There is a concern on high numbers of teenagers delivering at an early age

- There are dialogues taken in place on all five local municipalities all stakeholders involved
- We also educate learners about the use of contraceptives (led by AYP Champion). Civil Society Forums are actively involved on awareness's in the community
- We had youth camp at uPhongolo on June which catered the whole district led by Arts and Culture and all stakeholders.
- The District Civil Society Chairperson has started the facilitation or capacity building to maidens and encouraging young to be part of uMkhosi womhlanga within the district.
