3. WORLD TB DAY AND LAUNCH OF TB CAUCUS

- The country commemorated World TB Day in North West, Bojanala 08 delegates from KZN attended
- KZN World TB Day was scheduled for 11 April 2023 and has since been postponed due to support and assessments that need to be done to households affected by storm in the area
- Host District KCD based on high number of new cases, defaulters of treatment, death rate

TB CAUCUS

- TB Caucus was launched in South Africa in 2018. Each Province was then expected to launch their own TB Caucus.
- The aim of the TB Caucus is to raise awareness on the scourge of TB in the Province.
- TB Caucus is led by the Speaker of the Legislature, in KZN the Speaker appointed the Chairperson of the Portfolio Committee of Health to lead the TB Caucus activities
- There have been pre-TB Caucus launch activities that took place:

 - ➤ TB Caucus stakeholder engagement at iLembe District on the 17th of March 2023.
