

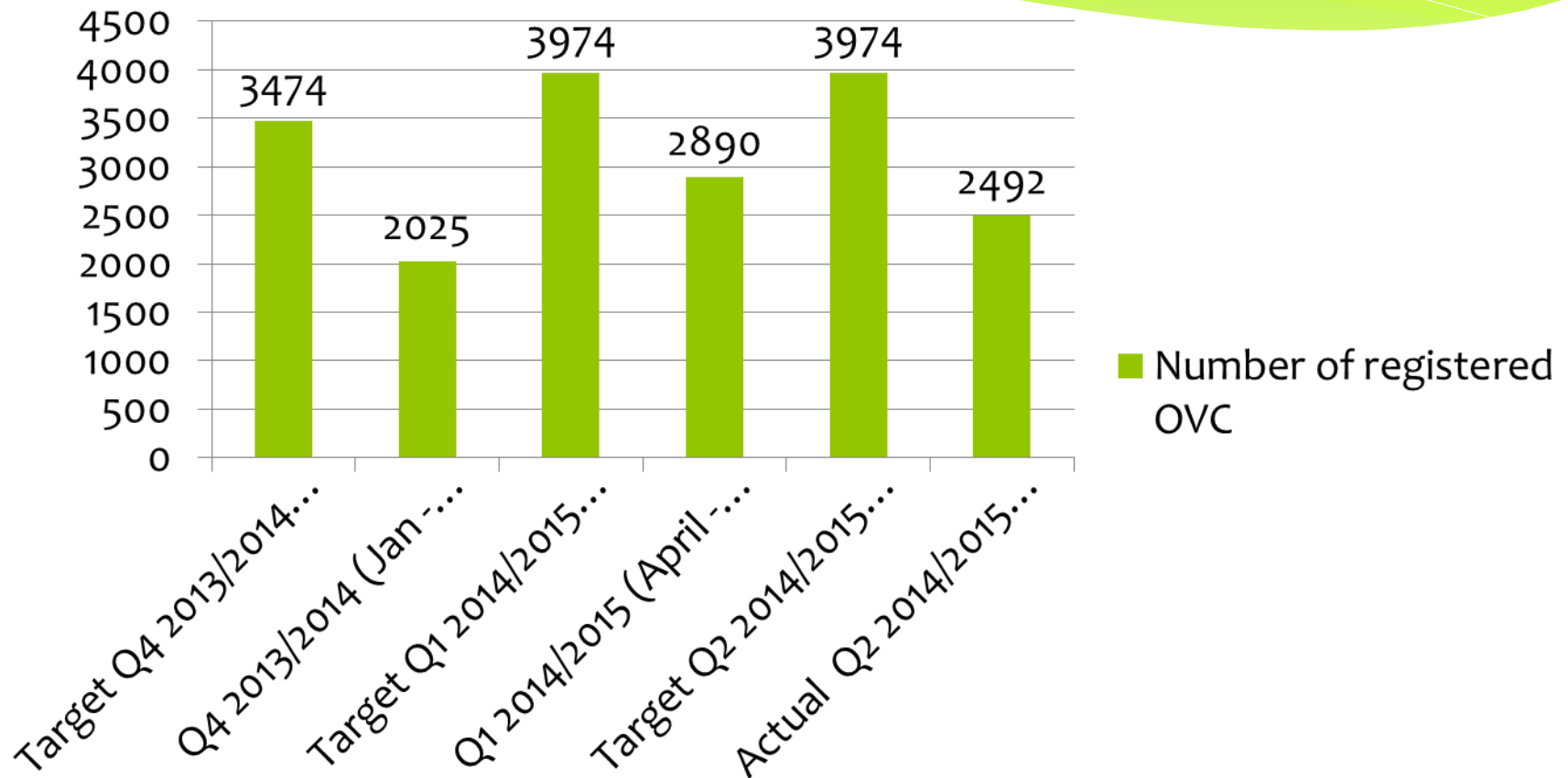

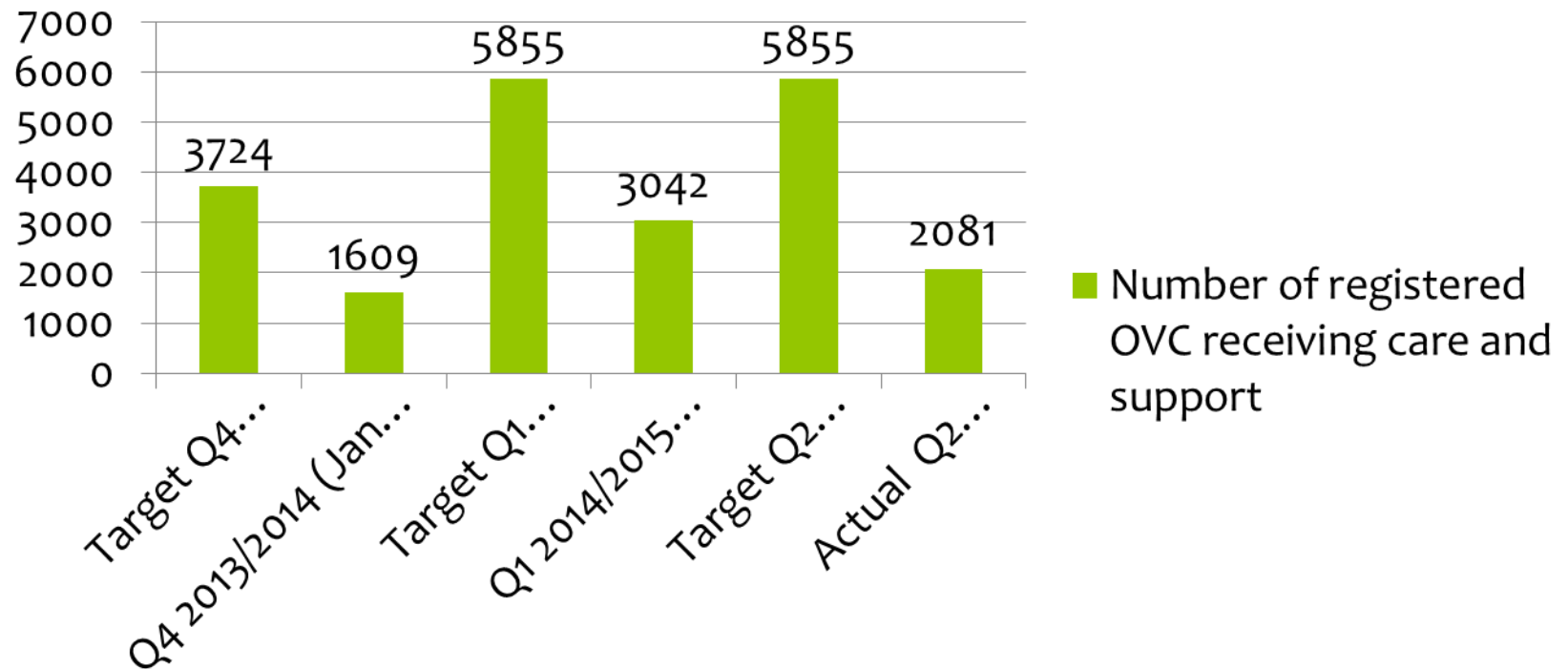

Number of registered OVC receiving care and support

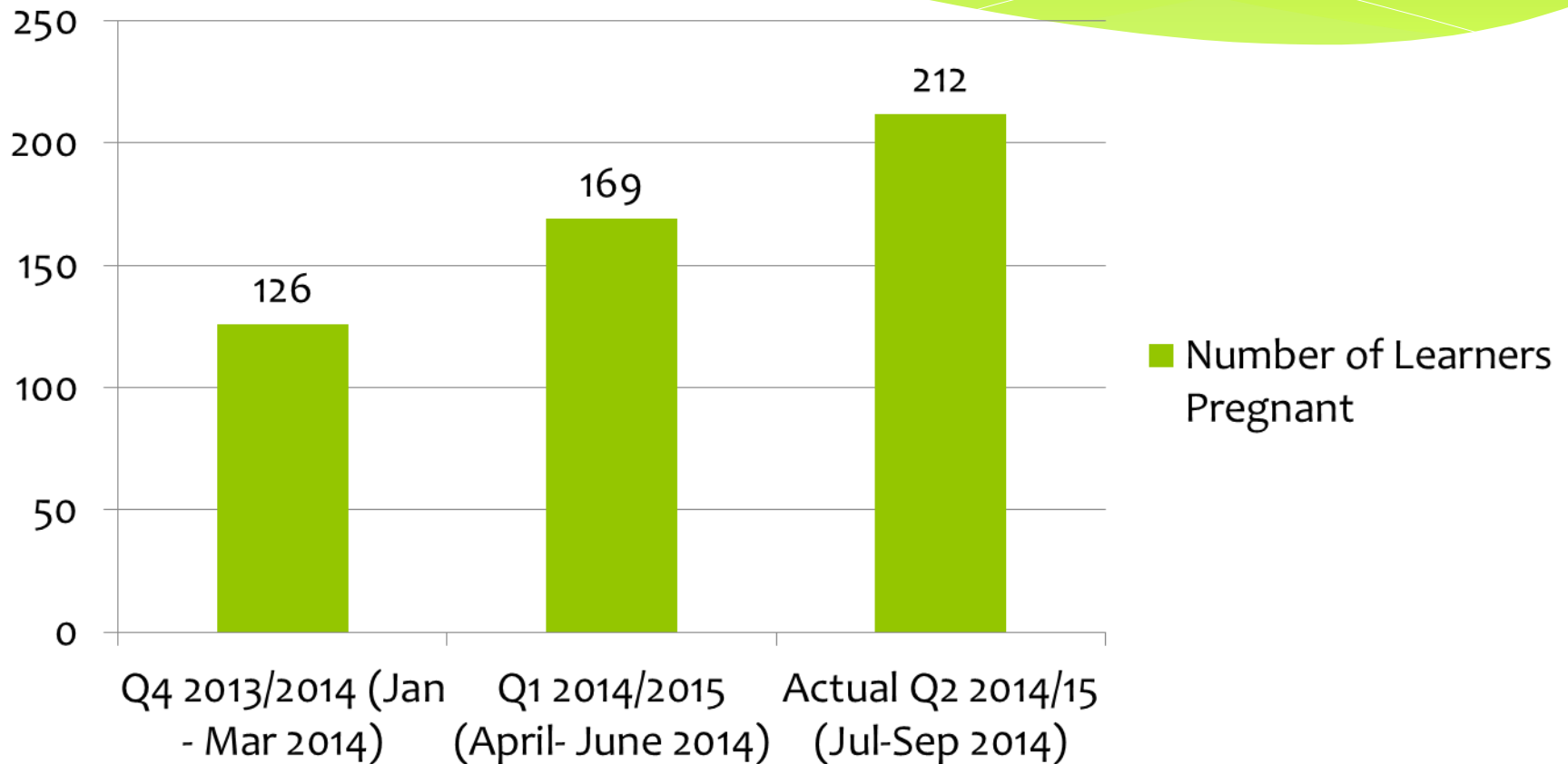


