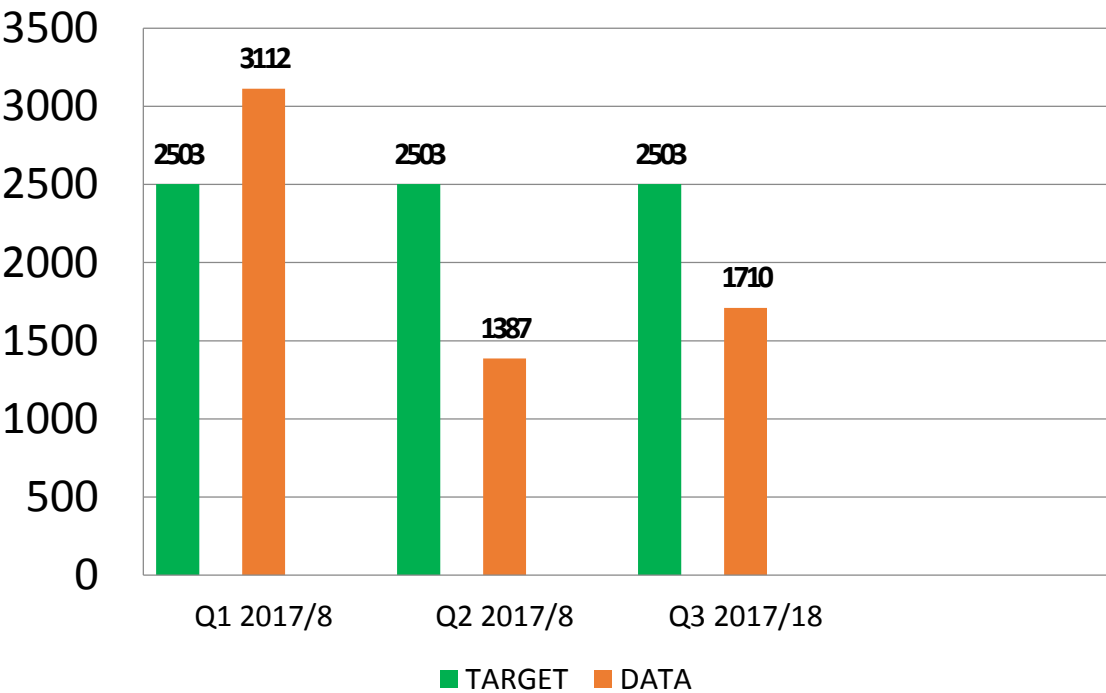
DISCUSSIONS

- Target less achieved as most social workers were on vacation leave resulting to less children identified at home community based care programmes.

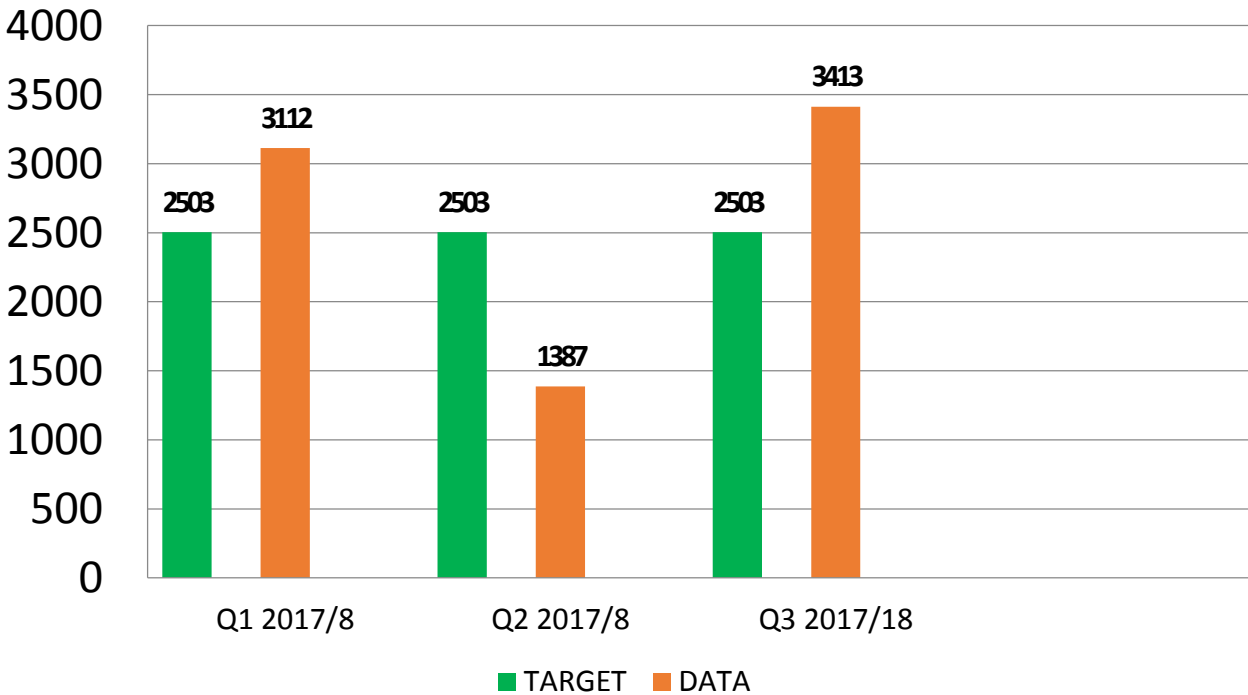
RECOMMENDATIONS

- To identify more in the last quarter through our field workers, CCGs, child and youth workers.

