BACKGROUND OF PCA STRENGTHENING

- On 11 March 2020 PCA Secretariat shared findings on the assessment done on AIDS Council in all Districts. Report reflected weak areas mainly at DAC, LAC and WAC
- The PCA meeting held on 30 September 2020 resolved that AIDS Councils need to be strengthening at all levels based on AIDS Council assessment report
- SANAC through Global Fund and AIDS Foundation of South Africa (AFSA) support this activity. A Service Provider known as Best Effort has been appointed to work with the Office of the Premier HIV and AIDS Directorate in strengthening AIDS Councils
- An introductory meeting and concept document has been shared with Stakeholders and all 11 Districts.
- Project Plan has been outlined by Service Provider