Discussions

Number of Learners Pregnant



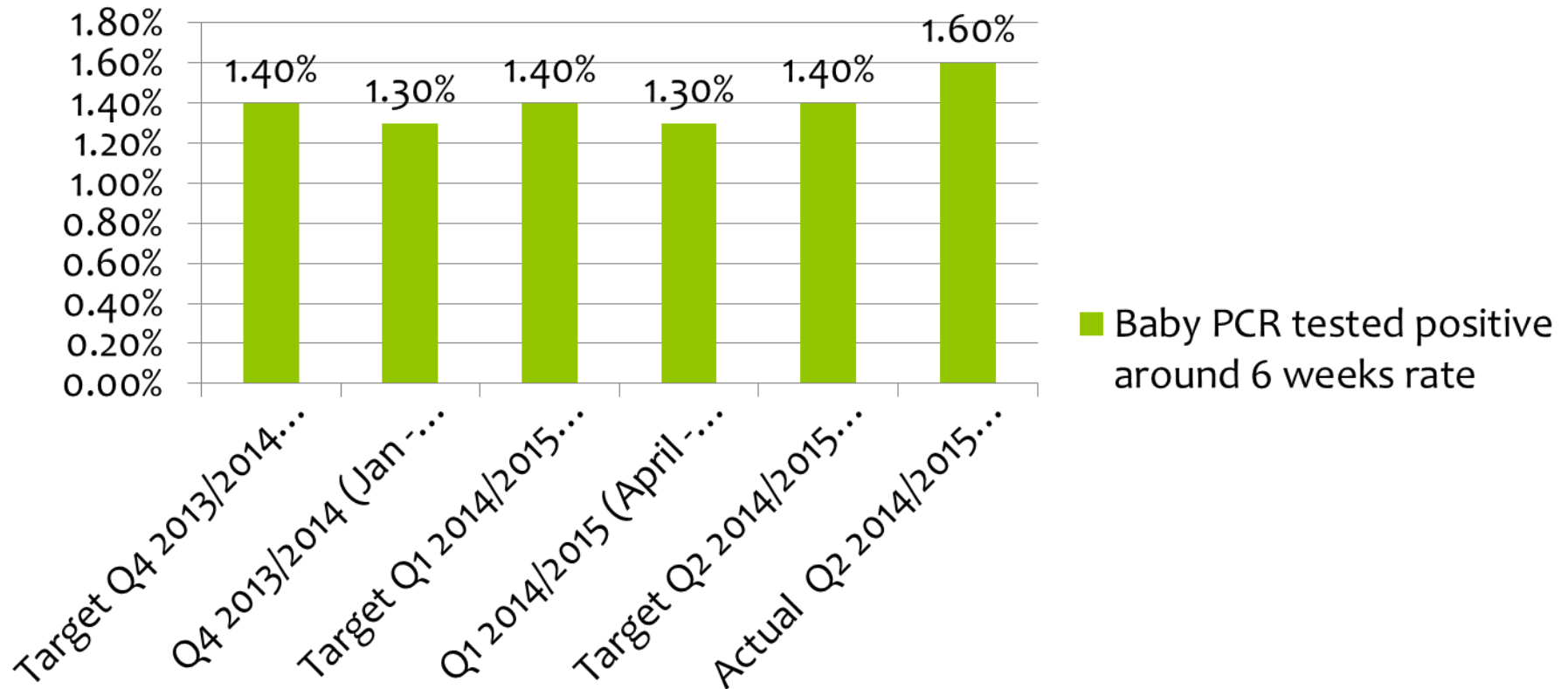
Discussions

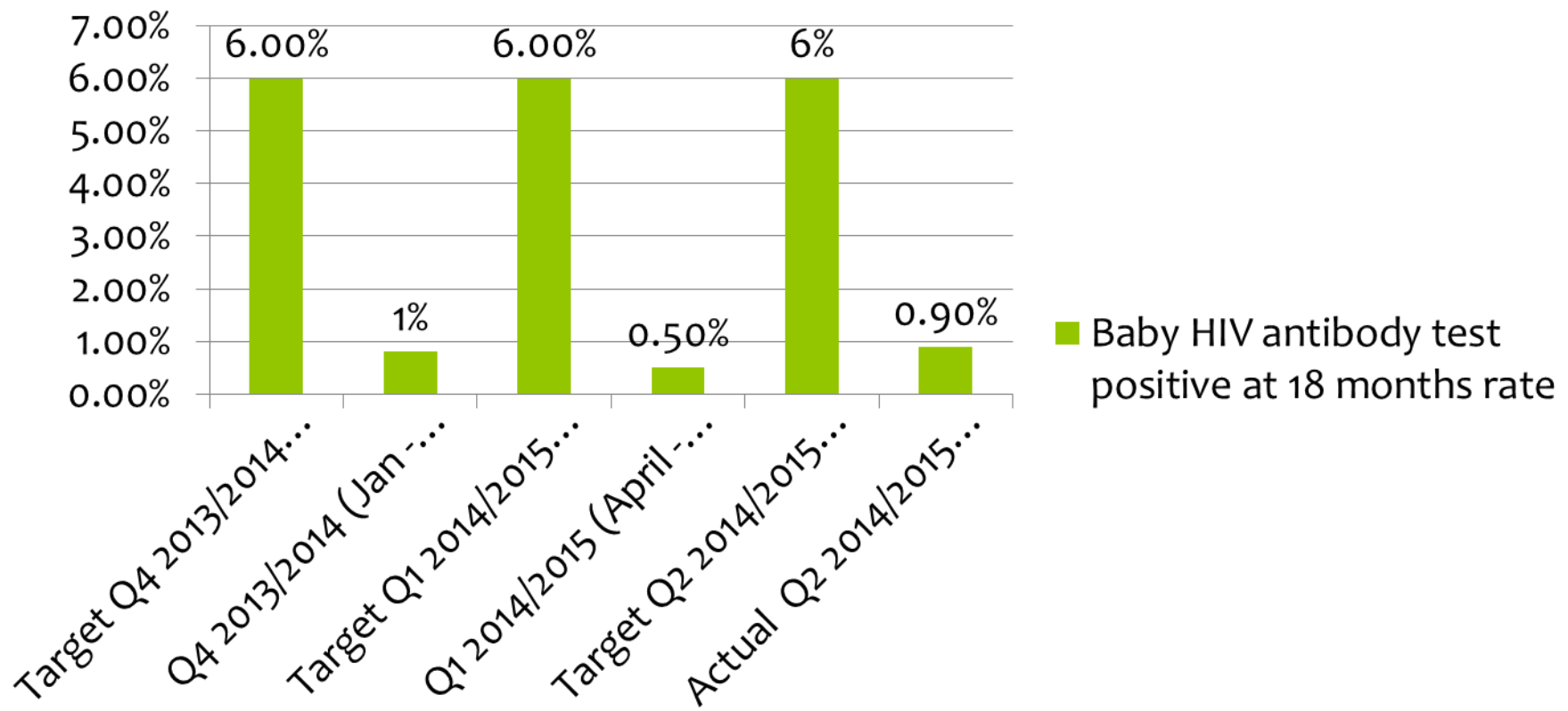
Baby PCR tested positive around 6 weeks rate

