

# RENEWAL OF GOVERNANCE AND LEADERSHIP FOR ALL STRUCTURES

- All AIDS Councils to renew their governance and leadership in line with the SANAC and PCA Procedural Guidelines,
- Government to nominate, commit or recommit its representation in the AIDS Councils, e.g. Premier commits the MECs as Council members, Departments commits representatives into the Council, etc.
- Civil Society elects Sectoral and Governance leadership and deploy those in the Councils,
- Private Sector establishes Provincial Private Sector Forums and elects subnational leadership,
- Premier officially appoints all delegated and deployed members of the three Council Sectors (Gov, CSF and PSF) through formal letters,
- Process to be completed by 31 October,
- PCA to share the complete list of all members of the Councils in diding for the Districts and Locals once process has completed



### **Civil Society Elections Update: Timeline and Election Procedures**

- Voters Rolls must be published by 31 August
- 14 day's notice is required to be sent to the database of members announcing election dates.
- All sector leaders must withdraw at the point that the election window opens
- September 30 is last possible date of current terms to be served:
  - ➤ 1 14 September member notice
  - ➤ 15 September 30 September elections for Tier 1 to take place
  - 1 October 15 October elections for Tier 2 to take place

#### **Timeline and Election Procedures**

- Tier 2 elections cannot commence without tier 1 elections being concluded for all sectors
- Elective processes must commence no later than 1 September
  - > Tier 1 elections will be virtual
  - > Tier 2 elections will be virtual unless resources are confirmed

Elections have to take place within the defined process as outlined in CSF Election Guidelines.

Elective processes for tier 1 and tier will be declared as open as communicated in writing through the national electoral body

#### **PCA Secretariat**

- Schedule for CSF Elections covering district and provinces
- Adhere to CSF Election guidelines & liaise with SANAC & CSF Secretariat on elective processes
- Assigning of officials to Zoom platforms for electoral processes
- Sensitization and engagement with the Premier of the respective provinces
- Engagement with provincial and district sectoral leadership
- Resource mapping where applicable (incl. in-kind contributions)



Timeframe: 25 August for completion



#### **Sectoral Readiness**

- Signed off sectoral level database
- Engagement with provincial sector leaders for database consolidation

\*Sign-Off = concurrence across sectoral structures on completeness of the list, appraisal for alignment to sectoral charters, CSF TOR and Election Guidelines



#### **SANAC & CSF Secretariat**

- Receipt of signed-off databases for sectoral elective processes
- Receipt of provincial elections schedule
- Designation of joint national electoral officers that are the custodians of the elective process from local to national levels, assigning of provincial electoral officers
- Procurement of Zoom licenses to run elections
- Training of Elections officials
- Step-by-step voting video
- Online voters training (mandatory)





### World AIDS Day 2023

- The Nerve Centre Planning meetings have begun, and the provinces are encouraged to join these weekly meetings.
- The WAD is not an event, but campaign wave which is ongoing under the ambit of the Cheka Impilo campaign wave
- It is a campaign wave, happening across the country in all sectors and spheres of our communities, e.g. schools, hospitals, churches etc.
- It is therefore important that the PCA's own and execute their respective WAD, all the way to down to the DCA and LCA's levels
- Consultations with the SANAC structures are on the WAD platform(venue) are underway, the outcome will be shared soon
- The Programme Review Committee (PRC) will approve the complete WAD concept note, with the theme and platform (venue) of the 2023 national event.

- SANAC will coordinate country stakeholders for the conferences,
  - Conference venue: Rainbow Towers Hotel & International Conference
    Centre in Harare, Zimbabwe..
  - Communication will be issued to the provinces through the DG's in the Office of the Premier.
  - Provinces to start making their conference arrangements and to share their list of participants for the conference with SANAC



### PROVINCIAL SUSTAINABILITY PLANS FOR THE NSP & PIPs

- NSP requirement for continuation and transition of programmes for sustained implementation.
- Sustainability Framework for 2021-2023 developed at national,
- Currently being updated to align to the new NSP,
  - This is due to the new indicators and definitions
  - Consultant appointed Paul Booth
- Next to support provinces to develop their Provincial Sustainability Plans aligned to the PIPs
- Initial provinces will be KZN, GP and WC due to their vastness and donor support
- Process will be supported through the Global Fund Consultant already contracted
- Provinces to establish Sustainability Steering Committees to oversee the process,
- Dates to commence this work will be communicated with the provinces.
- Work to be provincially lead by the PCAs working with the Resources Mobilisation Committee (RMC)



## POVINCIAL RESOURCES MOBILISATION COMMITTEES (RMCs)

- Also, a recommendation of the new NSP,
- All PCAs to setup their RMCs,
- Recognition that some provinces have already setup their RMCs e.g. GP, WC and FS,
- National RMC has approved interim Terms of Reference (ToRs) for Provincial RMCs in line working on the national TORs,
- SANAC is reviewing the Procedural Guidelines through the SANAC standardisation project and this process will update the RMC ToRs,
- Key recommendation is that all RMCs should be chaired by the MECs of Health and co-chaired by elected CSF member



#### SANAC STANDARDISATION PROJECT

- SANAC's current governance tools have been found to be limited to hold stakeholders accountable and as a result SANAC Plenary took a resolution to standardize all all its structures at all levels of the response
- The Standardisation project includes the development of a National Multi-Sector Policy Framework accompanied by review of the SANAC Procedural Guidelines,
- Overall, the Policy Framework will among others:
  - Provide an enabling policy environment to coordinate and guide the multisector HIV, TB and STI response,
  - Describe governance, leadership and coordination arrangements for the response in the country,
  - Outline accountability mechanisms for the multi-sector response and describe consequence management for non-compliance,
  - Ensure that all SANAC structures are streamlined and fit for purpose to achieve their mandates,
  - Procedural Guidelines are revised and become a backbone of the Framework
  - Outline the rules of engagement among all the structures of SANAC
  - Outline standardised approach towards the strengthening of the AIDS Councils including SANAC and all its sectors,

#### PROJECT PROGRESS UPDATE AND EXPECTATIONS

- Enterprises University of Pretoria (EUP) has been appointed as the service provider to develop the Multi-Sector Policy Framework,
- Multi-Stakeholder Steering Committee has been setup for oversight support of the project and will work closely with the Service Provider,
- Letter of introduction for the project has been written by the CEO to all Stakeholders including provincial DG's,
- Service Provider will contact all provincial stakeholders and structures identified to inform as informants to the process,
- We are asking for the cooperation of the Provincial Stakeholders to provide inputs into this process.



#### **PCA CONSIDERATIONS**

- PCA to endorse the renewal of all governance and leadership process for the AIDS Councils,
- PCA to *note and endorse* the new developments in the plan for the Civil Society elections.
- PCA to *note* the status update on the preparations for the WAD 2023,
- PCA to note conference arrangements for ICASA.
- PCA to *note* the process for the development of the Provincial Sustainability Plans,
- PCA to *note* the updates on the establishment of the Provincial Resources Mobilisation Committee (RMC)
- PCA to note the SANAC Standardisation project and actively participate in the project.
