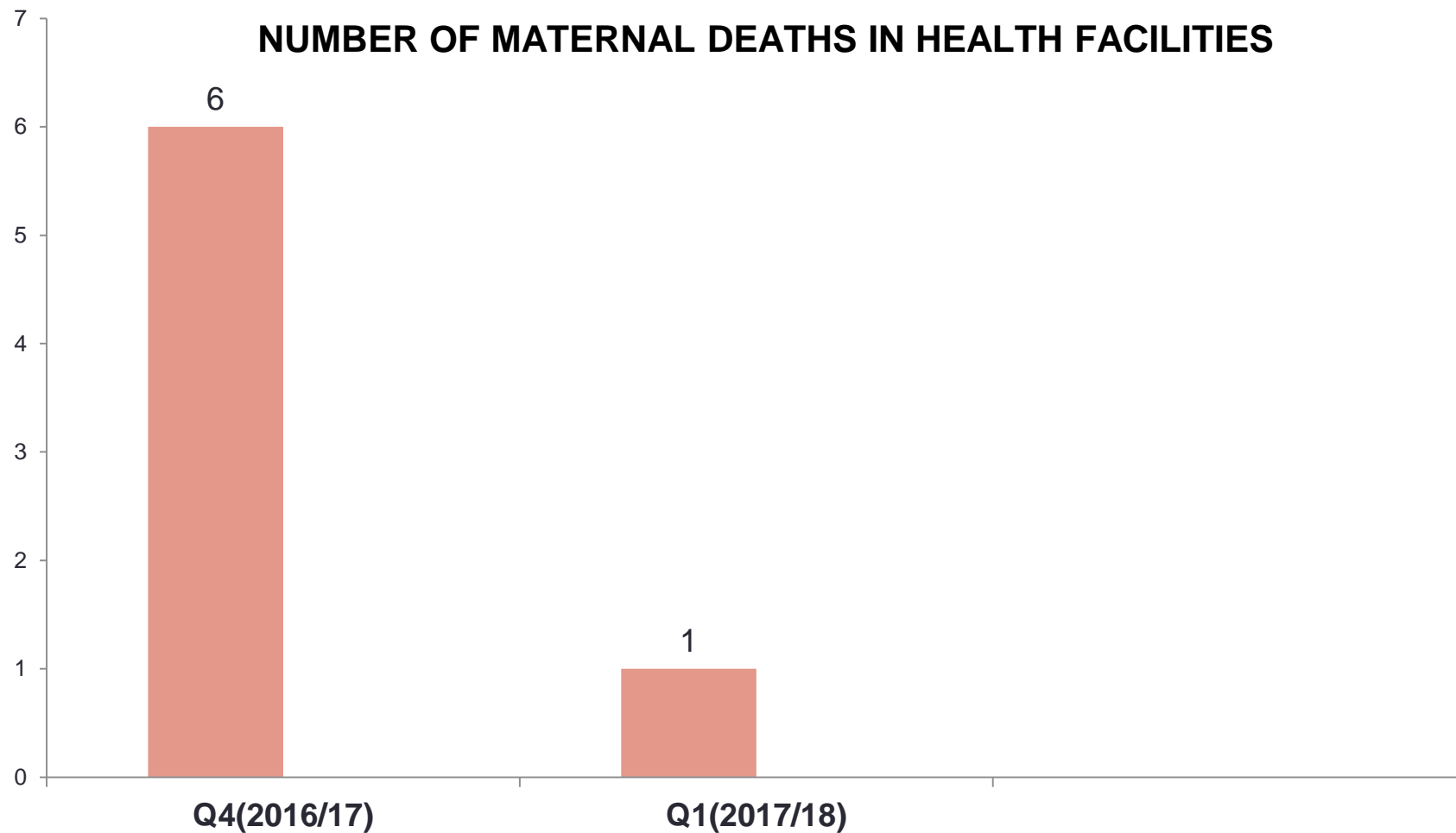
Baby HIV Antibody Test Positive Around 18 Months



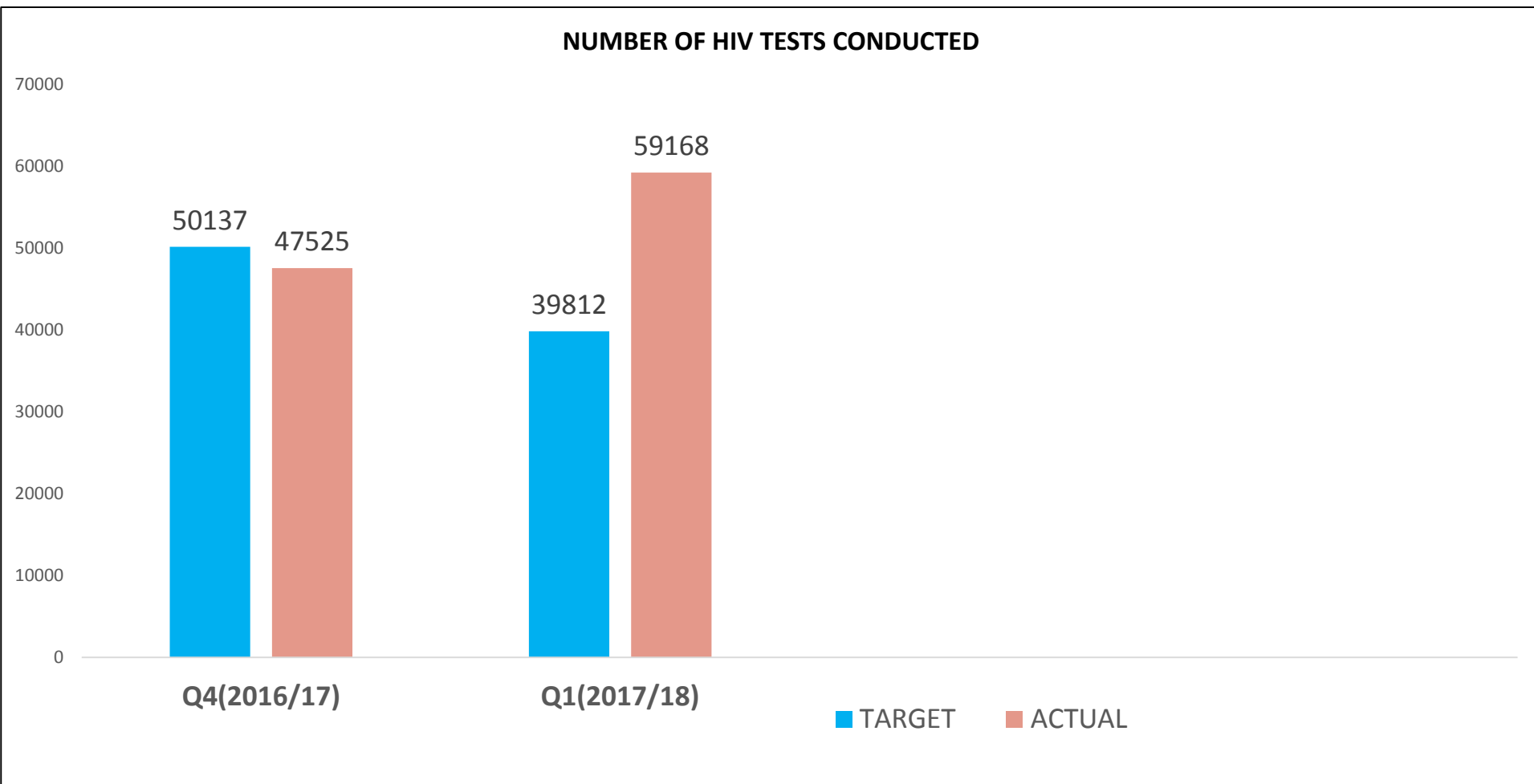

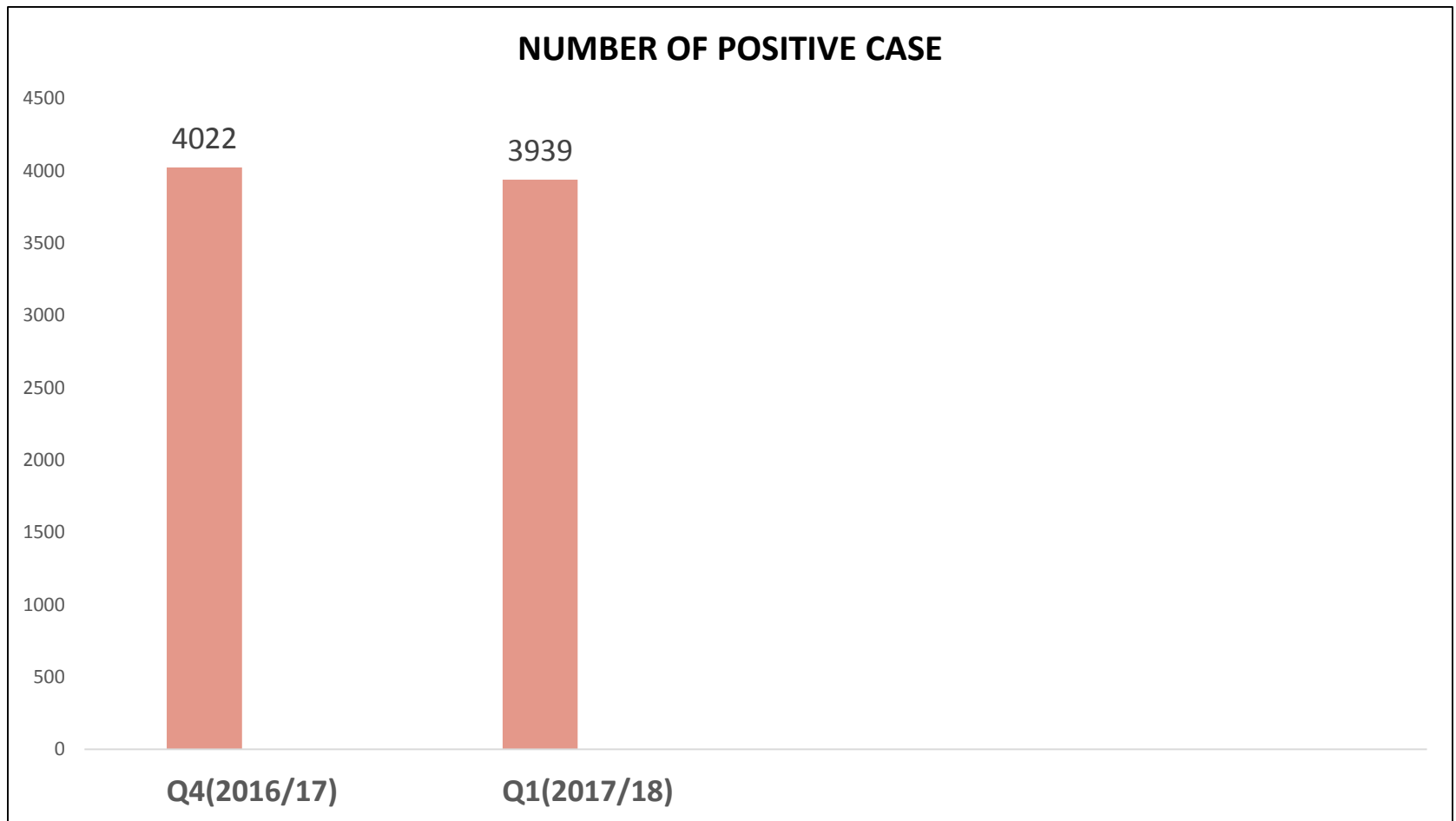