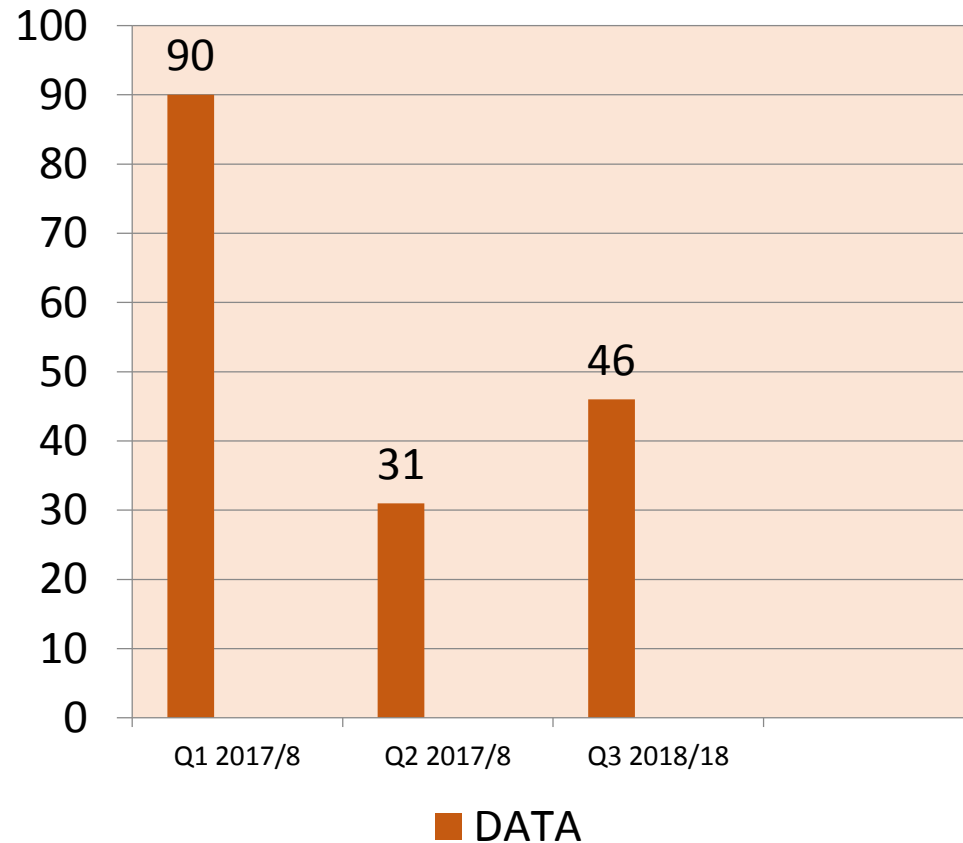
Number of Register OVC

DISCUSSIONS

- Learner pregnancy have increased compared to previous reporting quarter.
- Some Local Municipalities still having a challenge to access information in this data element.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Strengthen AYFS (adolescents and youth friendly services) in all facilities.
- Stakeholders to attend war-room meetings especially DOE for the WACs to eaccess number of pregnant learners.

DISCUSSIONS

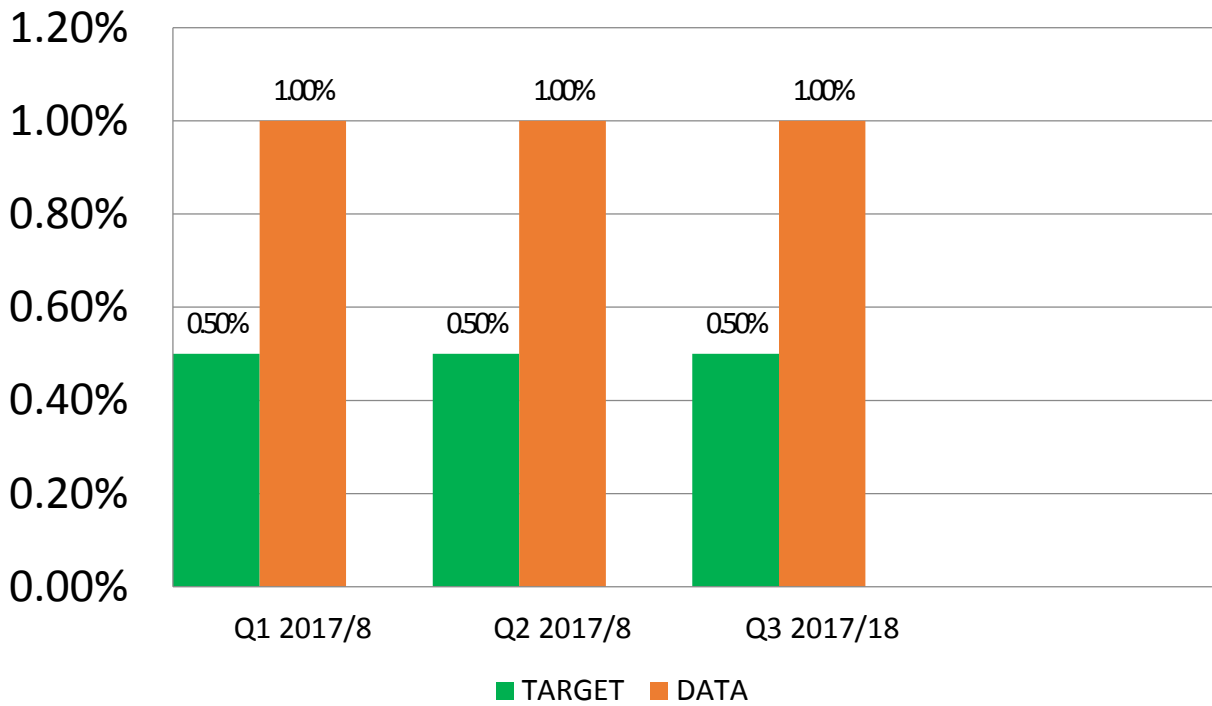
- PCR positivity rate at 1 % around 10 weeks ,contributing sub-districts Greater kokstad, UBuhlebezwe and Dr. NDZ.
- This is attributed by mix-feeding and poor adherence to treatment by unsuppressed breast feeding mothers.

