- Departments present, briefly provided progress on the implementation of the plan.
- The Social Cohesion and Moral Regeneration plan needs to be factored into the GBV Plan and Department of Arts and Culture will need to indicate how this will happen and be integrated.
- There is a need for workshops with the Amakhosi.
- District task teams need to be strengthened even further by the district development model.
- A GBV Nerve Centre will be set up at the Office of the Premier that will coordinate activities and reports
  from the Districts. The system will be automated at a later stage.