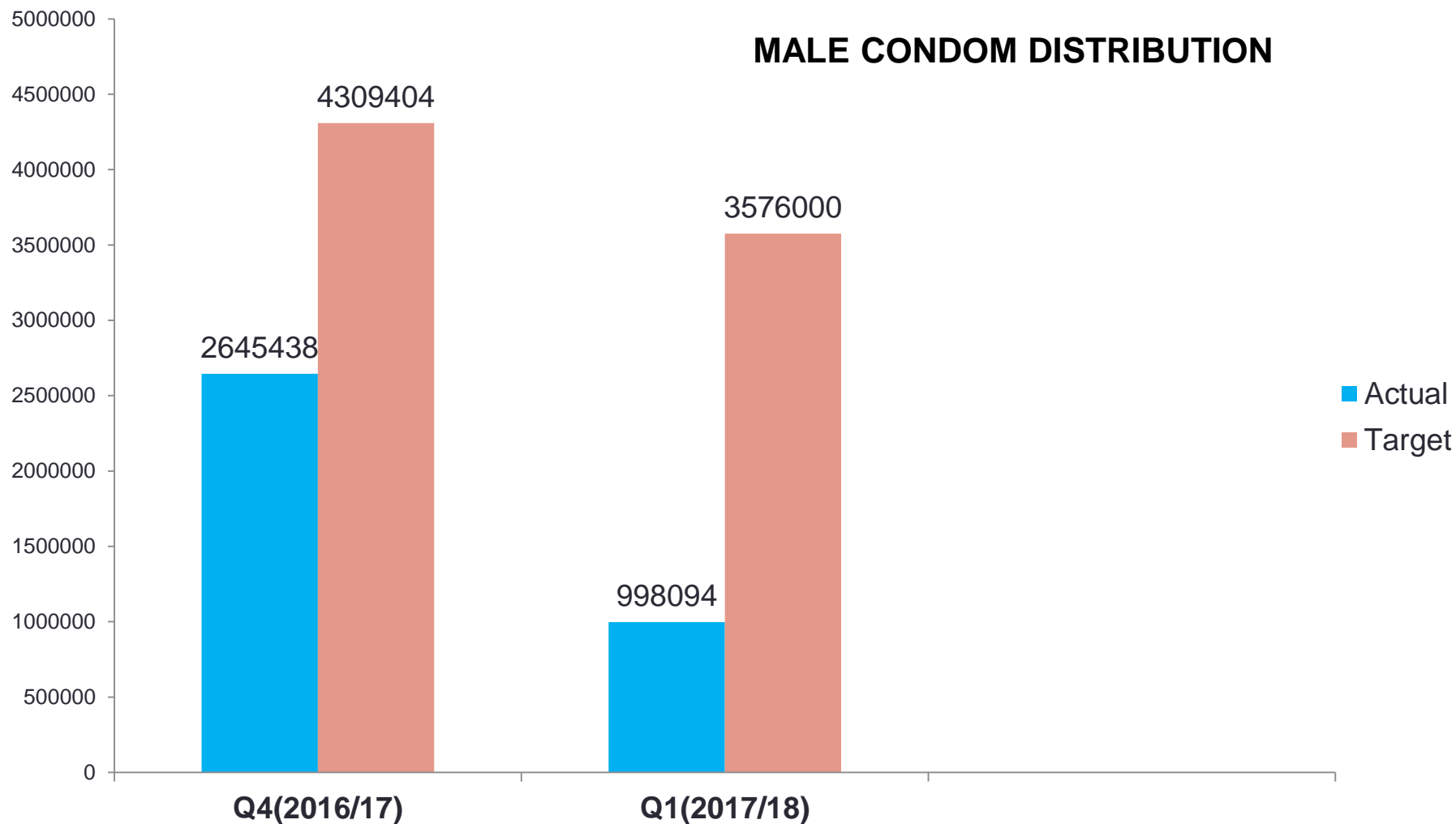
Intervention Area: HCT & TB screening



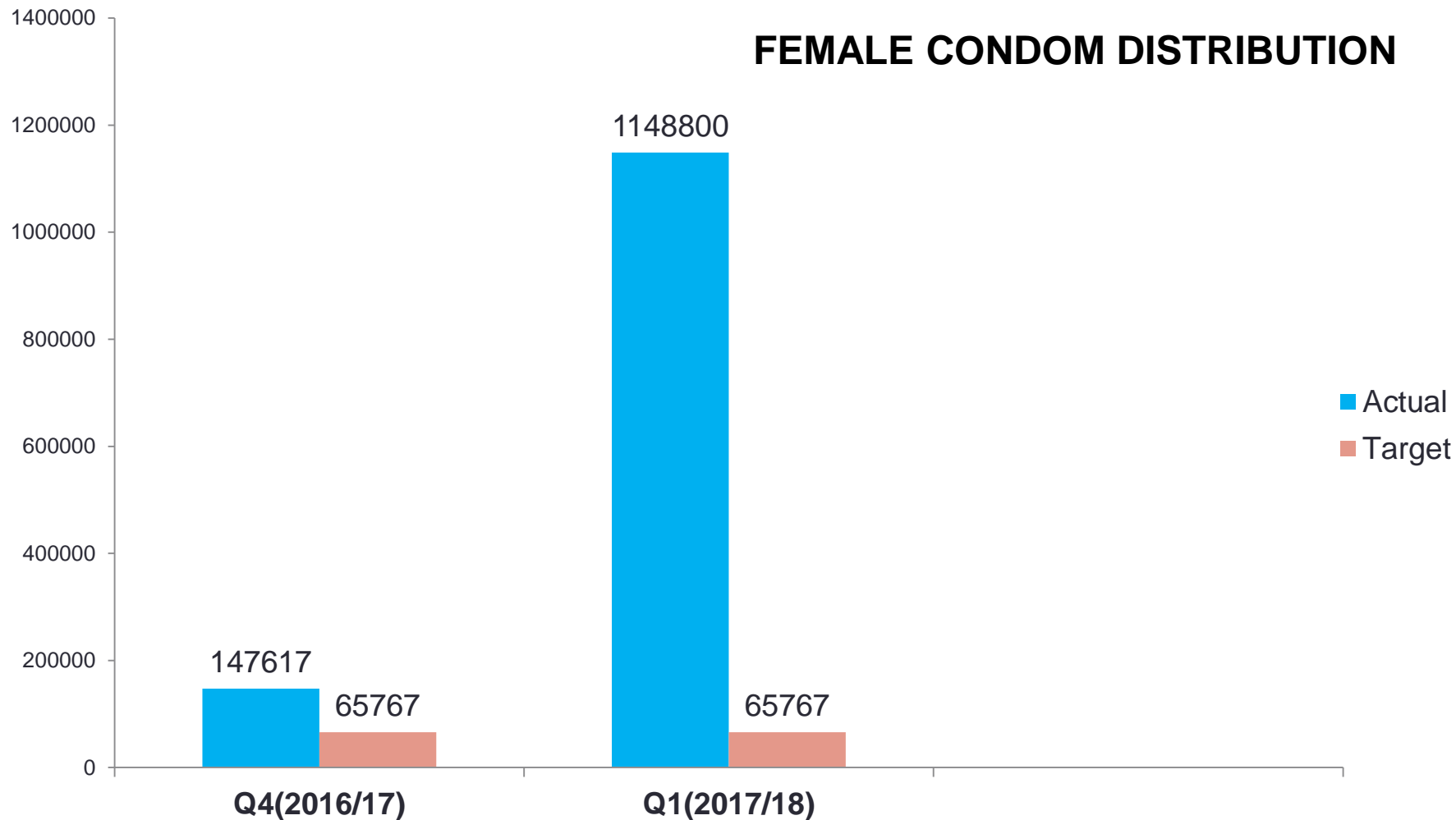

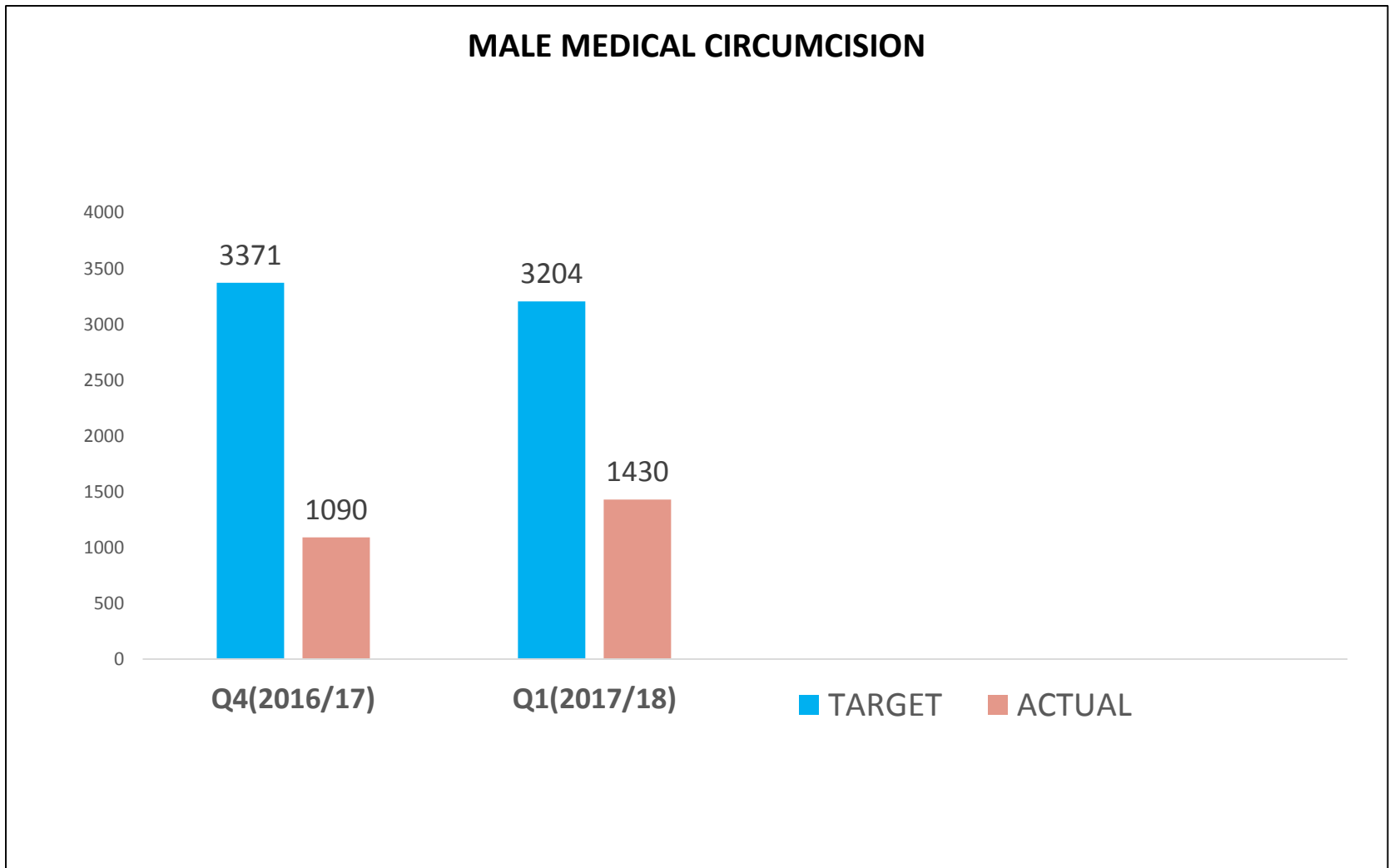
Intervention Area: Condoms distribution



