Report on issues raised at previous PCA

1.Pregnant women presenting to clinic after 20 weeks of pregnancy for first ante-natal care visit.

- Target of at least 60% of pregnant women presenting to clinic for first visit before 20 weeks still not met.
- Average for 2013/14 52,5%
- Improvement in Q1 of up to 63%

2.Maternal Deaths

 Maternal deaths still high, however a decline in numbers noted from 25 deaths in Q4 to 10 in Q1

Interventions: Strengthened booking before 14 weeks for early identification of pregnancy risks that are main causes .

Strengthened community referrals by CCGs and through women and children targeted campaigns like "Hlola Manje, Phila Ma, Phila Mntwana

Issues raised at PCA...

3. Infant mortality still high

- Infant deaths are still high.
- Much improvement anticipated with more clinicians and community workers trained on Integrated management of childhood illnesses
- Functionality of Phila Mntwana Community centers for early identification of contributory risks

4. Male Medical Circumcision

- Number of males 15-49 circumcised is still low compared to expected targets.
- Slight improvement in Q4 and Q1 though not remarkable.

Interventions: Social mobilizations with combined efforts and involvement of community/ traditional leaders, to avoid non- attendance for planned camps.

5. Condom distribution has decreased.

- Use of condom distributors anticipated to improve distribution
- Acceleration distribution plan for non-medical sites developed and for roll out


Issues....

6.ART patients de-registered due to loss to follow- up still a challenge due to high mobility of patients.

Interventions:

- Functionality of WACs with integrated CCG and OSS activities to help with early identification and referral of defaulters since treatment 'buddy' support is no longer a requirement.
- Engaging Ward based Civil Society Organizations within functional WACs for defaulter tracing.
- This plan to be cascaded as part of operational plan for trained WACs.





Number of deliveries under 18 years




SO2: Number of males 15-49 undergoing male medical circumcision






SO2: Number of new HIV tests carried out



SO2: Number of New positive tests




SO2: TBHIV Positive cases



SO2: Number of male condoms distributed




SO2: Number of Female Condoms Distributed




SO2: Prevention of Transmission from Sexual Violence

No. of New sexual assault cases




SO2: Children under 12years Sexual Assault rate





SO4 & 5

- Coordination of reports from the wards still a challenge as the Zonal AIDS Councils are not yet fully functional.
- Plans to train 71 additional WACs are implemented this month which will result to 79 WACs trained, and improved functionality of ZACs.
