KZN HIV and TB Epidemic profile

- 1.8 million people are HIV positive
- 62,000 new HIV infections every year
- Approximately 500 adolescent girls and young women are infected with HIV weekly
- Over 1 million people are on antiretroviral therapy
- TB incidence is 678 per 100,000
- TB is the leading cause of death among People living with HIV



NSP Goals 2017 - 2022

- Accelerate prevention to significantly reduce new HIV, TB and STI infections
- 2. Address the social and structural drivers of HIV, TB, STI infections and linking them to NDP goals
- 3. Reduce morbidity and mortality by providing easy access to treatment, care and adherence support for all




NSP Goals 2017 - 2022

- 4. Reach all key and vulnerable populationswith customised or focussed and targeted interventions
- 5. Protect human rights, increase access to justice and reduce stigma and discrimination
- 6. Mobilise leadership at all levels and promote shared accountability for a sustainable response to HIV, TB and STIs