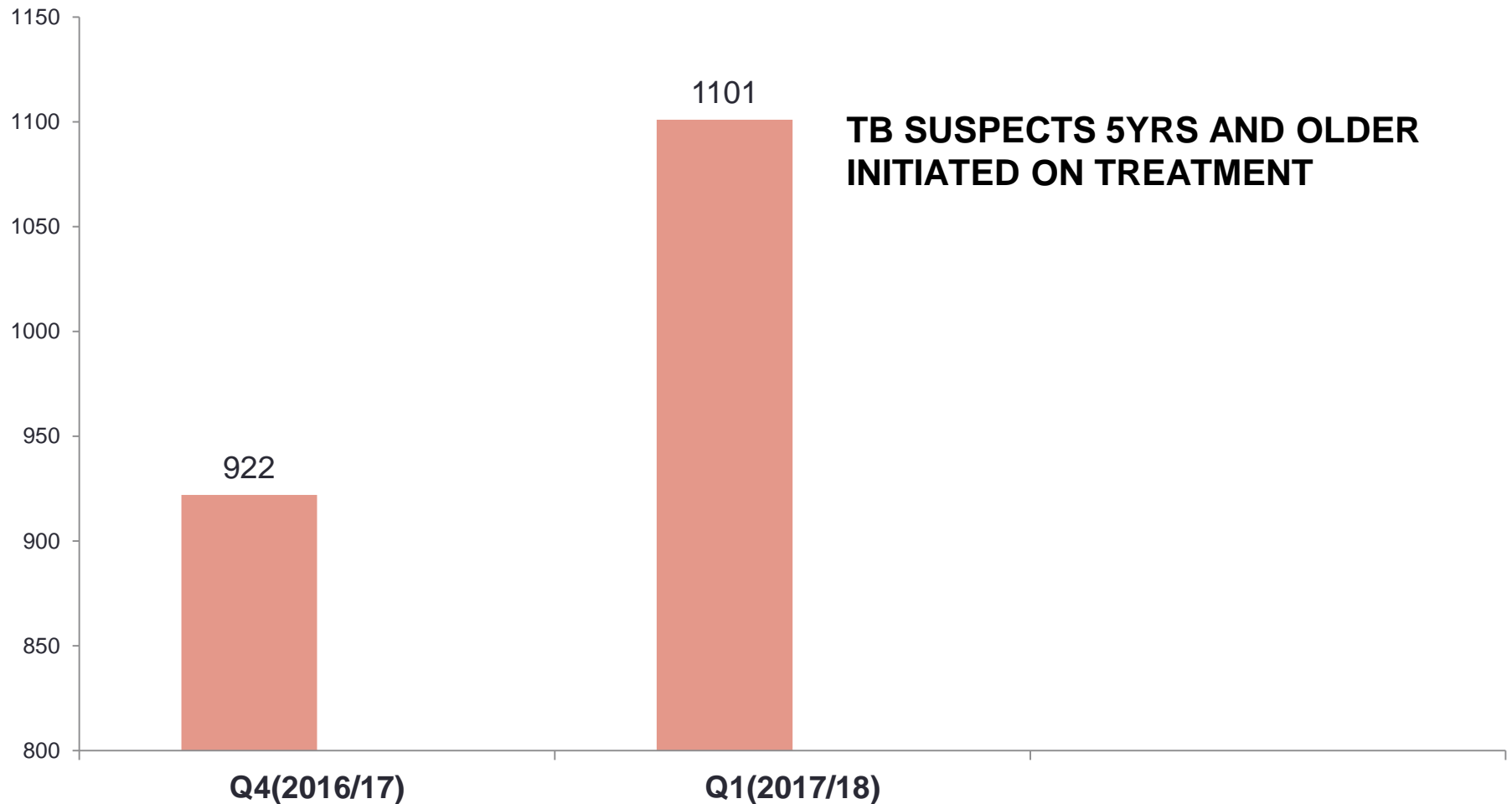

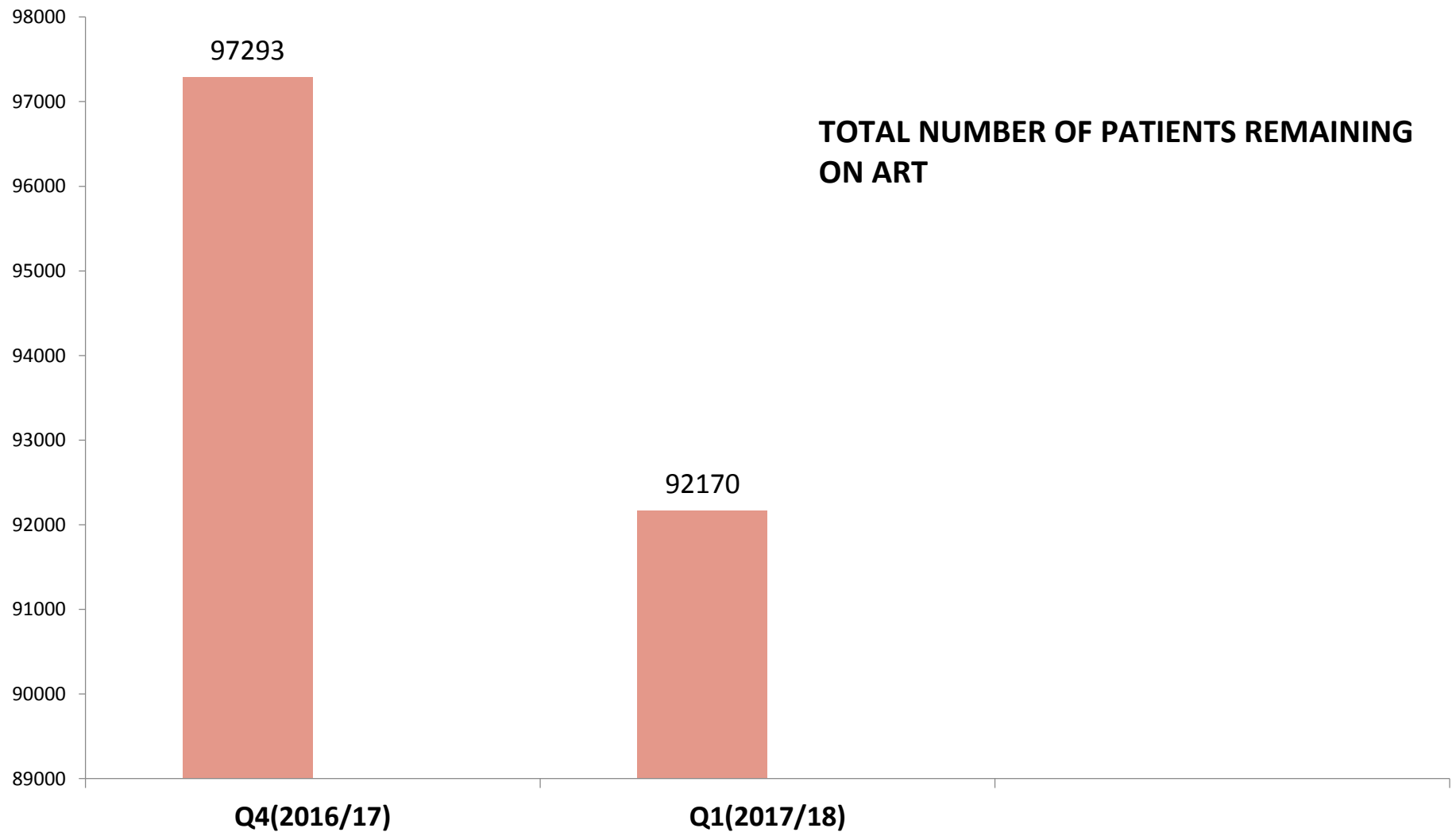
Intervention Area: Male Medical Circumcision



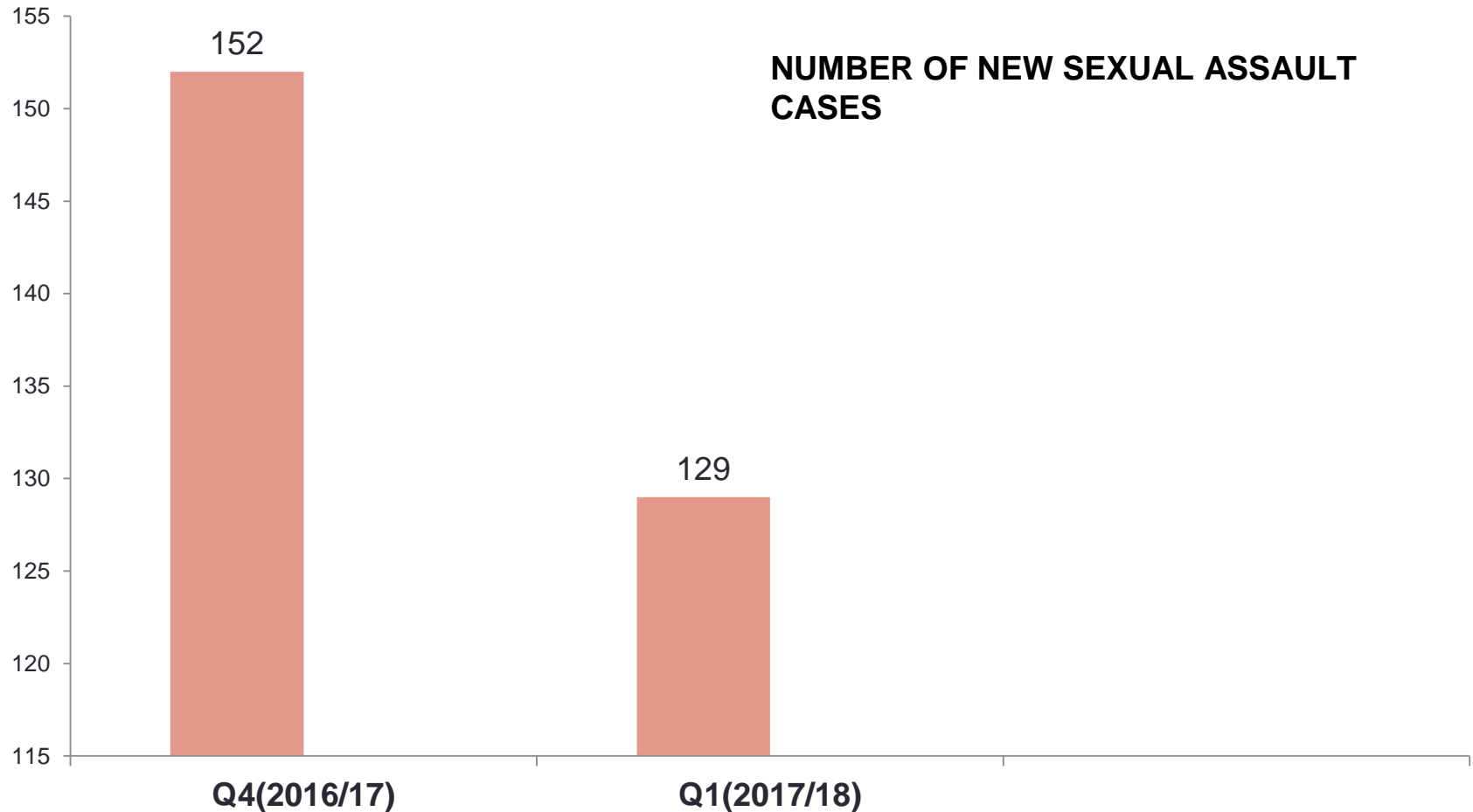

