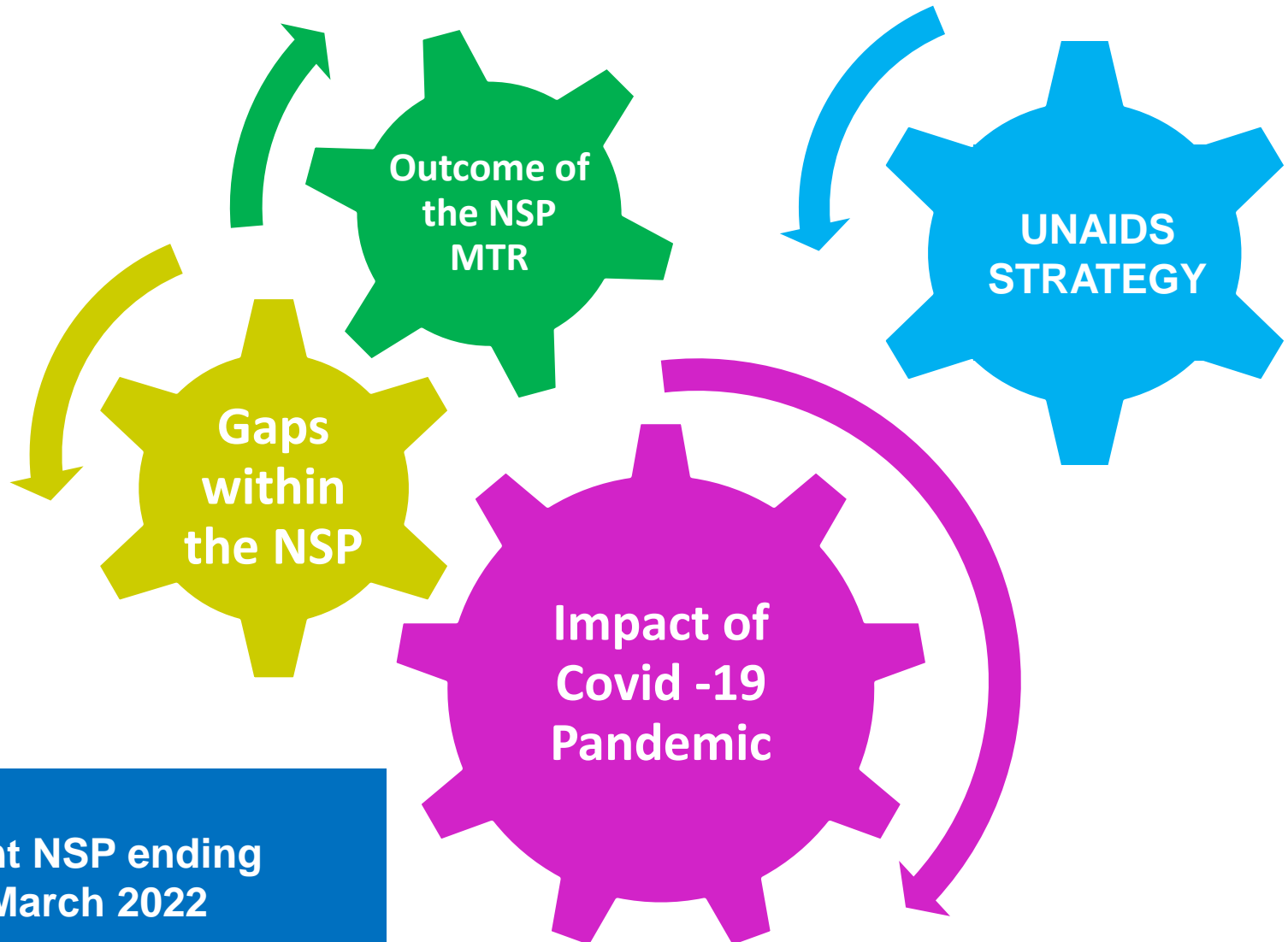

# NSP DEFERRAL – SANAC PLENARY RESOLUTION

- The 2-year period of 2021/22 and 2022/23:
  - Develop & Implementation of a Catch-Up plan to revitalise the HIV and TB programme
- The year 2022/23 start the development of the New NSP 2023 - 2028

