




Newly registered OVC

What has the District already done:


 The District has identified facilities with positive babies and in-service education on new ART and PMTCT guidelines has be done.


Deaths due to AIDS are gradually declining

Under 12 sexual assault remains a challenge. The graph shows an increase in Q2 from 39% to 41.6% in Q3.



Medical Male Circumcission



Target for Q1-3 = 174 552 Achieved Q1-Q3 = 184 076 (105.4%) District target was reached



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

Male Condom Distribution



Quarter 3 target was not reached.

- Ensure that all sub-districts have condom service providers to distribute condoms to grey areas.
- Continuous monitoring of condom distribution by health facilities and other stakeholders.
- Form partnerships with NGOs, traditional leadership, traditional health practitioners and business sector on condom distribution.
- Each community field worker to distribute 200 male condoms per day.
- 50 condoms will be pre-packed with medication for all PHC clients.
- Social mobilization on condom use by all government departments
- Strengthening of proper recording of all distributed condoms by different stakeholders.