RECOMMNDATIONS

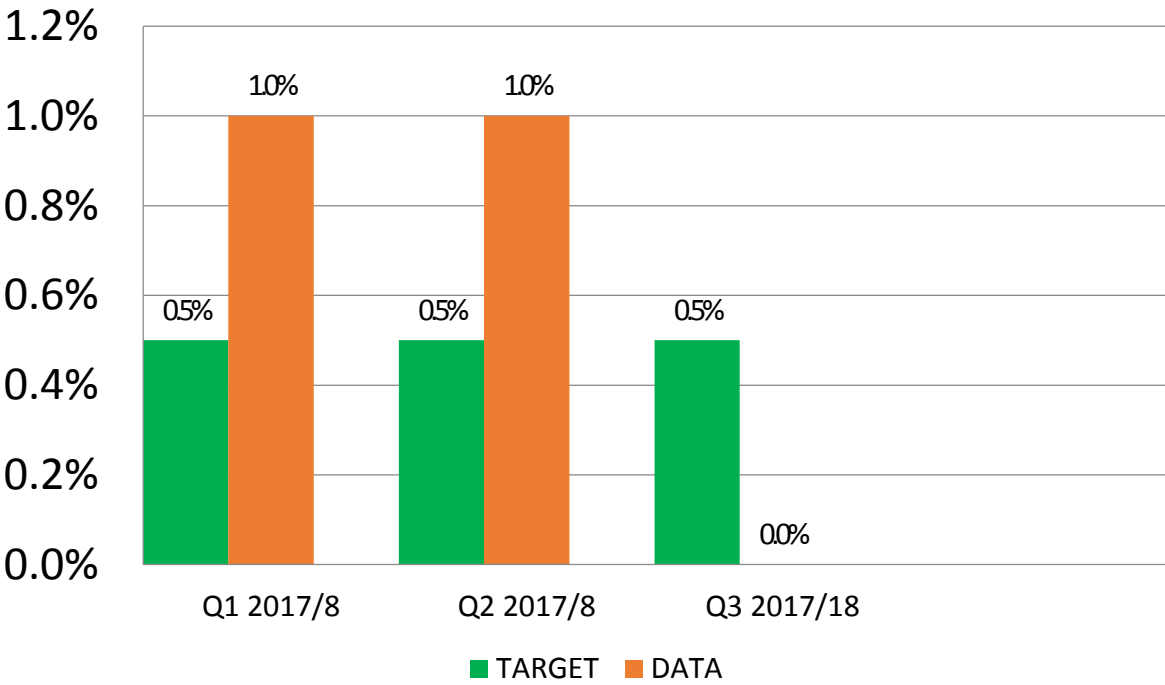
- Strengthen and monitor exclusive-breastfeeding
- Emphasize and monitor adherence to treatment by breastfeeding mothers
- Community dialogues to address myths.



