Deliveries 10-19 years

High child and teenage pregnancy has been noted in the district

- 12 Awareness campaigns were conducted in various school (Sinamuva H, Thobigunya H, Amalangeni H, Mansfield P, ZuziceboH, Jolwayo P. Nobamba H, Inani H, Mbambi H, Mlonde H, Bomvini and Sihle H School) covering all LMs, reached 1822 learners. This was done and currently being implemented collaboratively by all district stakeholders
- Learner Support Agents in 18 schools conducted awareness campaigns on teenage pregnancy, sexual assault and GBV
- 8 Community dialogues have been conducted covering all LMs
- Peer education workshops were conducted in schools
- Life orientation educators were trained to implement comprehensive sexuality education

TB lost to follow up

High lost to follow up in the past quarters

- Awareness's on TB was done in almost every facility in the district.
 Continuous screenings were also done during TB month.
- Mayoral Izimbizos between April and May were used to share HIV and TB information covering 32 wards
- Data verification and data clean up was done on identified facilities with data errors negatively impacting the indicator.
- District Supporting Partner (Isibani Partners) commenced work in the
 District in support of the TB Programme.



Medical Male Circumcision

- Male circumcision was noted to be low within the district.
 Various sensitizations were made at the local levels
- VMMC campaigns conducted in Gamalakhe Sorts and Leisure centre, Qinabout hall, Mfundo Lushaba CHC
- Conducted awareness campaign at Kasified Shisanyama about VMMC to males

Maternal death in facilities

- Maternal death has been escalating from the past financial year, however a slight decline has been noted in past quarter
