Low condom distribution	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 90 % of the target achieved which indicates upwards trend in performance though target not met.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Condom logistic officer appointed in Feb 2021.• Weekly targets for sub districts are monitored during nerve center.• All district Anchors carry condoms when visiting facilities for support
High Learner Pregnancy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Termination of pregnancy under 20 years is higher at Ubuhlebezwe which means that the service is well marketed and accepted	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Conducted adolescents and youth friendly services through integrated School Health services.



Infant deaths	<p>24 infant deaths were reported this quarter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dr NDZ had 6 • Kokstad 8 deaths • UMzimkhulu 7 • Ubuhlebezwe 3 <p>Majority of deaths are babies from birth to 6 days due to extreme Prematurity and gross congenital abnormalities.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Health care workers capacity building and community engagements for issues related to patients delaying seeking medical assistance.
Maternal death	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 maternal death reported in this quarter • 2 from CTK which was Covid -19 pneumonia related. • 1 from EGUM, HIV&AIDS related infection with unsuppressed viral load and opportunistic infections . 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monthly district and sub district maternal mortality and morbidity review meetings to improve quality of care and good perinatal outcomes.