Baby PCR tested positive around 10 weeks

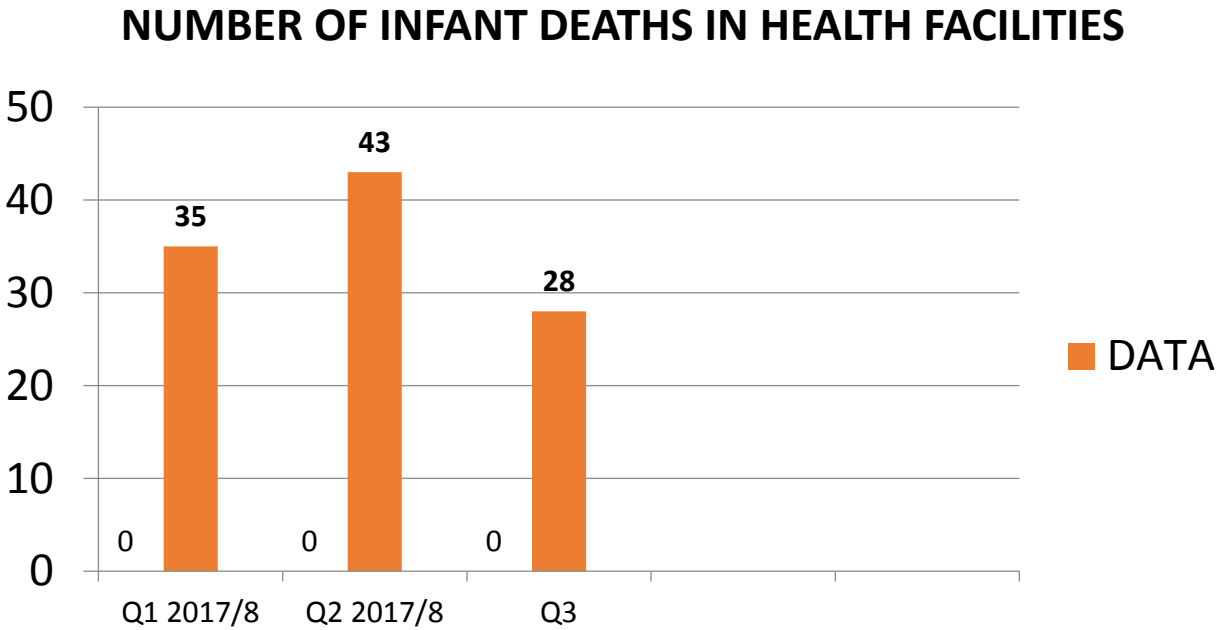


Baby HIV antibody test positive at 18months rate



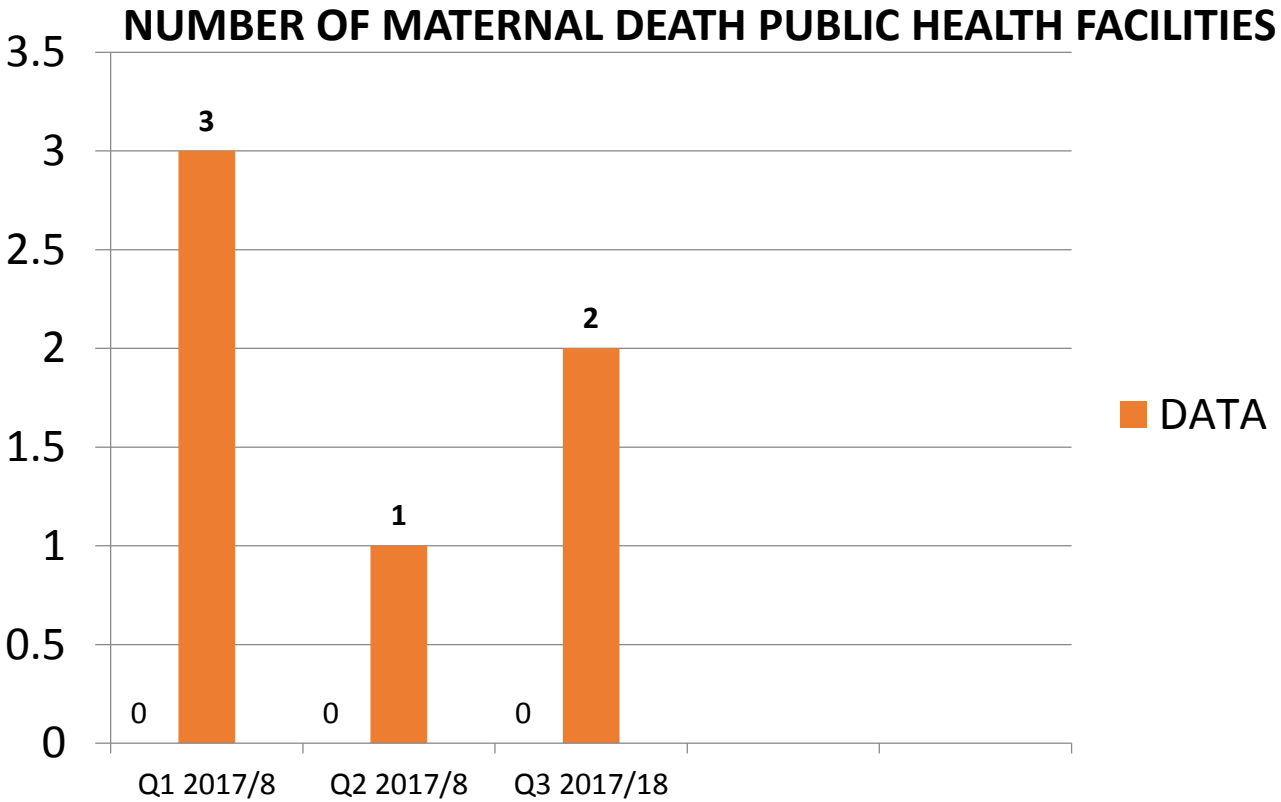
DISCUSSIONS

- There is a reduction in number of infant deaths this reporting quarter.
- Contributing factor are neonates 0- 28 days mainly due to inadequate facilities and lack of NICU (neonatal intensive care units) equipment.
- Number of maternal deaths =2, contributing facilities EGUM & Christ the king
- Causes : unaesthetic.
- Insufficient beds for waiting mothers which contributes to maternal deaths.



RECOMMENDATIONS

- Neonates early referral to facilities with Neonatal intensive care units where conditions deterioration is noted.
- Conduct perinatal meetings to scrutinize the causes of maternal deaths.



DISCUSSIONS

- Performance above target. WAD build-up events and partners' support attributed to the performance.
- Same target of people who know their status get tested in most facility with low positivity yield.
- HTS Policy not fully implemented at facilities to conduct community based testing due to limited resources.
- Number of HIV positive cases declined.
- Number of TB suspects tested smear positive=215
- Number of TB suspects initiated on treatment is 213 which accounts 99%, 0 died before initiation and 2 were loss to follow up still being traced for initiation.

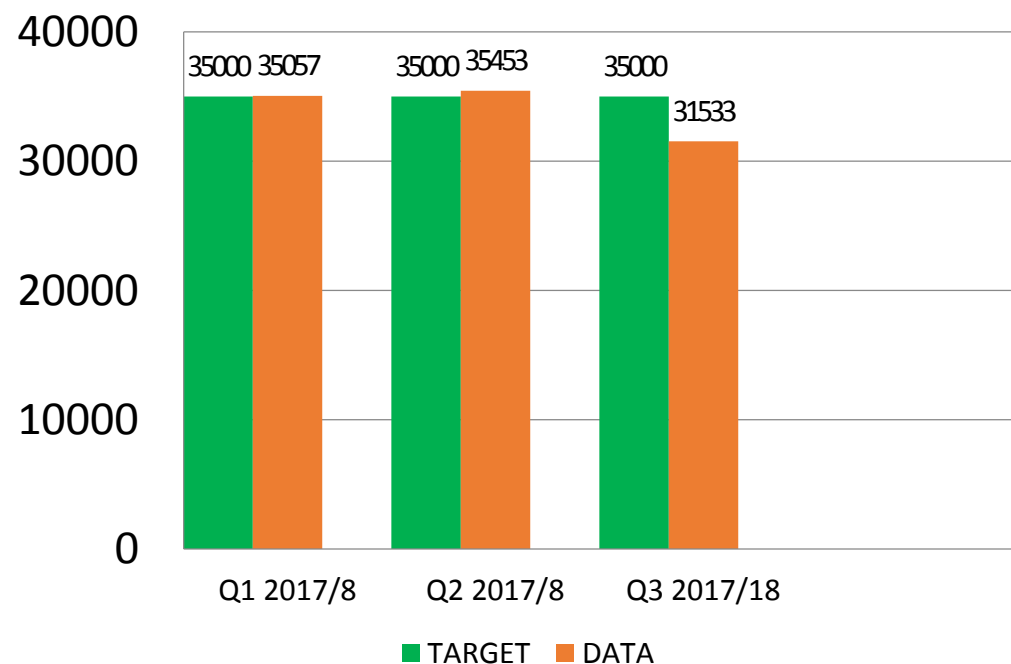
RECOMMENDATIONS

- Focus more on HIV positive index tracing and contacts testing.
- Train 30 more HCWs on Index contact tracing and testing by March 2018.
- Conduct community outreach services at Greater Kokstad informal settlements with assistance of Broadreach by March.
- Quality improvement plan to be developed and implemented. Monitor implementation plan.
- Trouble shoot facilities with poor performance.
- To strengthen client tracking system for early initiation .
- Attend sub district nerve center meetings to establish poorly performing facilities and monitor performance.



