HIV clients test positive	9 296	2212	There is still a challenge in finding positive cases. The District outreach team has planned to perform testing in targeted hard to reach areas and spots.

# Achievements

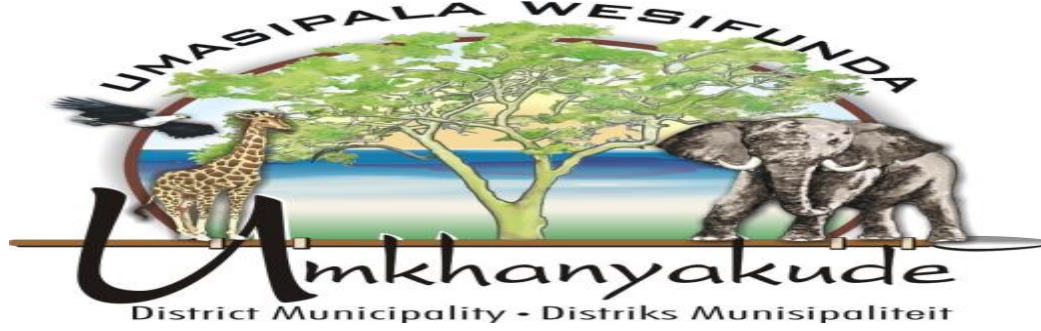
- ▶ Provincial World AIDS Day was successfully held at Hlabisa LM on 1 December 2020
