# eThekweni Report

**Brief Summary June 21, 2017**

# Demographics

- 7.1 million people are infected with HIV in South Africa
- Only 3.6 million are on ART
- KZN has 1.9 million people living with HIV
- Only 1.1 million on ART
- There are 650 000 people living with HIV in eThekweni
- However, approximately 367 425 people are on ART

# Successes

- DAC meetings take place quarterly with support from Mayor's office
- Good working relationship with eThekweni Civil Society
- The target for number of HIV tests conducted is exceeded in all quarters, this is partly due to increased engagement and community based testing by government and various development partners
- Mapping of Dreams funded partners and those doing She Conquers into specific wards has been concluded, so that they report quarterly on activities in the wards
- She Conquers Steering Committee has been formed by lead departments, Department of Social Development, Department of Basic Education, Department of Health and eThekweni Metro.
- To date a total of 213 986 Adolescent Girls and Young Women have been covered with various behavioral interventions
- Nerve Centre meetings take place quarterly where all role-players meet to discuss the district performance and strategies to address gaps.

# Challenges

- **Medical Male Circumcision** performance, district is unable to meet set targets. A turn around strategy being implemented:
  - 250 mobilizers have been engaged to do demand creation
  - Six PHC clinics to provide MMC daily, and including Saturdays.
  - Focus is more on densely populated areas (CRUs or hostels, informal settlements etc)
- **Learner pregnancy** statistics: It is still impossible to access these stats from Department of Basic Education on quarterly basis.
- **Shortage of Condoms**
  - There has been infrequent supply of condoms especially experienced in both 3 and 4
- **Sexual Assaults** especially children under 12 years, stands at 293 reported cases in quarter 4
- **Orphans and Vulnerable children** receiving care and support, more efforts to cover all OVCs in the districts using Dreams partners

# Challenges

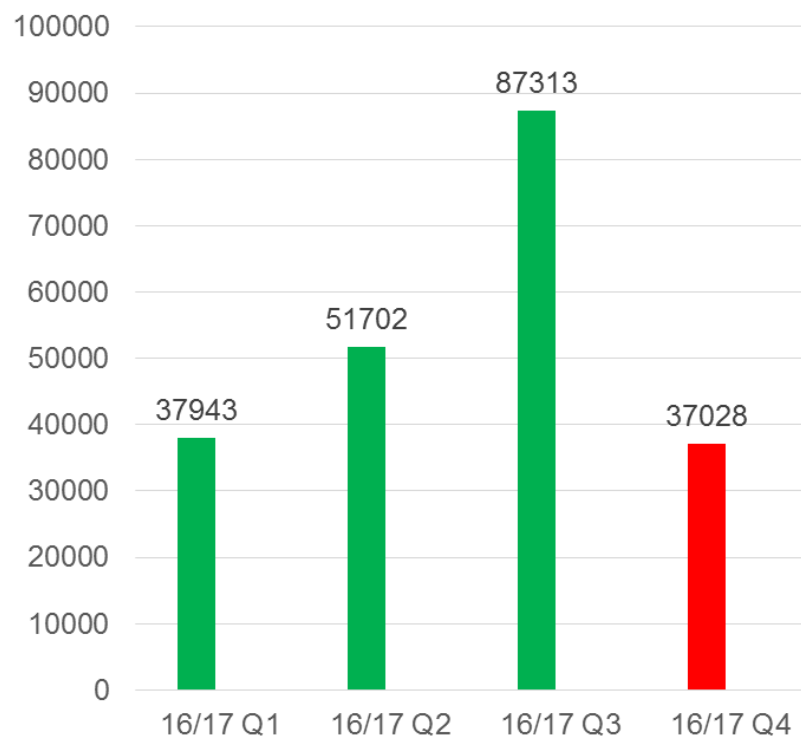
- **Dreams reporting system** is problematic, stats emanating from this system is not in line with what is captured
- **Partners** funded to work in the district and yet they are based outside the district or province
- Some partners are not working with local structures like War rooms, WACs and CCGs.

# She Conquers

- National HIV prevention program targeting AGYW between 10 – 24 years and their partners – total of **213 986** were covered from Q1 to Q4.

## Objectives:

1. Decrease new HIV infections in adolescent girls and young women  
(decrease by at least 30% from 90 000 per year to less than 60 000)
2. Decrease teen pregnancies  
(decrease <18 deliveries from 73 000 by at least 30% to 50 000)
3. Keep girls in school till matric  
(increase retention by 20%)
4. Decrease sexual and gender based violence  
(decrease by 10% )
5. Increase economic opportunities for young people,(increase youth employment by 10%)