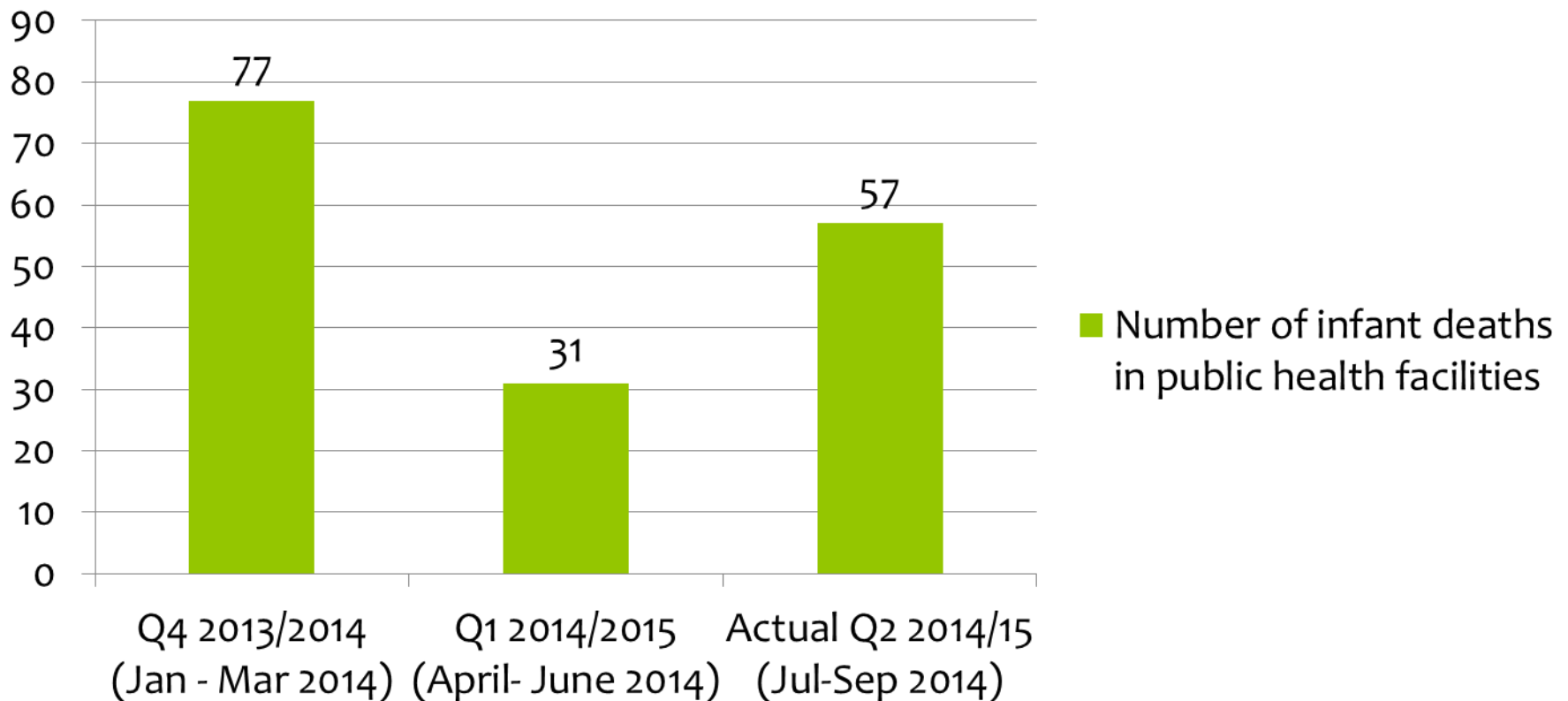

Baby HIV antibody test positive at 18 months rate



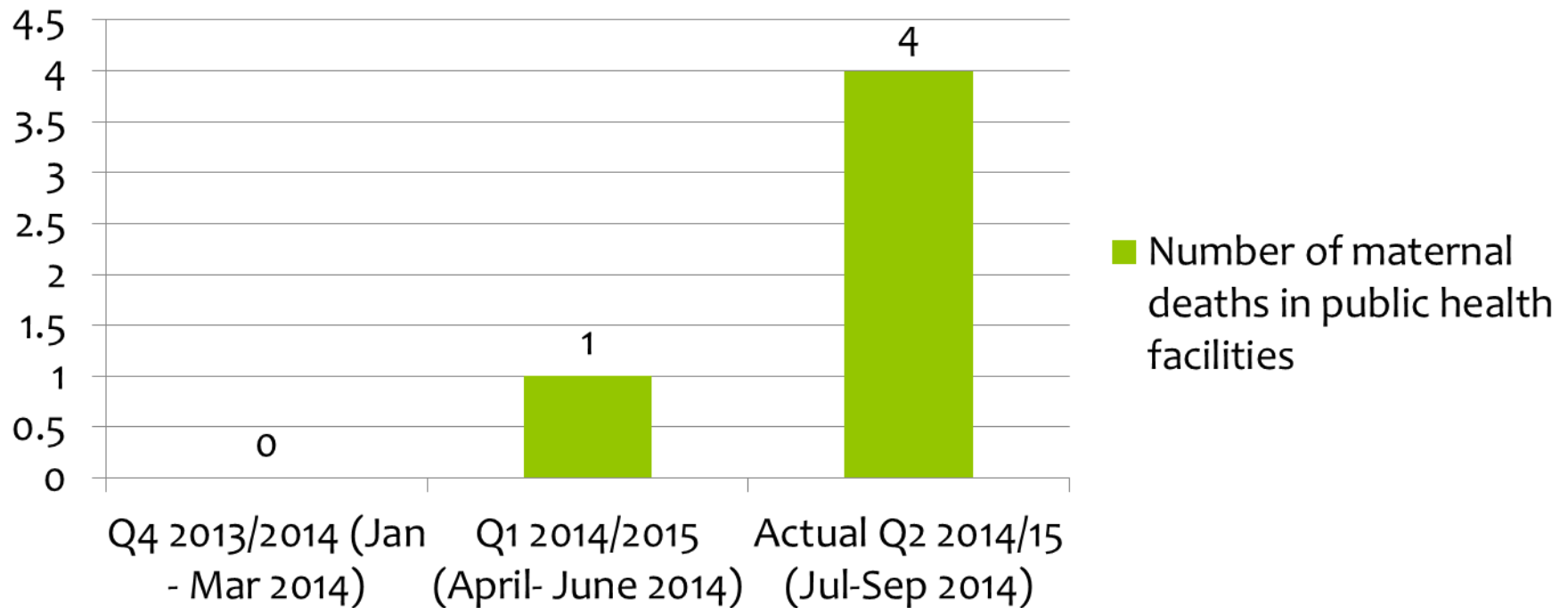

Discussion

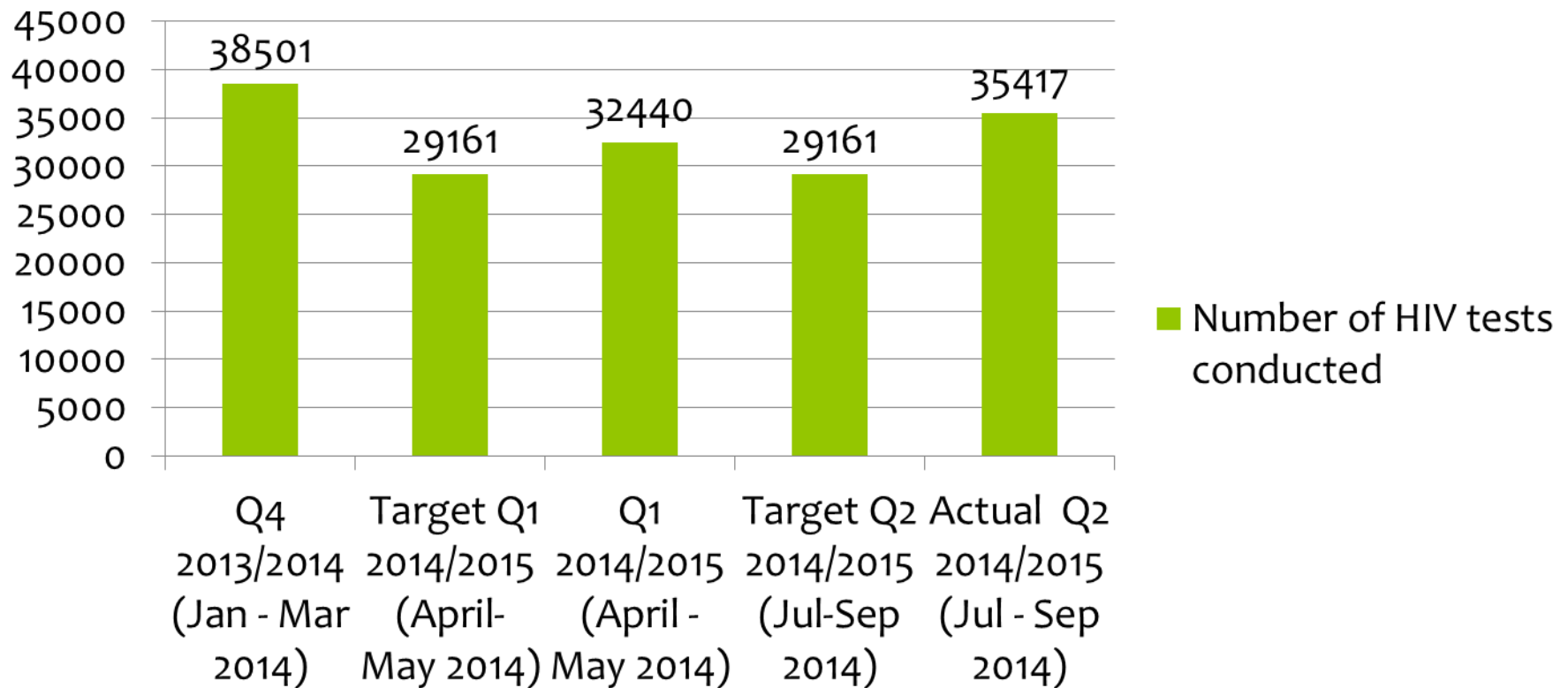
- * Baby PCR positive rate increased from 1.3% to 1.6% this could be attributed to late ANC bookings.
- * Sub-districts performance: Greater Kokstad 2.6%; Ingwe 3%; Ubuhlebezwe 1.9%; Umzimkhulu 1.6%; KwaSani 0%.
- * Cross boarder/ boundaries issues are assumed to be contributing to the increase positivity rate.
- * Baby HIV test positive around 18 months attributed to mix feeding.
- * Maternal deaths : 4 (Greater Kokstad 2, Ubuhlebezwe 2) .
- * Infants death rate increased from 31 to 57
- * Sub-district performance : Umzimkhulu 28 which is 17.3%, Ingwe 12 which is 15.3%, Greater Kokstad 9 which is 11.1% , Ubuhlebezwe 8 which is 4.1%

