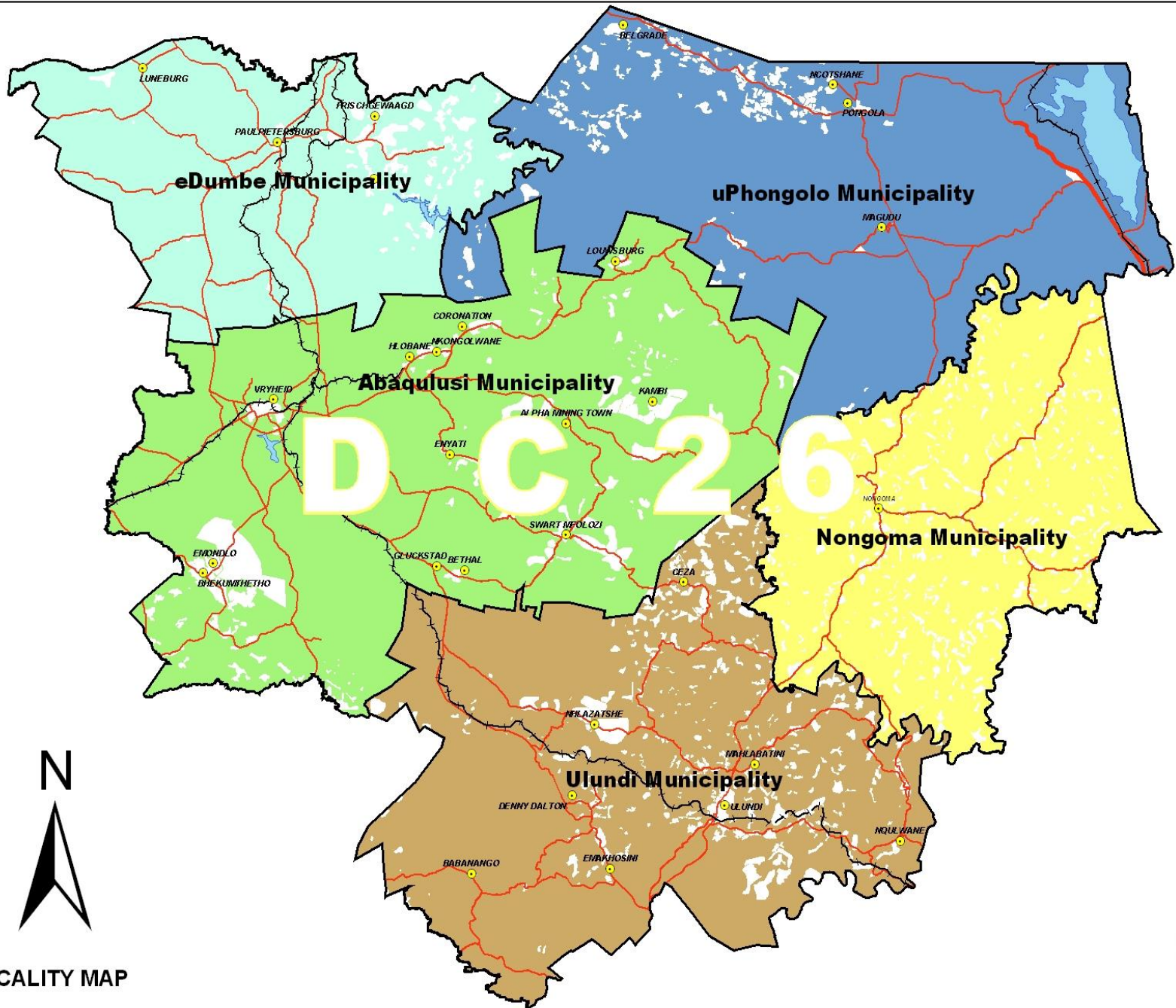

OVERVIEW OF ZULULAND DISTRICT

- ❑ Zululand is comprised of 05 local municipalities and they are distributed as follows;
- ❑ Ulundi - 24 wards
- ❑ AbaQulusi - 22 wards
- ❑ Nongoma - 21 wards
- ❑ uPhongolo - 15 wards &
- ❑ eDumbe - 08 wards
- ❑ The District has 90 wards in total with an estimated population of 803 575

ZULULAND DAC ACHIEVEMENTS

- ❑ Zululand DAC had its first meeting in this new term on the 11th of October 2016 and the second was held on the 13th of June 2017.
- ❑ Four LACs out of five are functional with an exception of AbaQulusi LAC
- ❑ At least 70% of members attended the first meeting though there was noticeable poor attendance with the second meeting where one Mayor attended.
- ❑ Ulundi LAC has launched its Civil Society, it was done on 06 June 2017. The schedule is in place for the other LMs
- ❑ About 85% of our War Rooms are functional and OSS Task Teams account to DAC quarterly

STAFFING & BUDGET

- ❑ There is currently one middle manager permanently serving the DAC and is also responsible for secretariat
- ❑ Budget allocation is R350 000.00 for financial year 2016/17
- ❑ Ulundi LAC 2 dedicated staff
- ❑ eDumbe LAC with 2 staff members
- ❑ Nongoma 2 staff members
- ❑ uPhongolo 1 member
- ❑ AbaQulusi no dedicated secretariat or coordinator

CHALLENGES

- ❑ Delayed staff establishment for DAC secretariat since there is only one staff member responsible for support
- ❑ Non functionality of AbaQulusi LAC
- ❑ Poor reporting from DOE and Agriculture
- ❑ Poor attendance from Senior Managers of DoE and Arts & Culture
- ❑ Low functionality of Ward AIDS Committees
