KEY ACTVITIES FOR THE QUARTER

- HIV and AIDS District Multi-sectoral Implementation Plan is being finalised.
- Conducted 8 HIV and AIDS awareness campaigns in the community, schools and farm dwellers.
- 12 NPOs have been funded with a sum of R10 000 each to implement HIV and AIDS programme
- Distributed 800 nutritional supplements to LMs and NGOs
- Conducted training on WACs and war rooms in Ray Nkonyeni