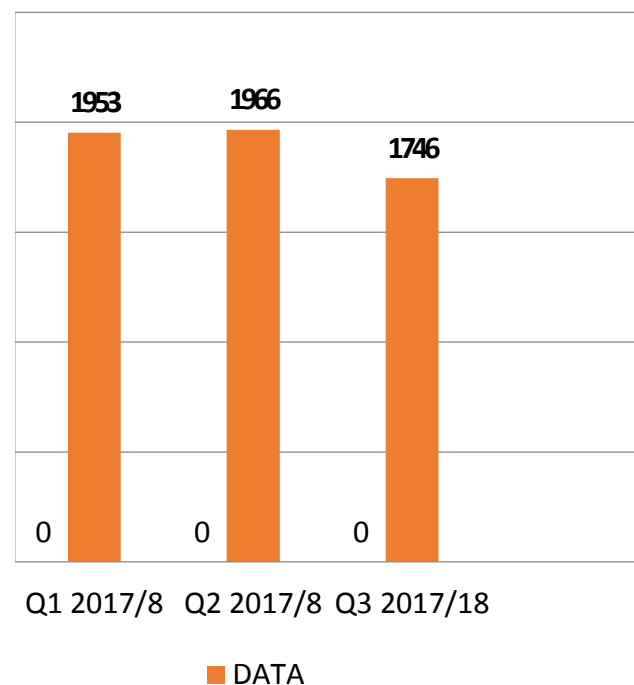

NUMBER OF HIV TESTS CONDUCTED



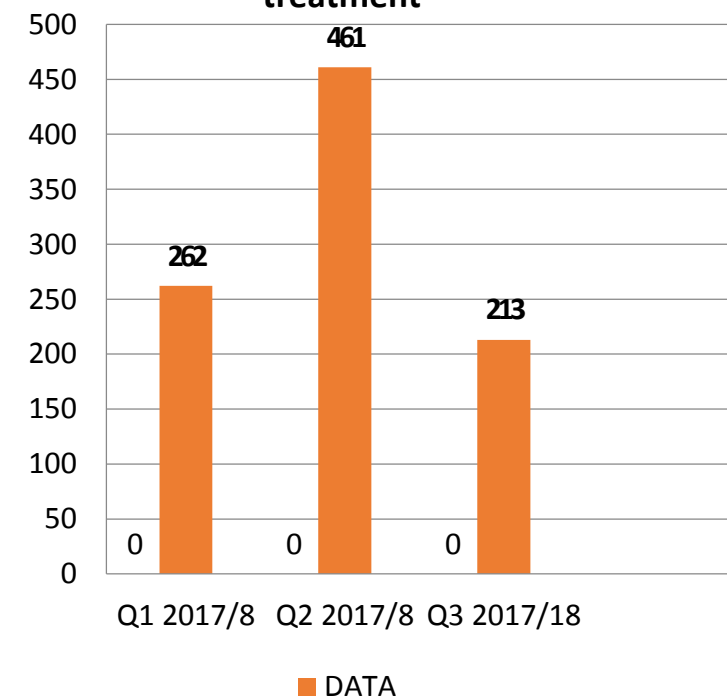

DISCUSSIONS

- There are challenges with recording and reporting of condoms.
- Condom distribution was done at various settings such as Communities/ outreach ,clinics and other departments.
- The service provider reporting was not clear in terms of actual numbers and sites. HAST section had to call them to correct it . A temporal form with more details was given to them as an example. project manager for condom distributing company was called.
- There are issues with service provider that has been centrally contracted
- some condoms were distributed in large quantities to places with lower needs e.g. St Margaret specialized hospital. .

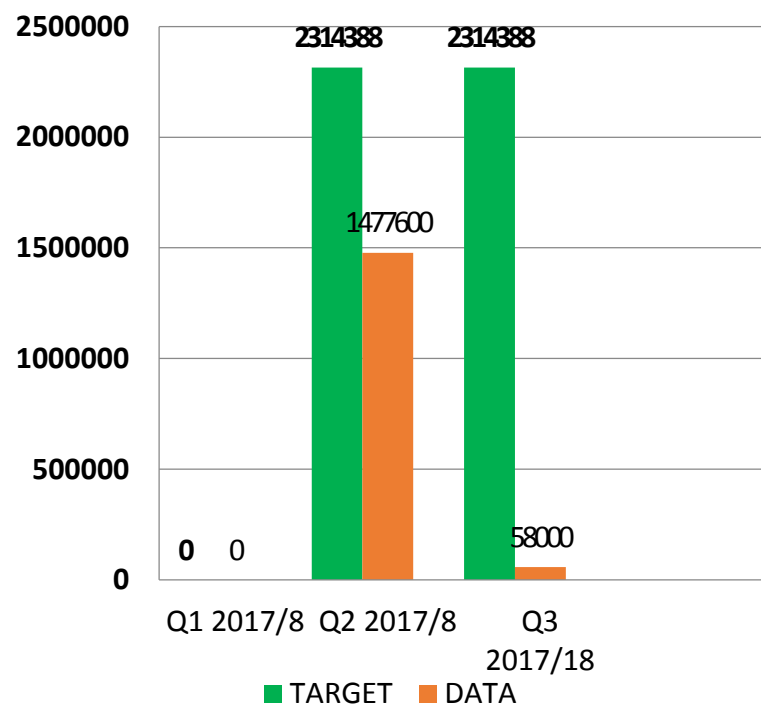
RECOMMENDATIONS

- HAST unit scheduled a meeting with service provider for end of February as the project leader of company that distribute condoms indicated that they are together with National are working on the new reporting format.
- Service provider was informed to collect and redistribute from specialized hospital. data management section to enter condoms distributed as HAST has worked on it.



