KZN PREMIER TO CHAMPION A TEAM TO MONITOR THE REOPENING OF SCHOOLS AT

<u>UTHUNGULU</u>

KZN Premier Mr. Senzo Mchunu will lead a delegation to monitor the reopening of schools

on Wednesday, the 21st of January 2015 at UThungulu District which is in northern KZN. This

monitoring function is in line with the theme, 'Doors of Education shall be opened to all,'

which is one of the important pillars of the Freedom Charter.

The objective of this programme is to monitor how schools manage during the first day of

the 2015 academic year, and also monitor the kind of challenges they experience. This visit

will target both good and bad performing schools with the view of getting a firsthand

understanding about the differing school environments, the problems they encounter, and

what seems to be going above board. Schools to be visited include Exhaphozini Primary

School, Mdlamfe High School, Empangeni High School, and others. This monitoring initiative

is part of the oversight function of the KZN Legislature, and the Premier has been tasked to

be the champion of this programme.

The actual monitoring will begin with a briefing at 07:30am, UThungulu Education District

on Wednesday 21 January 2014, and will then culminate with a debriefing at 08:30am,

Friday 23 January 2014. A Stakeholders Meeting which will include school inspectors, school

governing bodies and members of the provincial parliaments will take place at 10:30am Grantham Park Primary School.
