

Sinithulela uMnumzane Lucky Dodo "Donsa Madonsela Ngoba Ziyamdonsa Umagejageja" Madonsela, osehhovisini lezoLwazi Lobuchwepheshe (Information Technology). UMnumzane Madonsela ungowaKwaNyuswa, esigodini saseMagatsha. Uthando lokwazisa isintu luqale ngonyaka wezi-2013 emva kokuhlala iminyaka eyisikhombisa eMagatsha. Ilapho eqale khona ukubhekisisa ukwenza kwabantu bezigodi ezakhelene naye.

Kumsize kakhulu ukunamathela eNduneni (uKhalemsondeza), yesigodi sasemaGugwana esisendaweni yakwaMkhizwana, engumkhulu womngani wakhe ngoba ilapho abethola khona ulwazi olunzulu ngesiko-mpilo laKwaZulu. Ugcine esenothando lokulalela nezinhlelo zesintu emsakazweni nakumabonakude.

UMnumzane Madonsela ube esechaza izinhlaka ezahlukene kanye neminye imicimbi abake babe nayo. Kunomcimbi wokuvula unyaka okuthiwa ihlahla, oba khona njalo ngosuku lokuqala onyakeni omusha. Kukhona amaqembu engoma ahlukehlukene ngendlela adlala ngayo ingoma njengeMitshotshovu.

Leli iqembu labesilisa eligqoka imvunulo ecishe ifane nezingubo zabesifazane. Leli qembu lona liyayihuba ingoma. Kukhona elinye iqembu okuthiwa iShiyameni elidlala ingoma ngohlobo oluhlukile. UMnumzane Madonsela ubeke kanje: "Ubuhle bokungena engomeni ukuthi kuyayiqoqa intsha ngoba ifundiswa ukuziphatha, nempilo nokunye okuningi. Intsha ayibi uvanzi futhi iyanqandeka nasezidakamizweni nobugebengu ngoba ayisitholi isikhathi salokho."

Ephawula uMnu. Madonsela uphethe ngokuthi: "Kanti engomeni nezintokazi zinhle zigezile. Noma ngingakakhethi, ucu lungakahlangani ngisabheka intokazi engingayenza ingoduso ukuze nginimeme ningibungaze emgcagcweni wami. Ngokubona kwami uthando nomshado weSintu iwona obalulekile nongiyowuthokozela kakhulu kunalo owesilungu."