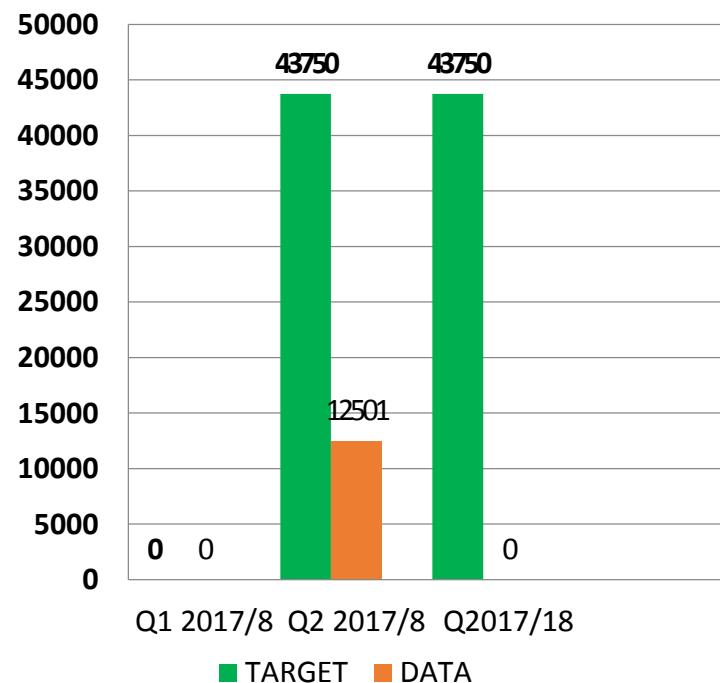

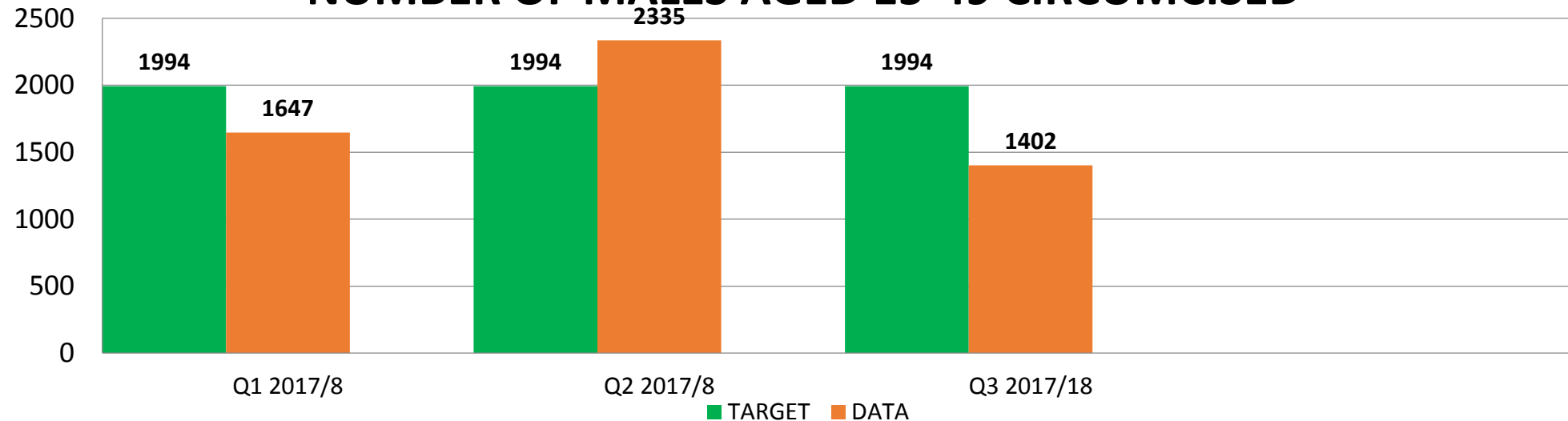
DISCUSSIONS

- Target not achieved inspite of the accelerated campaign to reach provincial 1 million target where the district had to do 5000 between the month of Oct and Dec 2017. Only 1402 MMC achieved .
- Challenges include High school exams thus the mobilization could not happen at schools.
- Data from partners and DHIS data still need verification and analysis because of its differences.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- To continue with mobilization and put more effort in quarter 4.
- Do data mop up , verification and analysis with partners.
- Set meeting in end of February to revisit the strategies.

NUMBER OF MALES AGED 15-49 CIRCUMCISED



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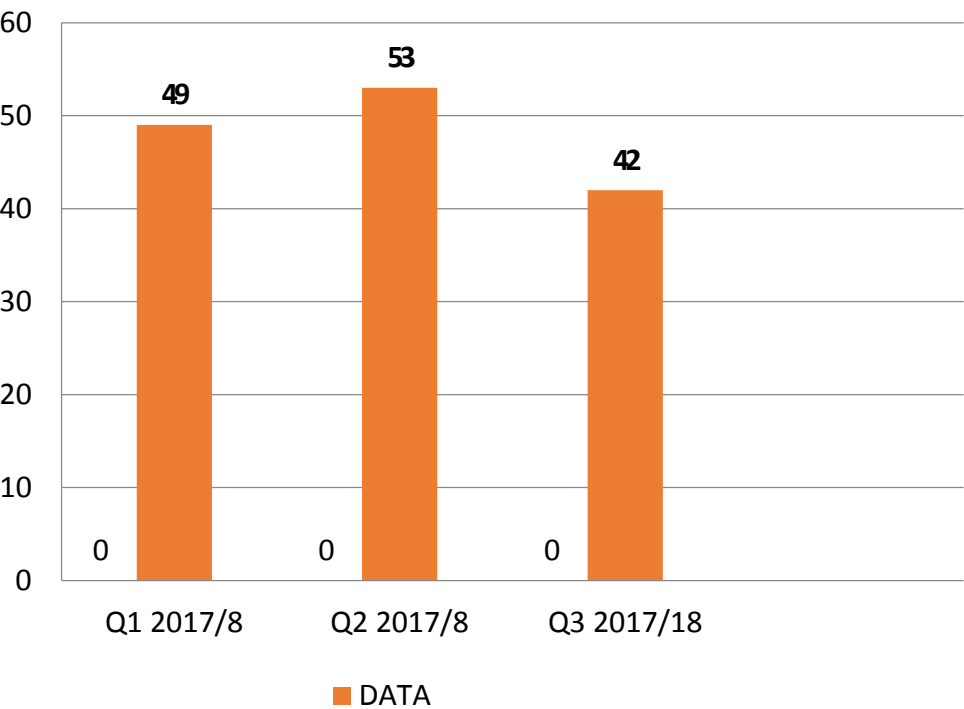


