Introduction

- □ KZN made an application to Global Fund via SANAC to receive grant funding to implement HIV and AIDS interventions.
- ☐ The KZN Provincial Proposal focussed on the following:
 - 1. Health information systems and M&E
 - 2. Prevention programs for adolescents and youth, in and out of school
 - 3. Prevention programs for sex workers and their clients
 - 4. Prevention programs for Men who have sex with Men (MSM) and transgendered (TGs)
 - 5. Treatment, care and support
 - 6. Community System Strengthening (OSS)

Financial Implications

- ☐ The KZN application was for R150 million for normal grant funding
- ☐ In addition, there was an application for R290m for incentive funding. This included the cash transfers of R 200m.
- ☐ The GF Technical Review Committee (TRC) and the Grant Approval Committee (GAC) supported both funding and approved R 440m as normal grant funding
- ☐ The team is currently in the process of finalising the implementation plans, budgets, M&E plan and the Performance Framework