Recommendations

- * Community mobilization to use MOM connect for improvement of early bookings
- * Community dialogues on infant feeding .

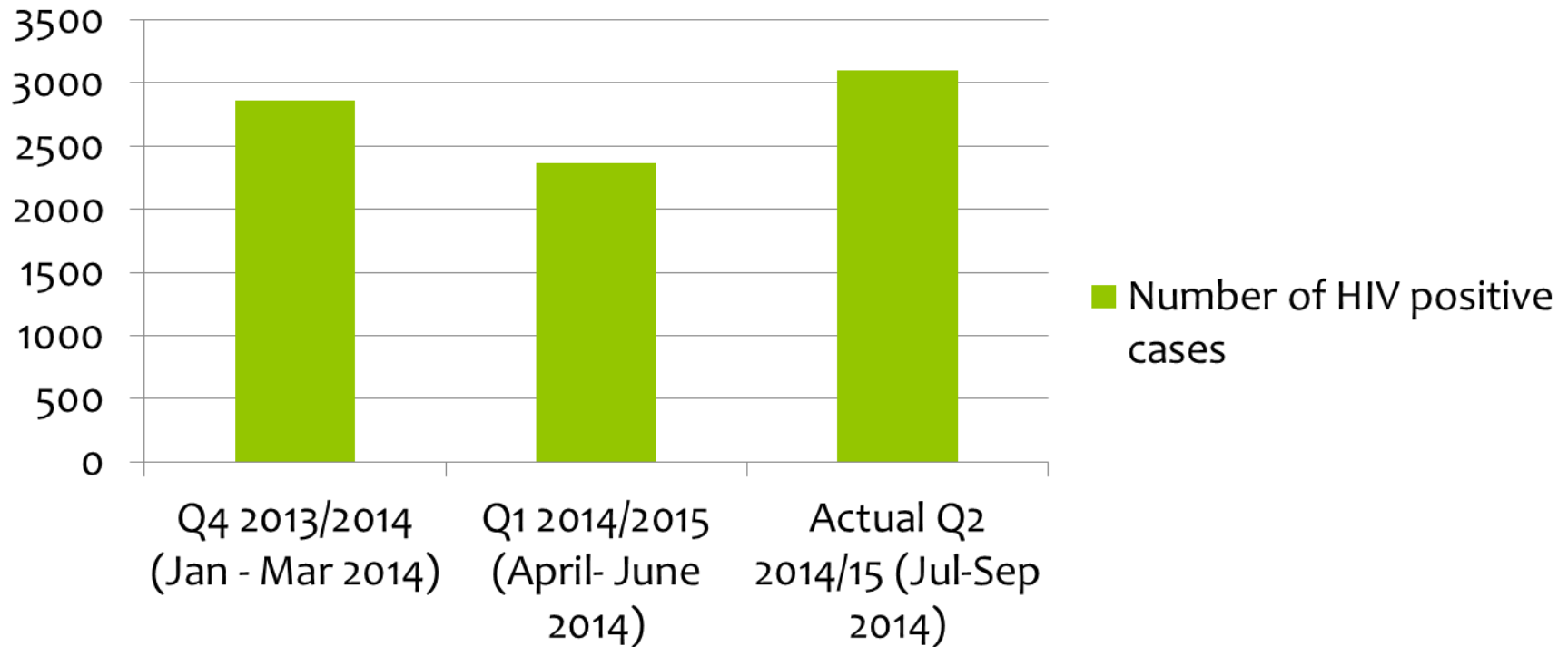
Strategic Objective 2: Prevention of new HIV, STIs and TB Infections HCT & TB Screening