DISCUSSIONS

NUMBER OF NEW SEXUAL ASSAULT CASES

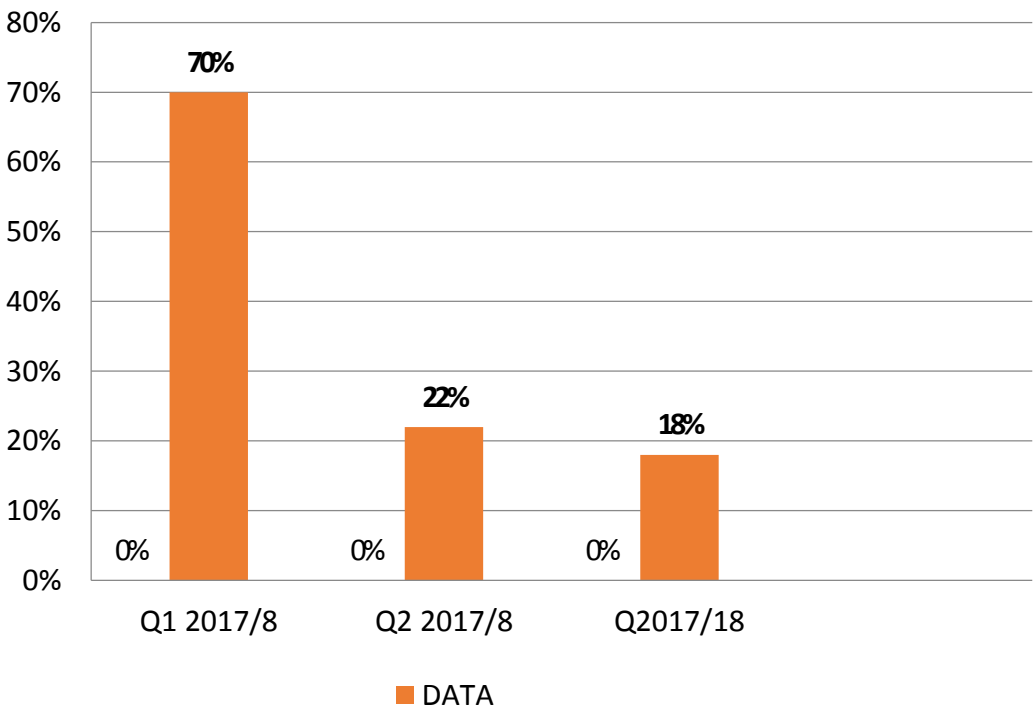


RECOMMENDATIONS

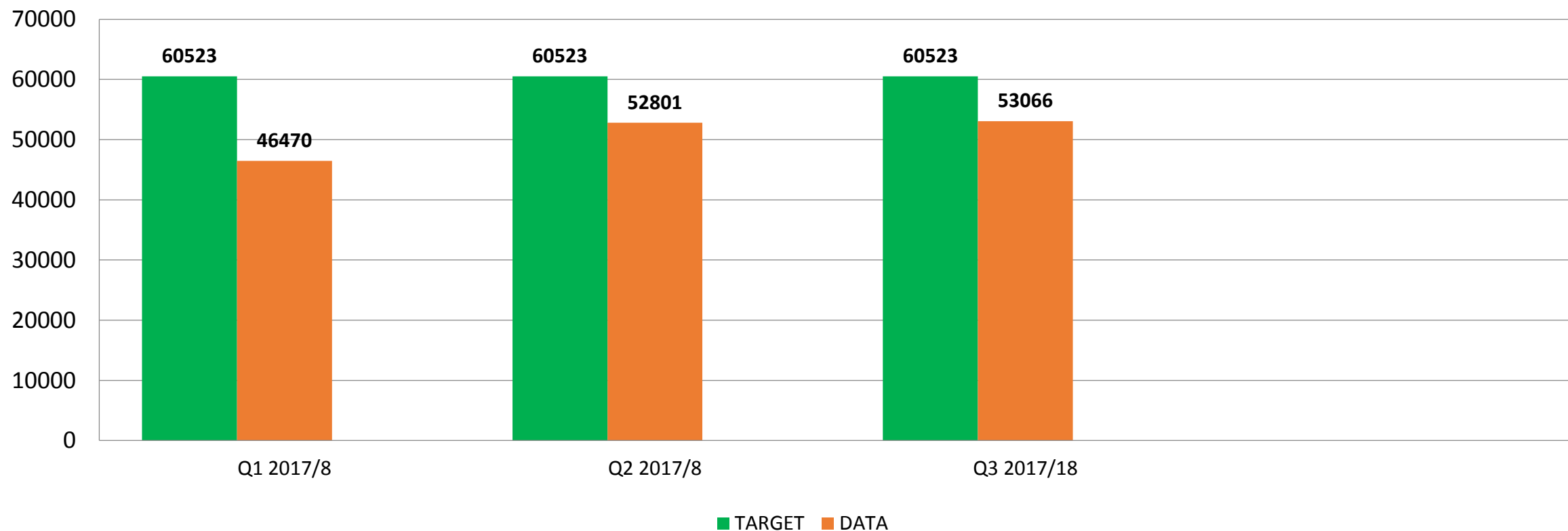
DISCUSSIONS

- Target not achieved but an increase is noted compared to previous reporting period.
- Missed capturing of some folders in the facility.
- Back capturing in high volume short staffed facilities.
- CCMDD client prescription period and return date recording in folders.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Patient folder process flow development and implementation per facility from the consulting room to the Data capturer then filing room/cabinet
- Strengthen HTS (HIV Testing Services) will ensure that HIV positive cases are diagnosed and put on treatment timeously.
- Adherence guideline Patient folder process flow development and implementation per facility from the consulting room to the Data capturer then