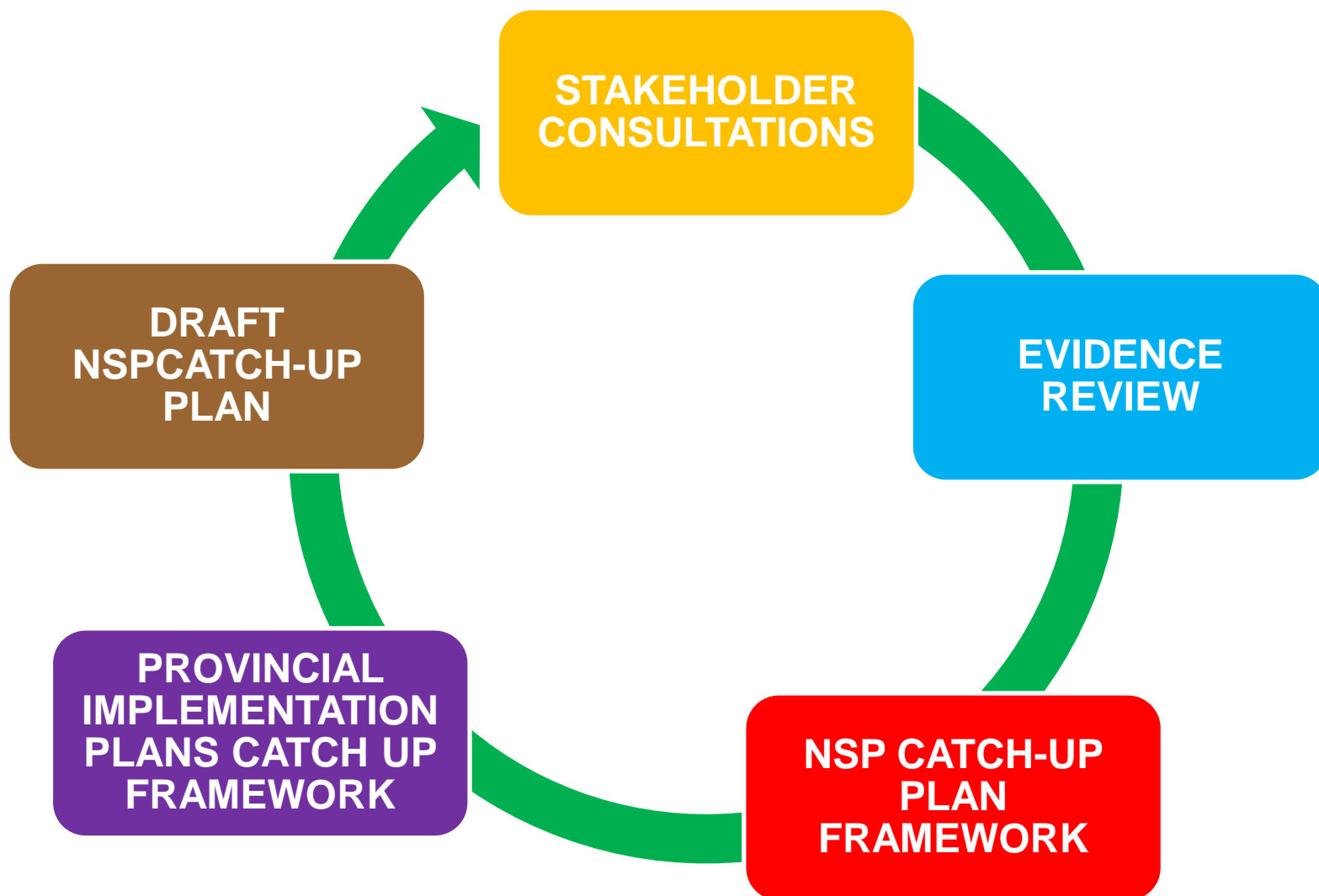
# FOCUS FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE NSP: 10 POINT-PLAN

1. Revitalise the HIV, TB and STIs **prevention** agenda to reduce new infections.
2. Rapidly **adapt the HIV Treatment Programmes in response to COVID-19**, in line with the World Health Organisation.
3. Urgently scale up the Anti-retroviral Treatment programme by **initiating new patients and welcoming back people returning after treatment interruptions, while retaining** patients already in care.
4. Strengthen **partnerships and accountability** for the HIV, TB and STIs responses.
5. Galvanise and reinvigorate political **leadership and financing**.
6. Improve the **multi-sectoral response** and strengthen **community-led responses**.
7. Lead interventions that address the **elimination of stigma, discrimination and punitive laws**.
8. Spearhead the **integration of HIV, TB, Covid-19** and Universal Health Coverage.
9. Lead the **Community literacy** programme for People Living with HIV on **Covid-19 vaccination programme**.
10. Take control and measure the **resource allocation and monitoring** of the catch-up plan, including coordination.

# REFERENCE COMMITTEE

- a) the **current status** of the HIV, TB and STI response taking into account the MTR of NSP, up to date Thembisa and Naomi estimates, and the TB Prevalence Survey Report.
- b) the **impact of COVID-19** on the TB and HIV response;
- c) the development of TB/HIV/STI **priorities** for inclusion in the NSP Catch-up plan
- d) the development a clear **High Level Action Plan with timelines, M&E Framework**.
- e) the allocation of relevant **resources** to the Catch-Up activities (critical enablers)
- f) the identification of **key risks** to the delivery of the Catch-Up plan and **mitigation measures**.
- g) the identification of areas where SANAC could assist in the **COVID-19 vaccine rollout** program; and
- h) consideration of the implications of COVID-19 and the deferment of the new NSP on the lives of South Africans who are infected with and affected by HIV, to whom **every new NSP brings a renewed sense of hope**. Consideration should also be given to the implications of the deferment for **principal international donors**.