Number of HIV tests conducted



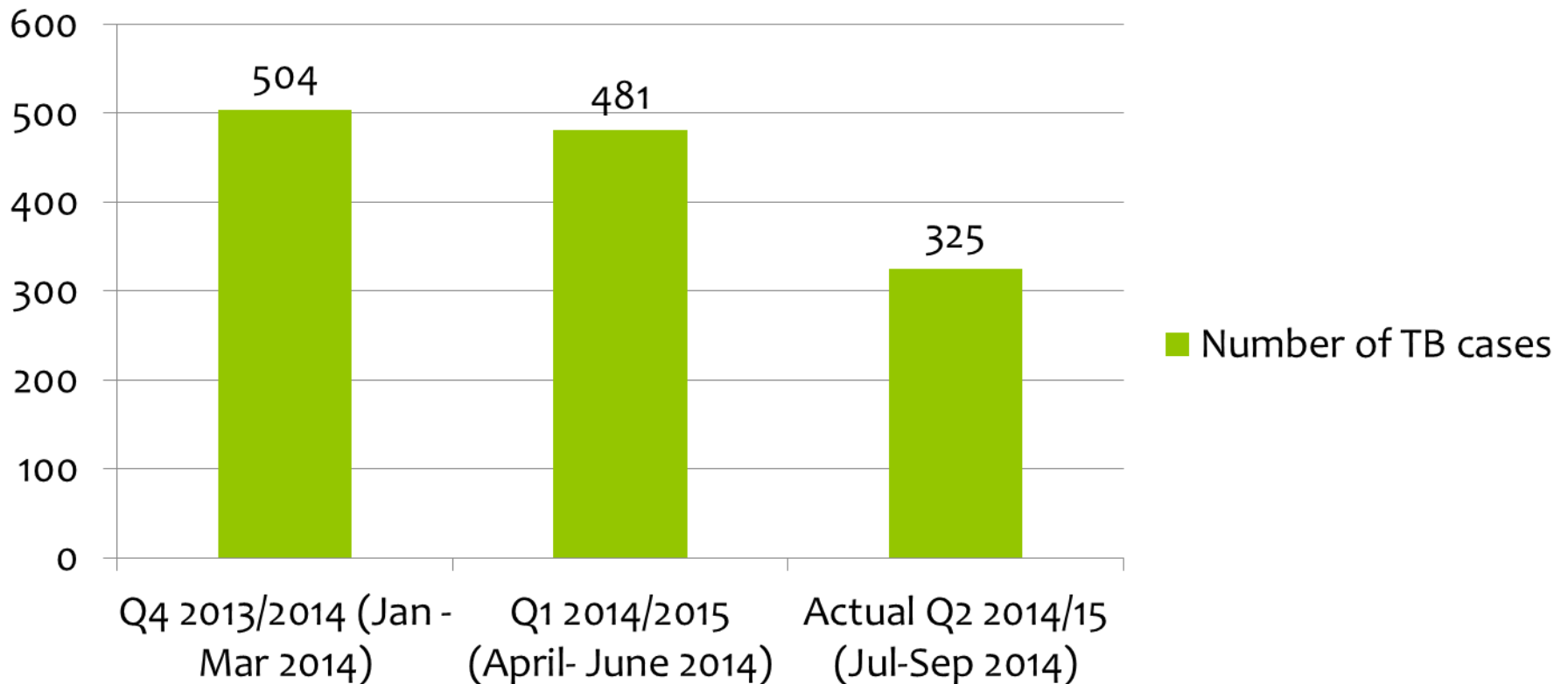

Number of TB cases



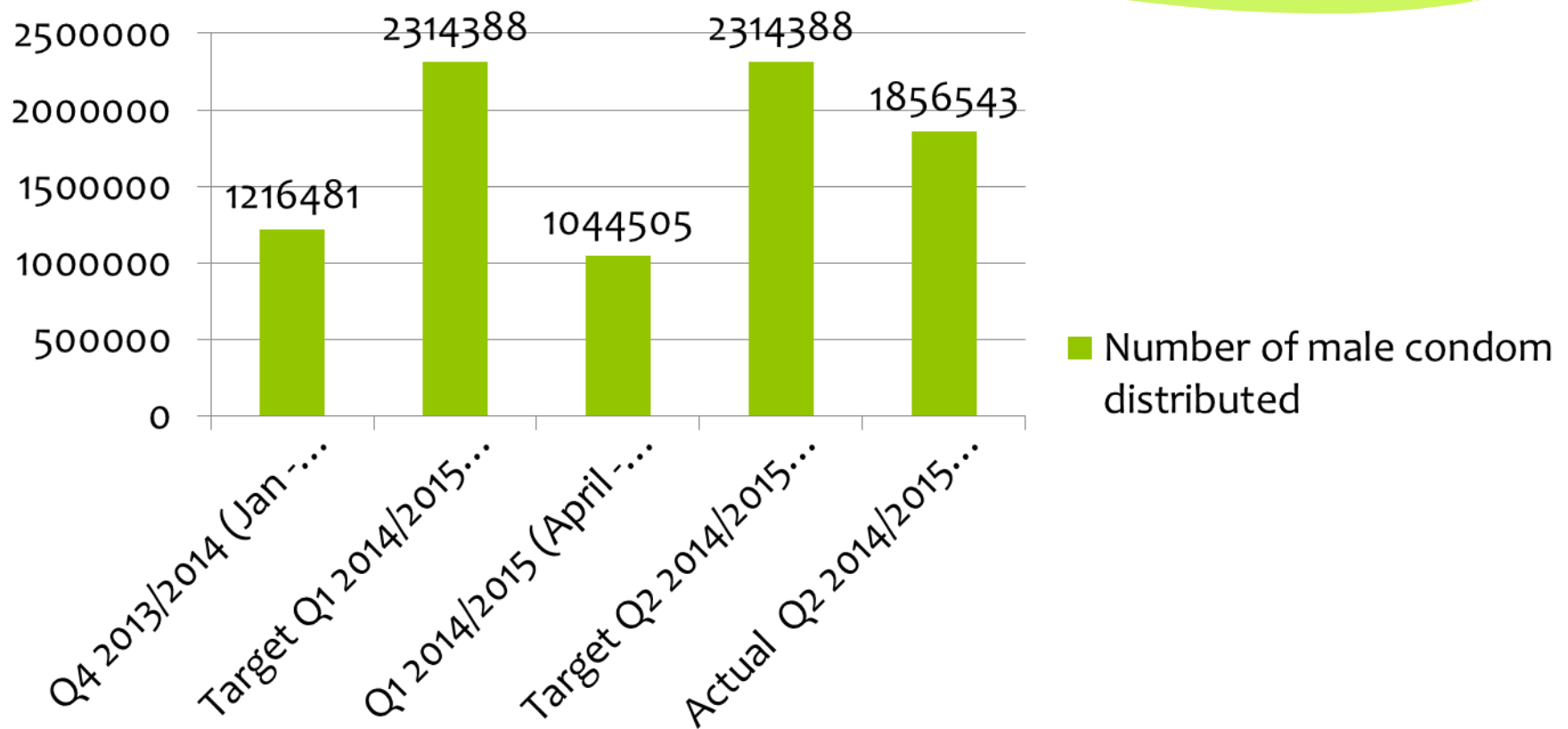
Discussion

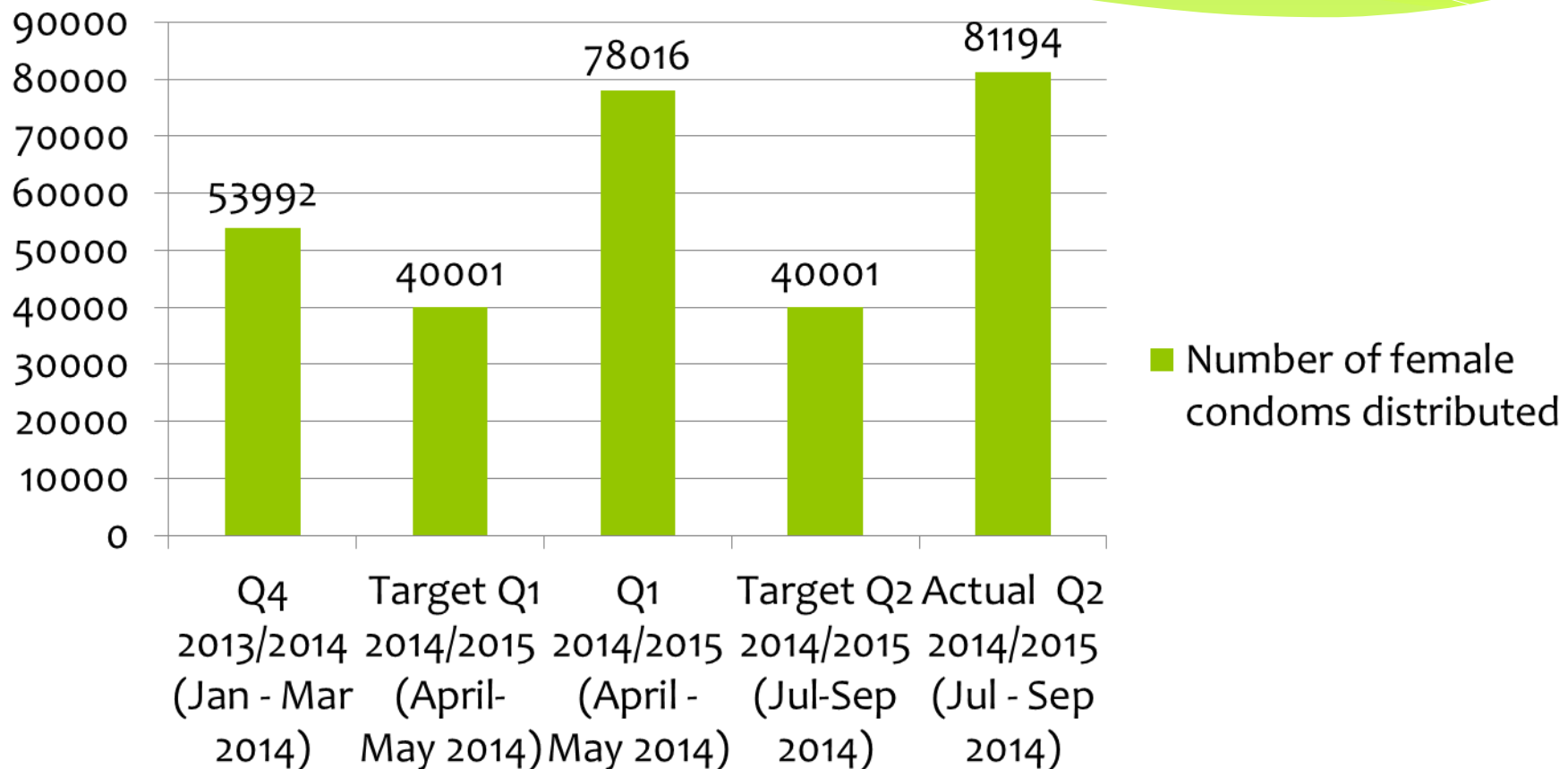
Number of male condom distributed

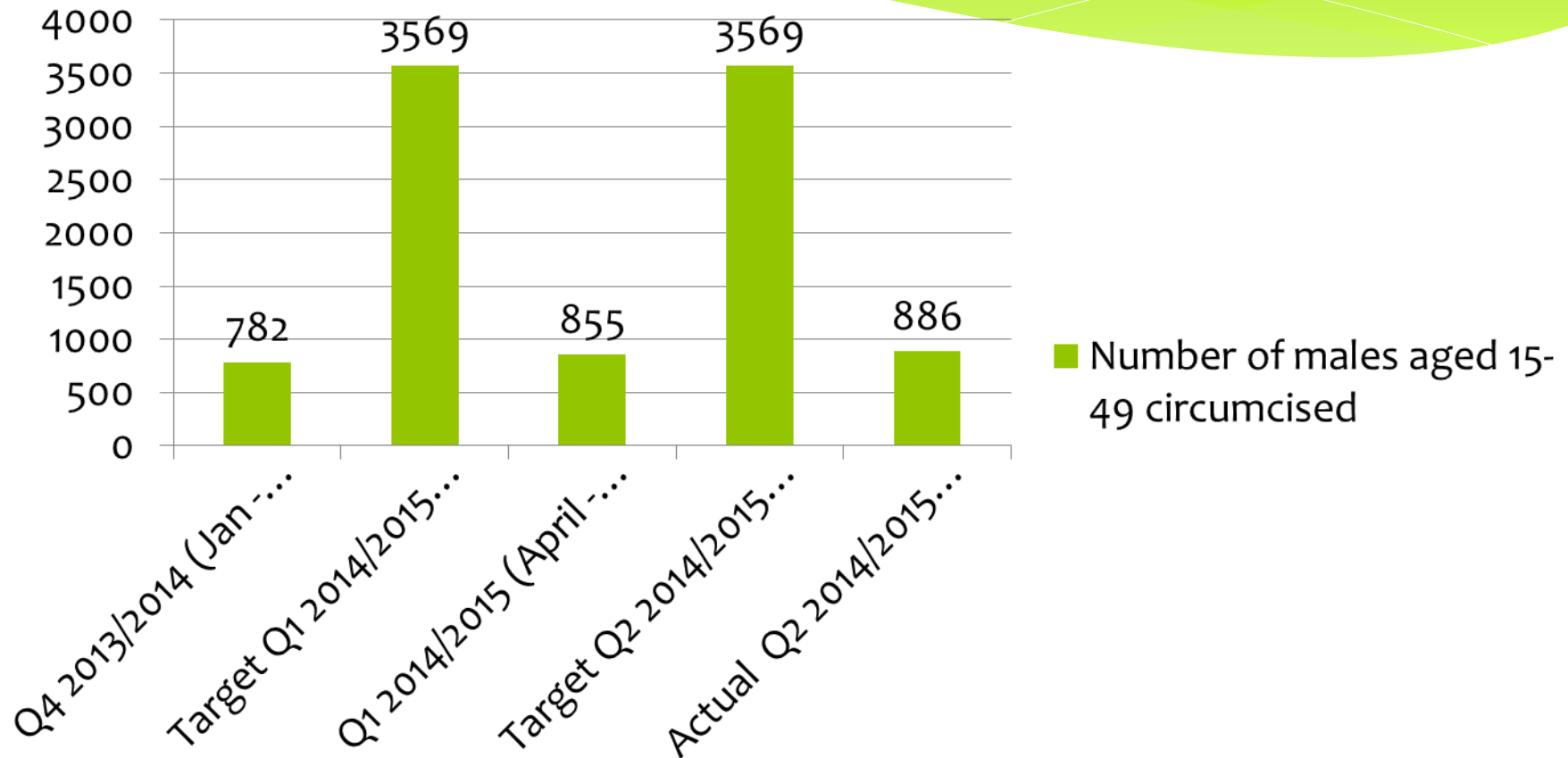

Discussions

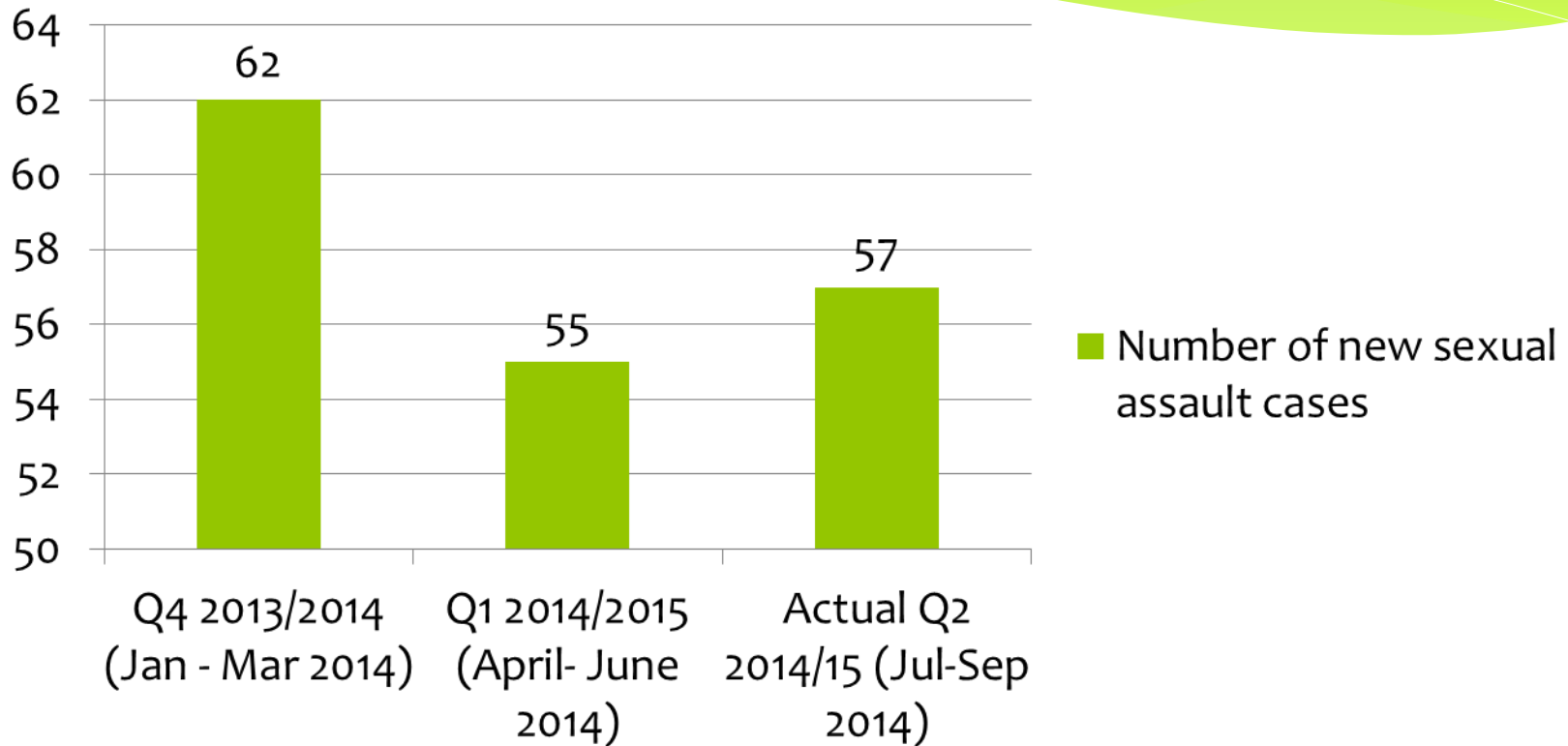
- * Target not achieved.

- * A total of 2007 (All ages) MMC was performed through the support of MMC partners in the district.
- * Training of Doctors on management of complicated cases was done in August 2014.