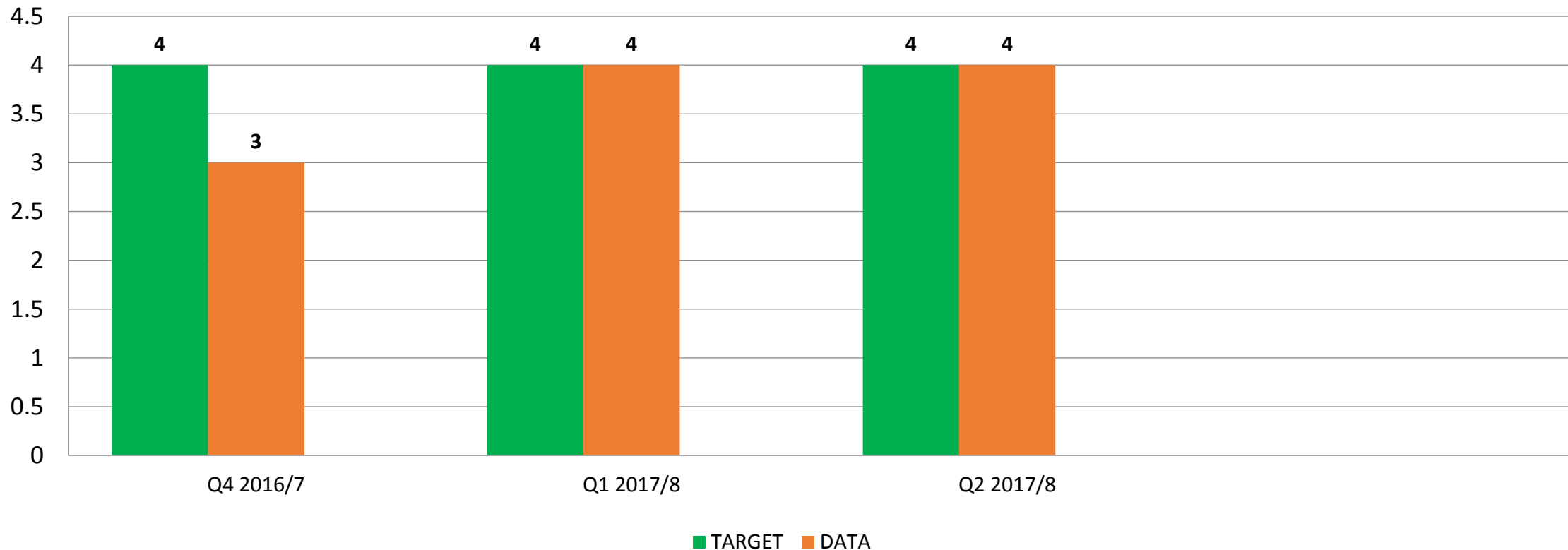
DISCUSSIONS

Strategic Objective 5: Coordination, Monitoring & Evaluation.

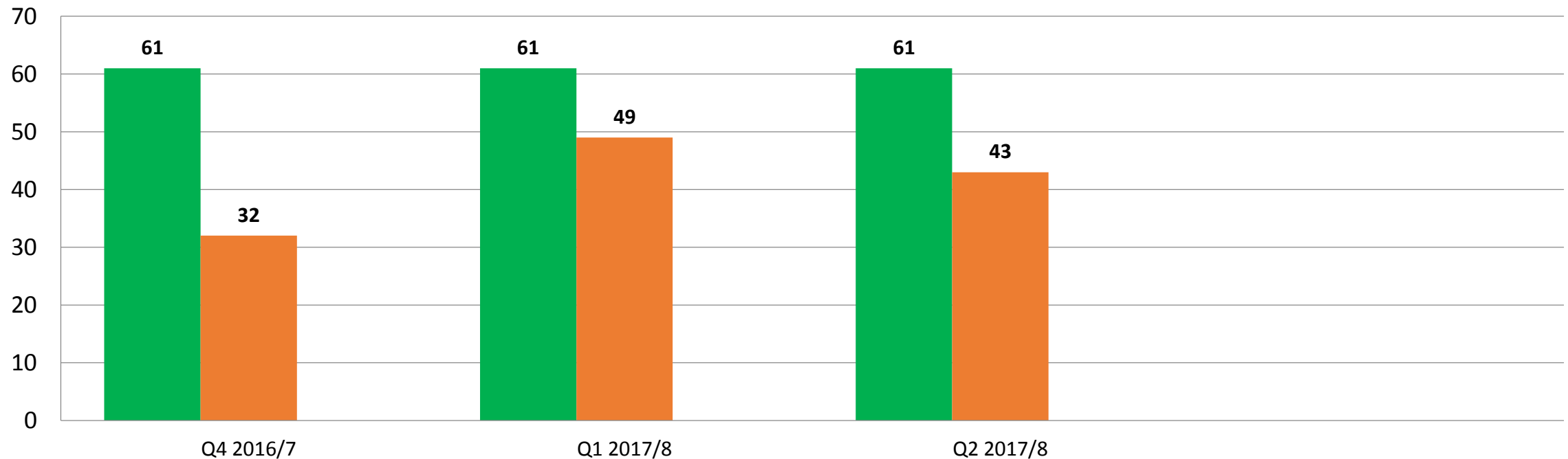
Discussions