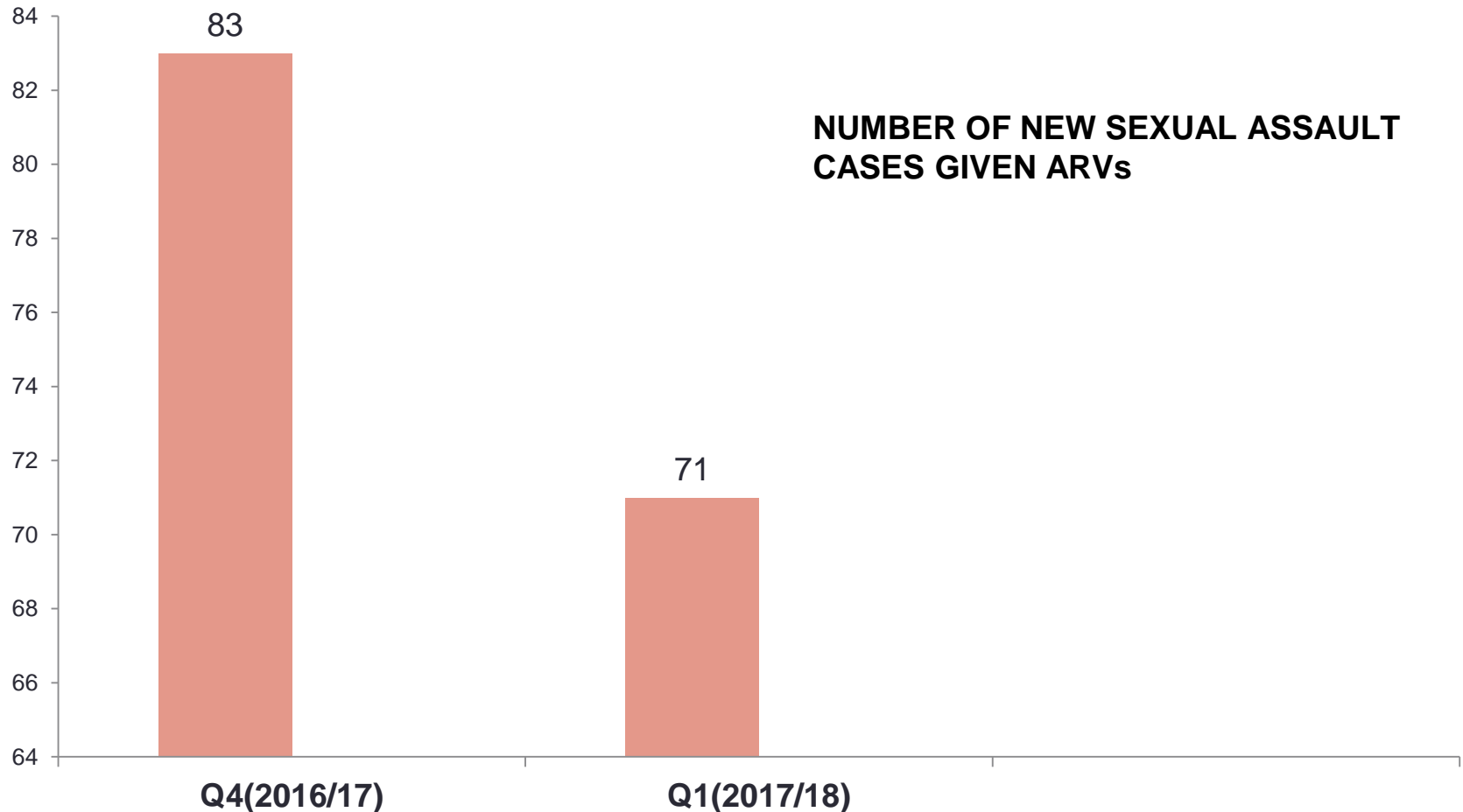

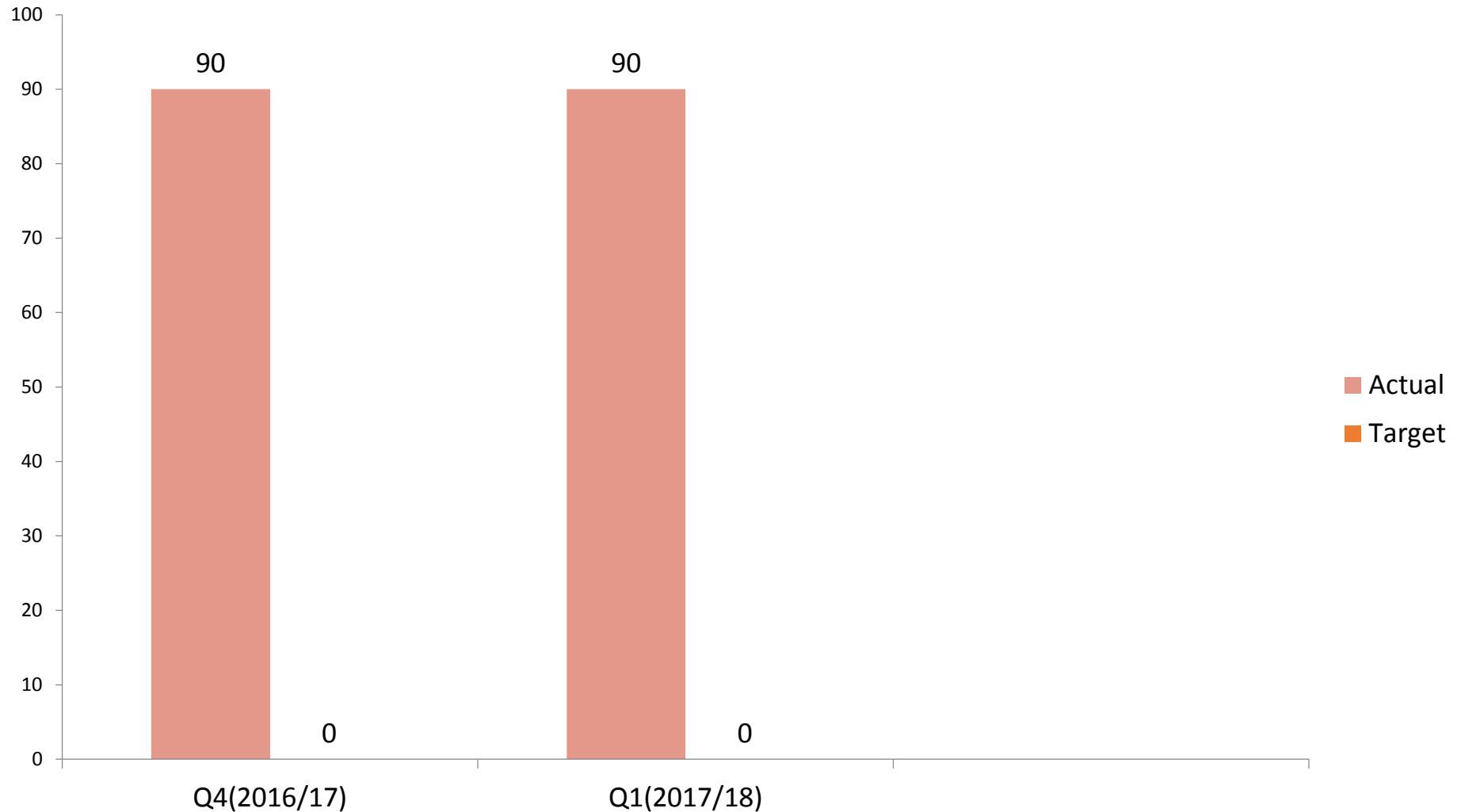

ZULULAND DAC ACHIEVEMENTS

- ❑ DAC meeting for the reporting quarter of April – June 2017 was held on the 13th of June 2017.
- ❑ Four LACs out of five are functional with an exception of AbaQulusi LAC
- ❑ Ulundi LAC has launched its Civil Society, it was done on 06 June 2017. The schedule is in place for the other LMs
- ❑ At least 53 out of 90 War Rooms are functional and OSS is a standing item on the DAC agenda where Task Teams account quarterly
- ❑ DIP+ consultation was done on the 06th of September 2017

CHALLENGES

- ❑ Increasing number of infants dying in our health facilities
- ❑ Delayed staff establishment for DAC secretariat since there is only one staff member responsible for support
- ❑ Non functionality of AbaQulusi LAC
- ❑ Lack of reporting from DOE and Agriculture
- ❑ Poor attendance from Senior Managers of DoE and Arts & Culture
- ❑ Low functionality of Ward AIDS Committees