- * LAC imbizo was done at Ubuhlebezwe in July 2014 all sub-district to conduct LAC Imbizo's.

- * All sub-districts to conduct LAC Imbizo's.

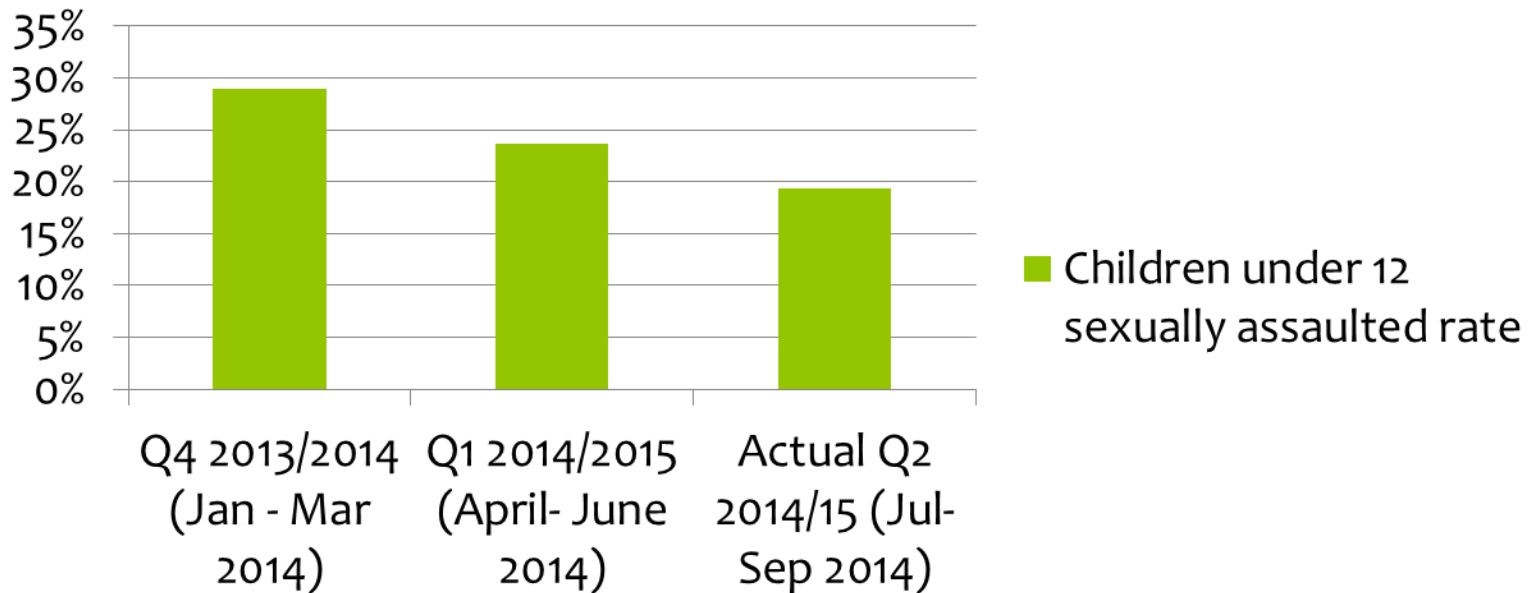

Discussions

- * High number of new sexual assault cases were reported. Greater Kokstad 8, Ingwe 10, KwaSani 1, Ubuhlebezwe 20 and Umzimkhulu 18).
- * Cases reported after 72 hours (Greater Kokstad 2, Ingwe 4, Ubuhlebezwe 9, Umzimkhulu 14)
- * **Recommendations**
- * The use of gender machinery structures.
- * Community dialogues
- * Human rights, women's day, youth month and 16 days of activism campaigns.

