Description

The Chief Directorate of HIV & AIDS has developed this presentation as a result of a resolution passed at the Provincial Council on AIDS (PCA) meeting held on the 17 September 2014 and chaired by the Honourable Premier Mr SE Mchunu. The resolutions arising out of concern for the escalating cases of gender based violence and sexual crimes was as follows:

- The PCA secretariat to collate sexual crimes and sexual cases data and rank districts according to highest cases. The data should include conviction rates.
- The PCA secretariat circulate results to districts
- Districts to look at their data and come up with actionable proposals on curbing this vice.
- Districts to report on their proposals in the next PCA meeting scheduled for November 2014.

Presentation Outline

Information used in developing this analysis is from the Crime Research & Statistics Division of the South African Police Services obtained from the KZN SAPS website and Routine Data as reported by the District AIDS Councils. The presentation provides a summary analysis before presenting the detailed information in tables that includes district specific information the ranking of areas/police stations according to highest number of sexual crimes. The summary analysis presents information on

- Districts with the highest absolute numbers of total sexual crimes reported in the FY 2013/2014
- Districts with highest ranking according to the ratio of a sexual crime per population
- Districts with the highest rankings according to number of sexual assault according to (PEP) data in FY2013/2014 and April-June 2014.
- Districts with highest rankings according to the Children under 12 sexually assaulted rate for FY 2013/2014 and April-June 2014 (PEP)
- Ranking by highest absolute numbers by Area/Police Station by District.

Summary Analysis

- eThekwini has the highest number of total sexual crimes reported in the FY2013/2014, followed by uMgungundlovu, uThungulu and Ugu.
- Ugu ranked highest in terms of a sexual crime per population ratio. It is followed by eThekwini, iLembe and uThungulu.
- In terms of new sexual cases reporting for treatment in FY 2013/2014, eThekwini reports the highest cases followed by uMgungundlovu, uThungulu and Ugu. The ranking follows a similar pattern to total sexual crimes reported to the Police.
- For the period April-June 2014, eThekwini reports the highest cases of new sexual assault cases reporting for treatment, followed by uThukela, Ugu and uThungulu.
- In FY2013/2014, Ugu recorded the highest % of children under 12 sexually assaulted, followed by uThungulu, uMgungundlovu and iLembe.

Summary Analysis

- For the period April-June 2014, uMzinyathi records the highest %, followed by uMkhanyakude and iLembe.
- In all the instances Harry Gwala records the lowest statistics.
- eThekweni has 12 areas in the top 31 highest number of total sexual crimes reported to the police followed by uMgungundlovu at 4, uThungulu-3, uMkhanyakude 2, uThukela-2, iLembe 2, Zululand-3 and Ugu -1.

The table below provides a summary of the highest sexual crime totals as reported to police by area/police station per district
