ICASA 2023 comes a year after the UNAIDS Global AIDS Update 2022 Report entitled: In Danger- revealing the potentially catastrophic impacts of COVID-19 on health systems worldwide if we don't take stock and shore up HIV health systems immediately

Conference is hybrid – 10 000 delegates are expected to attend the Conference