Plans for fighting sexual crimes/gender based violence

- * Key social issues that negatively affect our district
 - Sexual assaults
 - Forced Marriages/ Ukuthwala in Umzimkhulu and Ingwe local municipalities
 - Killings of Senior citizens on the allegation of witchcraft particularly at Umzimkhulu local municipality
 - Assaults cases that are still under investigation
 - High level of drugs abuse particularly in Greater Kokstad Local Municipality

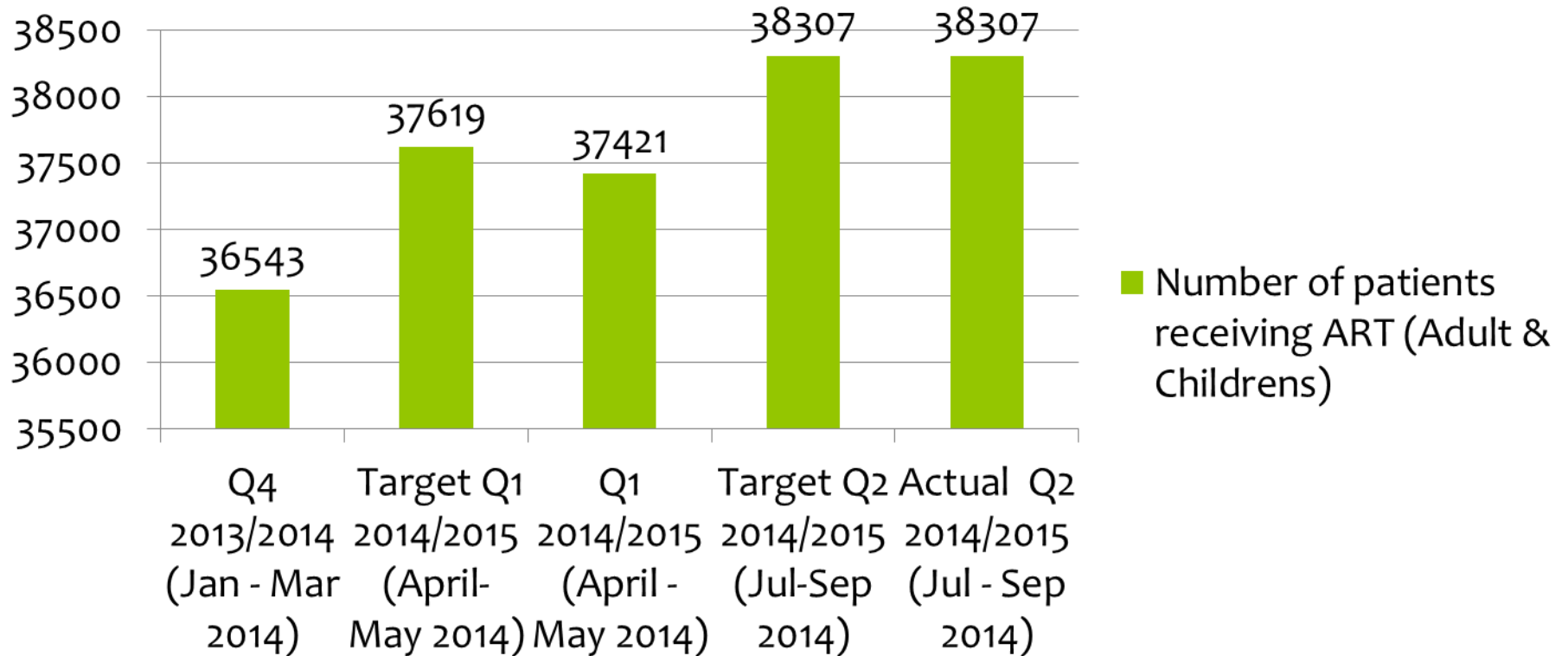

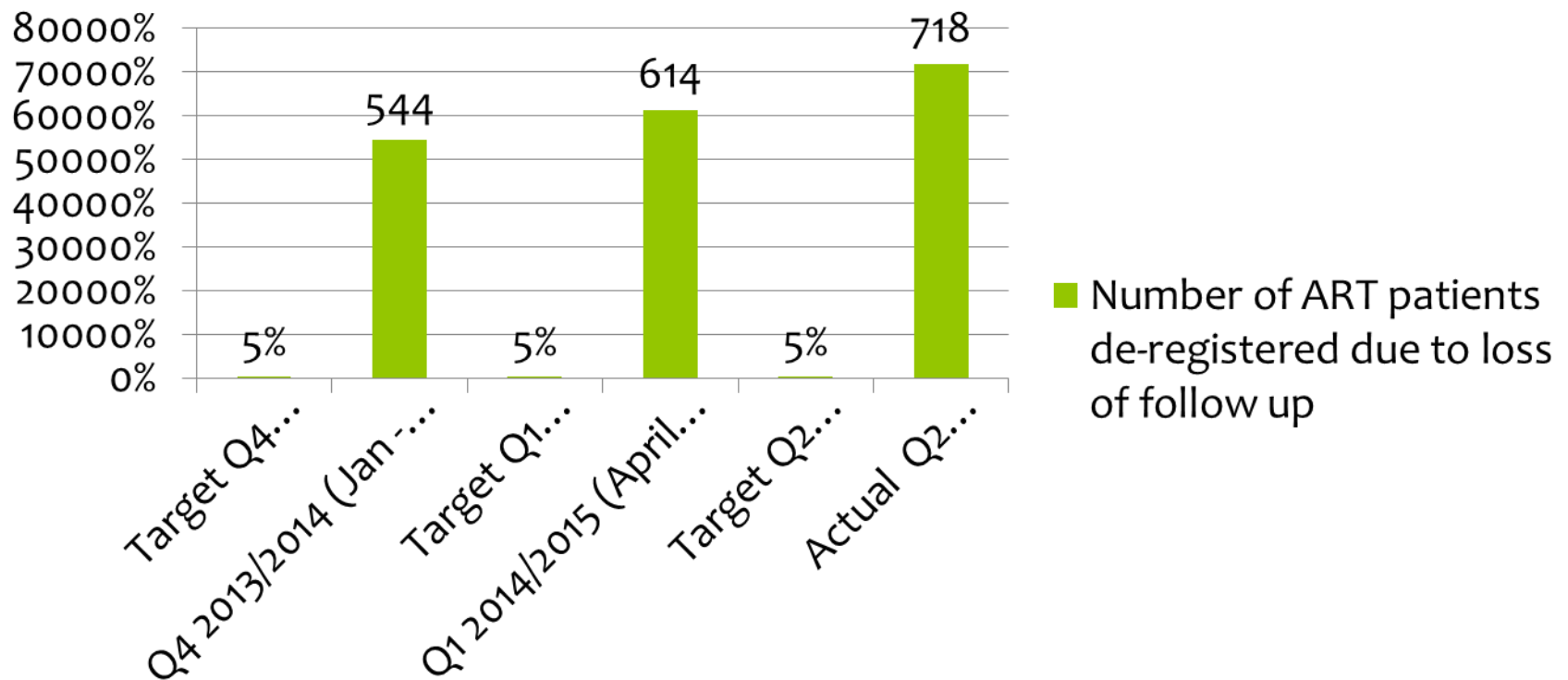

Number of patients receiving ART (Adults & Children)



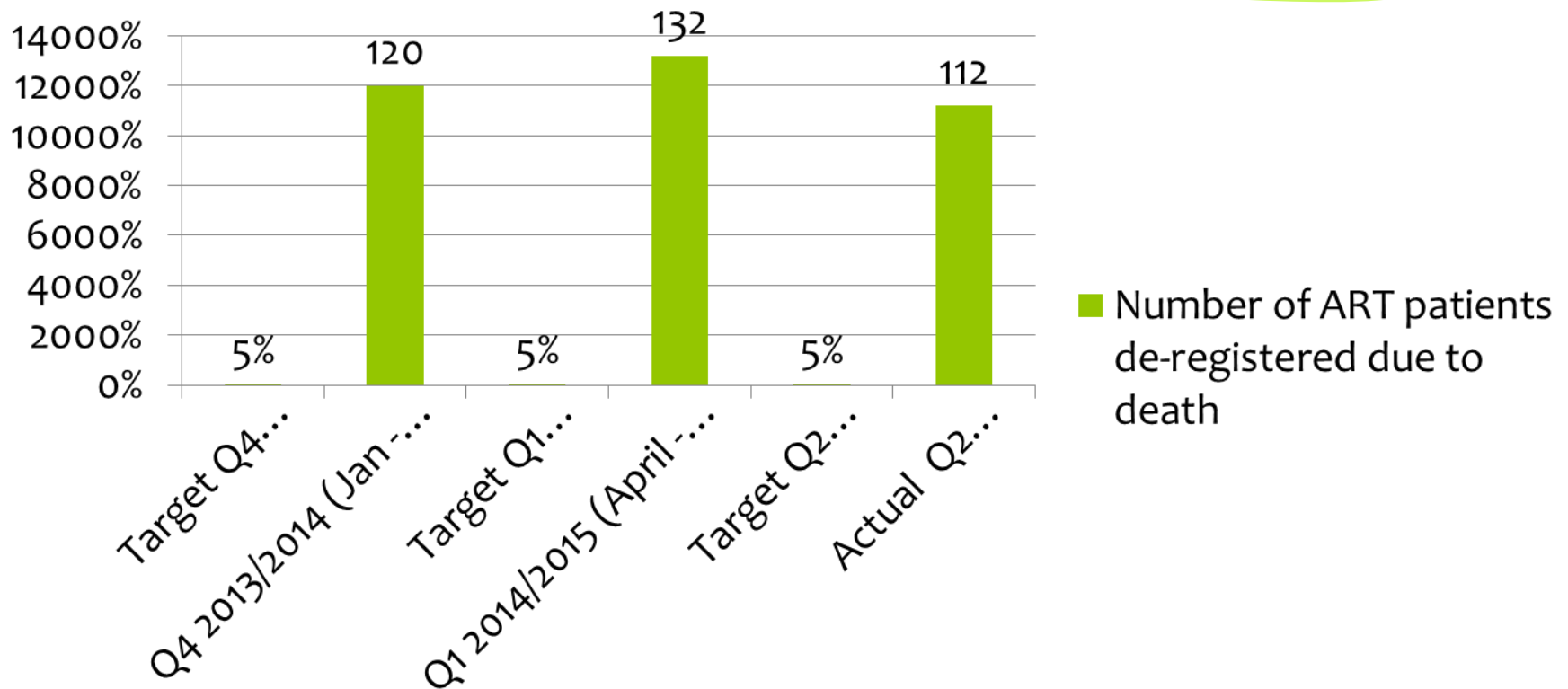

Number of ART patients de-registered due to death



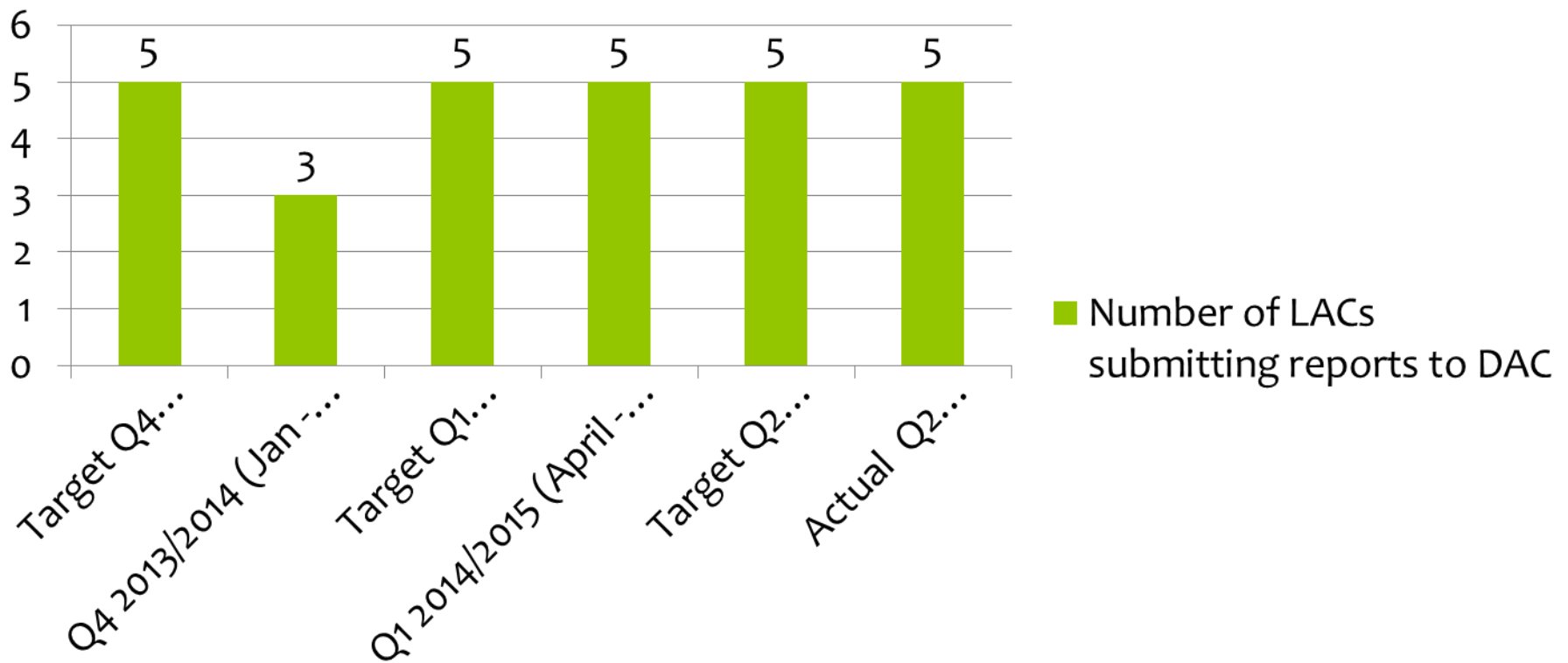
Discussions

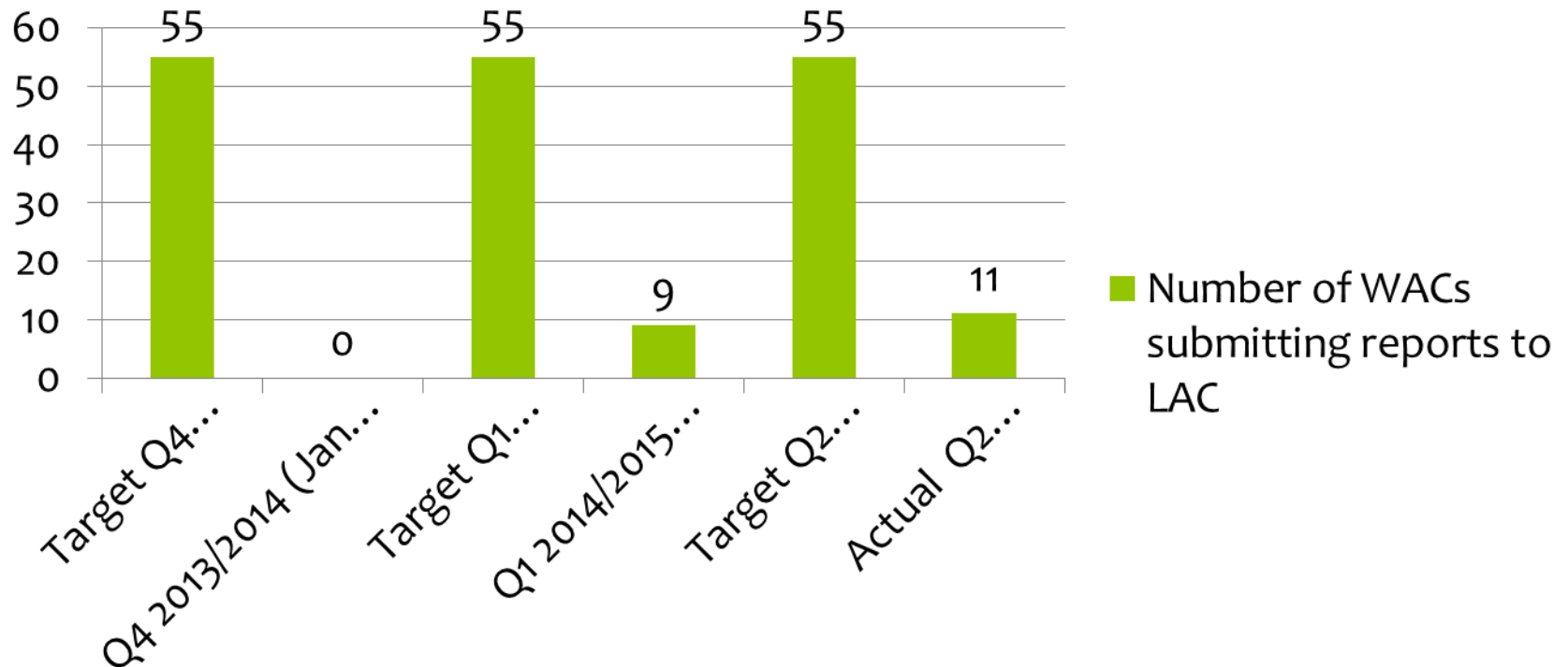
Number of LACs submitting reports to DAC
